Cross Regional Collaboration - Taiwan Initiatives Missionary Prayer Letter - Kenneth and Vania Law



The Lord has blessed our "Cross-Regional Collaboration - Taiwan Mission Project". The first phase (assisting two partner churches in establishing English ministries and church planting) of our work is on track. We are now starting the second phase, which is to undertake registration for the "Taiwan Evangelical Free Church Association". Once the registration is completed, we can plant bilingual (English and Mandarin) churches in various regions of Taiwan, as well as sponsoring foreign missionaries to come to Taiwan.

According to Taiwanese regulations, religious foundations must possess a certain amount of asset (e.g. a minimum of 20 million Taiwan dollars in bank accounts for registration in Taipei). Because of this requirement, Hong Kong's fundraising target has increased from 1.8 million HKD in 2025 to 2.4 million for 2026. The allocation of the budget for FY 2026 (1 January to 31 December) is as follows (HKD):

1. Administrative fee (10%): \$240,000
2. Religious foundation registration fund: \$900,000
3. Taiwan mission operating expenses: \$900,000
4. Ken and Vania's ministry expenses: \$360,000

It is noted that our Taiwan Mission project is a cross-regional collaboration, the funds for registration and operation are contributed by the Evangelical Free Churches from several regions (including Hong Kong, USA, Singapore and Malaysia). When the registration is completed, the fundraising target for each region for the following year will be reduced.

Three months ago, Evangel Global Missions invited me to serve as the Acting General Secretary and assist the Board of Directors in recruiting a new General Secretary. Although this additional role increases my workload, my two roles have a synergistic effect and have not impacted my Taiwan mission work negatively. Vania and I now travel back and forth between Hong Kong and Taiwan every month. Once our new bilingual church starts, we will spend more time in Taiwan.
