Request multiple copies of the death certificate from the funeral home or the local health department.

Legal and Administrative Tasks

- □ Notify **social security**, **insurance** companies, **banks**, and other financial institutions.
- □ Contact the deceased's attorney, if they had one.
- □ Secure the Deceased's Property
 - □ Ensure that their home and other property are secured and protected.

□ Locate the Will and Estate Documents

□ Find the will and any other estate planning documents.

□ Probate the Will (Probate Necessary? Call today to find out 951-223-1157)

- $\hfill\square$ File the will with the local probate court to start the probate process.
- $\hfill\square$ The court will appoint an executor to handle the estate.

□ Notify Creditors and Close Accounts

- □ Inform creditors of the death and settle any outstanding debts.
- □ Close bank accounts, credit cards, and other financial accounts.
