RAMP -- A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/ show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp). At the discretion of the judge, English Springer Spaniels may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition. This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

VETERAN DOG, 7 years and older FIELD TRIAL DOG FIELD TRIAL BITCH

The winners of these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Any veterans defeated in these classes may not compete for Best of Breed, even if entered in the class.

Chapter 11, Sect 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "Neutered dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed."

Field Trial Classes - Class for dogs that have placed first through fourth in an AKC licensed field trial or who has completed the requirements for an AKC Field Trial Championship. Spayed and neutered bassets are eligible for this class.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered in this competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs, which according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Undefeated dogs ONLY are eligible to compete for Best of Breed

AWARD OF MERIT

At the Basset Hound Club of America National and Regional Specialty Shows, the judge may bestow, at his or her discretion, up to five (5) Awards of Merit to exhibits other than the dog awarded Best of Breed

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR COMPETITION

During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Best Bred-by Exhibitor will be selected from the First-Place Winners of the Dog and Bitch Bred-by-Exhibitor classes, both Puppy & Adult. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED. Best Bred-by Exhibitor receives a prize of one free litter registration, donated by AKC.

POINTS AVAILABLE FOR RESERVE

The Basset Hound Club of America will award at its National Specialty a three-point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

The Basset Hound Club of America will award at its National Specialty a three-point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

*STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition.

*BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as the Stud Dog Class, substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "Get."

Neutered dogs, spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in Brace, Team, Veterans and all other single entry non-regular classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed.) Entry Fee: \$34

BRACE CLASS– This class is for two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers (can be one handler). Both dogs competing in brace competitions must have at least one common owner. Both dogs must be entered in a regular class. An entry form for a dog entered in the Brace Class must indicate the name of the other dog comprising the other half of the brace. If more than one Brace is entered by an identical owner, the dog comprising each Brace Unit must be designated as "Brace #1" and "Brace #2", Etc, Entry fee (\$34) is for Each Brace Unit, not each individual dog.

Parade of Veterans

Open to dogs and bitches seven years and over. No judging involved but each participant must submit a short narrative of not more than 50 words. Narrative must be turned into the Show Chair NLT end of judging on Wednesday. Use the standard entry form and indicate Parade under Dog Show Class or Additional Classes. Each entrant will receive a Green & Turquoise Rosette. Each Rosette will list dog's name. Entry Fee: \$20.00

SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

Eligibility: This Sweepstakes is open to all Basset Hounds who, on the day of the show, will be at least six months and under twenty months of age. Classes to be divided by sex and age. Sweepstake Classes will be judged prior to the regular breed classes. **Dogs shown in Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes.** Indicate "Sweepstake & Age Division" in the Additional Classes space. Professional Handlers and Champions of Record are eligible to compete.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Junior Dog, 6 mos. & under 9 mos.

Junior Bitch, 6 mos. & under 9 mos.

Junior Dog, 9 mos. & under 12 mos.

Junior Bitch, 9 mos. & under 12 mos.

The class winners will compete for Best Junior in Sweepstakes & Best Opposite Sex Junior in Sweepstakes.

Senior Dog, 12 mos. & under 18 mos.
Senior Bitch, 12 mos. & under 18 mos.
Senior Dog, 18 mos. & under 24 mos.
Senior Bitch, 15 mos. & under 24 mos.
The class winners will compete for Best Senior in Sweepstakes & Best Opposite Sex Senior in Sweepstakes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

Eligibility: This Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Basset Hounds, who, on the day of the show, will be at least 7 yrs of age. Neutered males and spayed bitches are eligible for Veteran Sweepstakes. Judging will be held prior to regular classes. A dog **DOES NOT** have to be entered in the Regular Classes at this show. Indicate "Sweepstake & Age Division" in the Additional Classes space.

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf.

