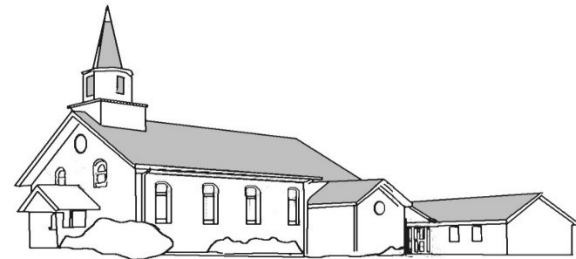

(The congregation signifies its renewed dedication and unity of purpose in service to Christ)

Prayer

One: God of compassion, guide us in our discipleship, however imperfect it may be, that we may be your witnesses to a hurting world.

All: May we celebrate the faith of those who have gone before us, confident in your Word of Truth.

One: May we stand firm on your purposes for peace and wholeness for all of creation and your promise to be with us always.

All: We covenant with you to be instruments of understanding and forgiveness among those to whom you send us.

One: We dedicate ourselves to accept the challenge to be living examples of God's love.

All: Increase our faith and give us grace to boldly answer your call. Amen.

Service of Holy Communion – Day of Pentecost

Grace, Mercy and Peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ be with you all.

All: Amen. Thanks be to God.

Right Hand of Fellowship

(The congregation signifies its oneness in Christ and desire to be at peace with one another)

***Prayer of Confession – Day of Pentecost**

One: Holy and gracious God, on this day of wind and fire, we remember the gift of Your Spirit poured out upon Your people.

All: Yet we confess that we have not always lived as Spirit-filled people.

One: You call us to unity,

All: But we cling to division.

One: You call us to speak words of life,

All: But we have spoken in anger, silence, or neglect.

One: You breathe courage into Your church,

All: But we shrink back in fear.

One: You send us into the world,

All: Yet we remain comfortable and unmoved.

One: Forgive us, O Lord, for resisting the movement of Your Spirit.

All: Forgive us for grieving Your presence, for ignoring Your prompting, and for failing to love as Christ has loved us.

One: Cleanse our hearts and renew us.

All: Fill us again with holy fire, that we may walk in Your ways, speak Your truth in love, and reflect Your grace to the world. Through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

Day of Pentecost Assurance of Pardon

One: God of mercy and redemption, we gather at Your table on this holy day, remembering the sacrifice of Christ and the gift of Your Spirit.

All: We thank You that through Jesus, our sins are forgiven and we are made new.

One: By His body broken and His blood poured out, we have been reconciled to You.

All: Through His sacrifice, our guilt is removed, our shame is covered, and our lives are restored.

One: Send Your Spirit upon us now, as You did on that first Pentecost day.

All: Sanctify this bread and this cup, and make them for us signs of Your grace.

One: As we receive these gifts, unite us with Christ and with one another.

All: Let Your Spirit dwell within us, transforming our hearts, guiding our lives, and sending us into the world.

One: Make us a people of atonement and reconciliation.

All: That we may embody Your love, proclaim Your truth, and serve Your kingdom with boldness and joy.

(Instructions) All who confess Jesus as Lord are welcome to receive the sacrament of Communion. Wait until all are served so that we may partake together.

This is the table, not merely of the church, but of Christ. It is made ready for those who love him and for those who want to love him more. So, come, whether you have much faith or a little; have tried to follow, or are afraid you have failed. Come, because it is Christ who invites you. It is His will that those who want to, might meet him here.

Blessing and Serving of the Cup

In the same way after supper our Lord Jesus Christ took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it to his disciples saying, "Drink from this, all of you. This is my blood of the new covenant, which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sin. Do this whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me."
