We process personal data relating to you if one of the following conditions applies:

Know how long your data is stored

When we collect your personal data, we retain it for as long as necessary for the purposes for which we collected it. A may be kept for a longer period due to any legal obligations or on the basis of your consent.

Here's what it entails in more detail. We will retain your personal data for the purposes and reasons set out below:

- **For contractual purposes**: If we have entered into a contract with you, we will retain your data until the performance of that contract is completed.

- Access your data. You have the right to obtain information about the data we process, certain aspects of the processing and to receive a copy of the data processed.
- Check and request rectification. You can verify the accuracy of your data and request that it be updated or corrected.
- Obtain the restriction of the processing of your data. You can request the restriction of the processing of your data. In this case, we will not process your data for any purpose other than storing it.
- **Obtain the deletion or removal of your personal data.** You can request that we delete your data.
- Receive your data and have them transferred to another controller. You have the right to receive your data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and, where technically feasible, to obtain its unhindered transfer to another controller.
- **Submit a complaint.** You can lodge a complaint with the competent data protection supervisory authority or take legal action.
- **Know the reason for the data transfer.** You have the right to obtain information about the legal basis for the transfer of data abroad, including to any international organization governed by international law or established by two or more countries, such as the UN.
- **Know the safety measures.** You have the right to know the security measures we take to protect your data.

How to exercise these rights

The request is free of charge and we will respond as soon as possible, in any case within one month, providing you with all the information required by law.

Any rectification, erasure or restriction of processing will be communicated by us to each of the recipients, if any, to whom the personal data has been transmitted, unless this proves impossible or involves a disproportionate effort. We will notify you of these recipients if you request it.

Defense in court