Most important to note are the following:

- Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
- 2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at https://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:

- · Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
- Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show
- Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

Each dog entered in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be of a breed eligible to compete in the conformation classes (including Miscellaneous Classes) at the event. Dogs may be ILP, Full or Limited-Registered to compete in Junior Showmanship Classes, additionally, spayed and neutered specimens are eligible for competition. Breeds excluded from competition at the event are not eligible. The dog must be entered in one of the classes associated with the event or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. An eligible dog other than the one entered may be substituted. Such substitutions must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. The junior must have the AKC number of the substitute dog. All such substitutions must be made with the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister. uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations, or by a permanent member of the Junior Handler's household as recorded with The American Kennel Club at the time entries close or an application for transfer of ownership must be sent to the American Kennel Club by the new owner within seven days after the last day of the show. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. At a Specialty Show, each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held. A Junior is limited to one substitution at a dog show. If one of the owners of the dog is a judge, the dog may be entered in the Junior Showmanship Only to be exhibited by the Junior at an event where the judge is judging classes other than Junior Showmanship.

A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused by the veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Entries for Regular Junior Showmanship Classes shall close at the same time that entries close for this show


Winning First Place in an Open Junior Showmanship Class at this show may qualify, or count towards qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on the eligibility requirements for Limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, write to AKC, Event Plans, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

ETHICAL CONDUCT GUIDELINES

PURPOSE: Each member of the Basset Hound Club of America will consider the welfare of the breed when engaging in any activities involving the breeding, selling or competition of Basset Hounds. BHCA members, both individuals and member clubs, are urged to comply with the following guidelines:

GENERAL:

- 1. Members of the Basset Hound Club of America will abide by the constitution and by-laws of BHCA and of the American Kennel Club.
- 2. Members will ensure that all dogs in their care are provided adequate food, water, and shelter, opportunity for exercise, veterinary care, and personal attention to monitor their needs.
- 3. Breedings will be directed toward producing Basset Hounds of exceptional quality in breed temperament, Basset Hound type and ability to hunt game. Members shall follow the recommendation for screening and/or testing of breeding stock for inherited diseases/disorders as set forth in the BHCA Health Policy. Only healthy and mature dogs and bitches free of congenital defects and of characteristic breed type, sound structure and temperament shall be bred.
- 4. Members should not undertake the breeding of a bitch unless they are prepared to act responsibly with whelping, rearing puppies and the disposition of the resultant puppies. Members shall be discriminating in the placing of puppies and adult hounds, choosing environments in which the Basset Hound will receive suitable care and affection and will not be misused.
- 5. Basset Hounds offered for sale or males offered at stud must be presented honestly regarding their pedigrees, their potential and their faults or the fault possibilities, structural or health related that may develop in maturity.
- 6. Members of the Basset Hound Club of America will follow good business practices and ethics in breeding and sales contracts and will honor all agreements. Written agreements in all dealings regarding Basset Hounds are strongly encouraged.
- 7. No member of this club shall engage in the wholesaling of litters or the selling of breeding stock to commercial sales operations ("puppy mills"). No member will offer or supply Basset Hounds for prizes, raffles, or lotteries.
- 8. No member shall engage in false or misleading advertising or misrepresentation of his/her Basset Hounds or those of competitors, including the above types of comments on any social media.
- 9. Members will practice the principles of good sportsmanship, considering competition to be a challenge, not a threat.
- 10. All members of the Basset Hound Club of America shall conduct themselves in all aspects of the sport of dogs in a manner designed to reflect credit upon our breed and our club.





Violators who refuse to make restitution shall be refused a room reservation through the Basset Hound Club of America for a period of five (5) years, and the Nationals' headquarters hotel will be so informed, unless hearing is requested before the Board of Directors at a mutually agreeable site within 30 days. Three (3) members of the Board must be in attendance and may reverse the findings of the Hospitality Committee.
 - C. Violators who make restitution to the hotel will have their names placed on a list for a period of five (5) years, to be kept by the Corresponding Secretary of the Basset Hound Club of America. Should no other violation occur during this time, the violator's name shall be removed from the list. 



Ask if others are ready if you are first in line


Let the judge and others know if your bitch is in season

- 1. Entries must reach the Show Secretary, DogZibit, P. O. Box 2044, Woodinville, WA 98072-2044 by the closing date & time specified in the Premium List. After which time no entries can be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any change or cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show Rules and Regulations. - 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might
 reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other
 than the merits of the dogs.
- $\bullet\,$ The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are
 able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- · Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- · Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
