Marianne Lovejoy, Vicki LePenske, Ben Marley, Samantha Fox, Gene McDonald and David Bee **Exhibitor Information:** This test is open to hounds of the breeds specified that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained ILP or PAL numbers, except for aggressive hounds or hounds suffering from any deformity, injury or illness, which may affect the hound's physical or mental performance.

Safety of the hounds is a primary concern. The test running grounds are open meadows and olive groves. No releasing dogs on rabbits except as instructed by the judges during the trial. All hounds must be on leash at all times except when being tested. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their hounds, guests and children. Anyone engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the test committee, be asked to leave the trial site.

Bitches in season are not permitted at this test and entry fee will be refunded if a bitch entered in solo stake is in season at time of test. If a bitch in season has been entered in brace or pack another hound may be substituted. Refunds will be given if the secretary is notified by Wednesday, October 8, 2025.

Judges are not required to wait for hounds. Owners or handlers of each hound are solely responsible for the dog being ready to perform.

Judging will commence at Sunrise In a BHCA sanctioned hunting performance test, In a Hunting Hound (HH), Senior Hunting Hound (SHH), and Master Hunting Hound (MHH) or Master Hunting Hound Excellent (MHE) title may be earned. Each entry must specify "Q" or "NQ" indicating whether or not that hound is intended to qualify for a leg for a title. Only one "Q" entry may be submitted for each hound at a test. A hound qualifying three times in either solo, brace, or 2-couple pack can earn HH. Once having the HH, the hound must compete in one of the other remaining stakes and qualify three times for SHH, and then in the remaining stake qualifying three times to earn an MHH or MHE. Awards: Ribbons with an AKC logo will be awarded to all qualifying legs. For titles earned, a certificate from the BHCA with the hound's name, owner's name(s), title earned, and date will be prepared and delivered to the owner. Application can be made to add the title to the AKC pedigree.

Hounds will be judged in the following categories of hunting ability on a scale of one to ten:

- 1. Ability to find game 2. Use of voice 3. Line ability 4. Adaptability
- 5. Determination

Gun shyness will be judged on a pass/fail basis. A pass is a minimum of 5 in each category and an average of at least 6. A current copy of the rules can be found on the BHCA web site.

DIRECTIONS TO HUNT TEST GROUNDS -

Start out going southeast on W 5th St toward Brewster Rd. Turn left onto Highway 109/MO-109. Pass through 1 roundabout. Drive 6.57 miles, Enter next roundabout and take the 2nd exit onto MO-109. MO-109 becomes S Eatherton Rd. and turn slight left to stay on S Eatherton Rd. Drive 2.11 miles and S Eatherton Rd becomes Olive Street Rd. Drive 1.18 miles and turn left onto Chesterfield Airport Rd. for 0.66 miles and stay straight to go onto I-64 W/US-40 W/US-61 N. Continue to follow US-61 N. Then drive 28.30 miles take the exit for 0.21 miles. Turn left onto MO-47/E Highway 47. Drive 2.20 miles and turn right onto Highway H/MO-H. Highway H is 0.5 miles past Dunard Dr. Drive 7.26 miles and turn left onto Tagg Rd. Tagg Rd is just past Trail Cemetery Ln. Drive 0.80 miles to Eastern Missouri Beagle Club is just past Two Far Farm Rd.
