Cross Regional Collaboration - Taiwan Initiatives Missionary Prayer Letter - Kenneth and Vania Law



Praise the Lord! The "Cross-Regional Collaboration-Taiwan Initiatives" which comprises Evangelical Free Churches (EFC) from four regions, is on target to accumulate TWD15 million, which is the amount needed to register for the "Taiwan Evangelical Free Church Association" (EFCT). According to the Taoyuan Government, a religious foundation must always keep a minimum balance of TWD 15 million in its bank account.

The registration process is expected to be completed by the end of this year, at which point we will plant our first EFCT bilingual church. When more missionaries arrive in the future, we can plant more churches across Taiwan under EFCT, without the need to register for each individual church.



The cost of planting the new church (including rental deposit, renovation, equipment purchases and the first-year operating expenses but excluding each missionary's self-raised expenses) is estimated to be HKD 3 million. Starting this month, EFCs from various regions will work together to raise this amount. It is our hope that the new church will grow and become financially independent in a few years, at which time no external financial support will be needed.

As I mentioned in my previous prayer letter, the fundraising target for Hong Kong this fiscal year (January to December 2026) is HKD 2.4 million. We are grateful for the HKD 1.35 million raised during the first half of 2026. After deducting the expenses incurred by my wife and myself, the entire amount has been allocated for registration purposes. For the second half of 2026, I am focusing on raising the aforementioned fund for planting the new church.

Six months ago, the Board of Evangel Global Missions invited me to serve as the Acting General Secretary and assist in recruiting a new General Secretary. Although this additional role increases my workload, my two roles have a synergistic effect and have not impacted negatively on my Taiwan mission work.
