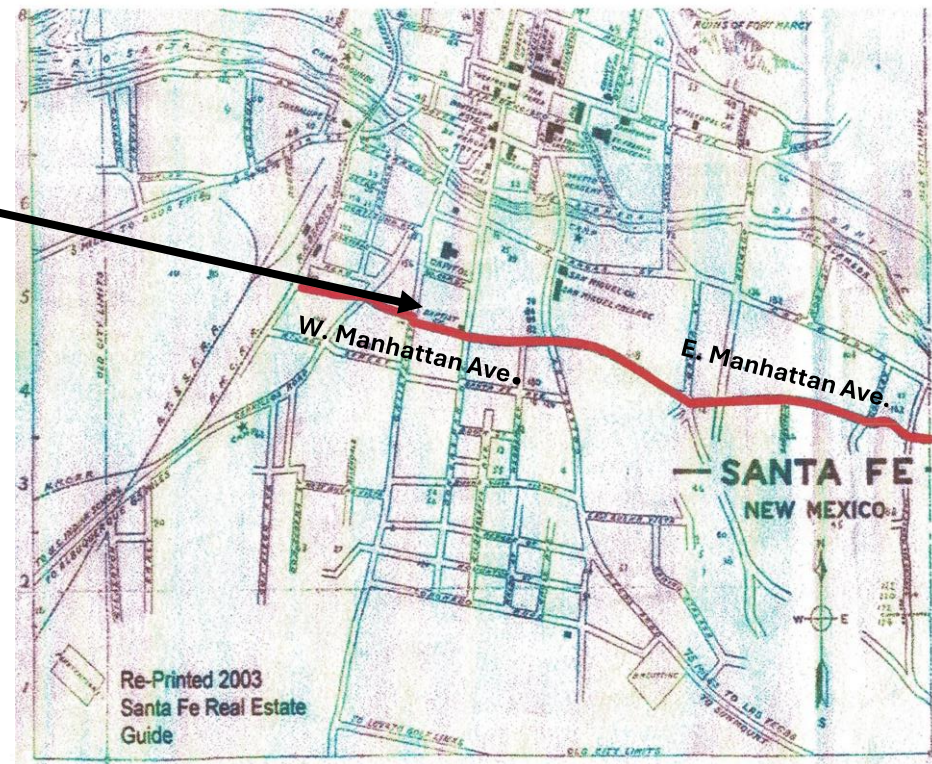

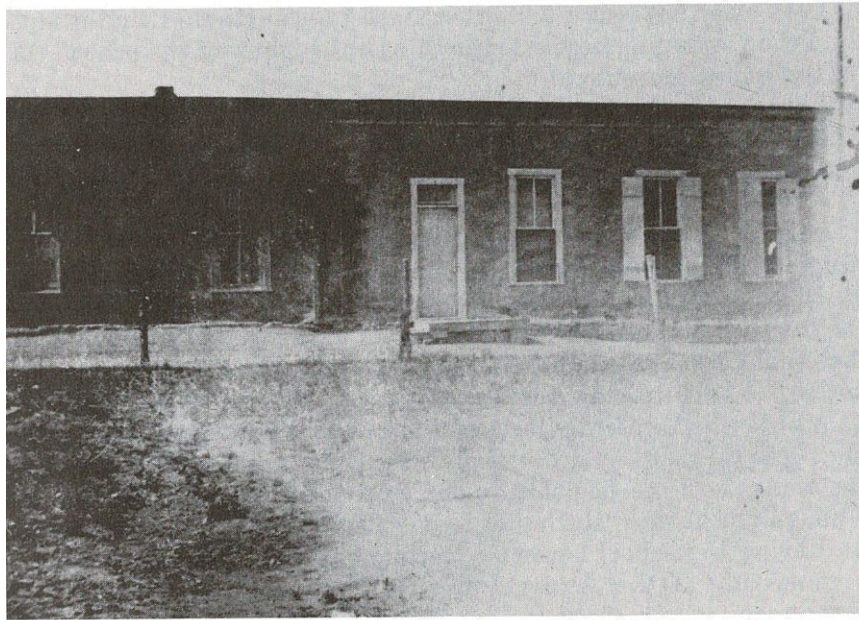
First school on West Manhattan Ave. in 1885. Adobe House that made from oil painting by Elodie Wukadinovich, former art teacher at NMSD School.

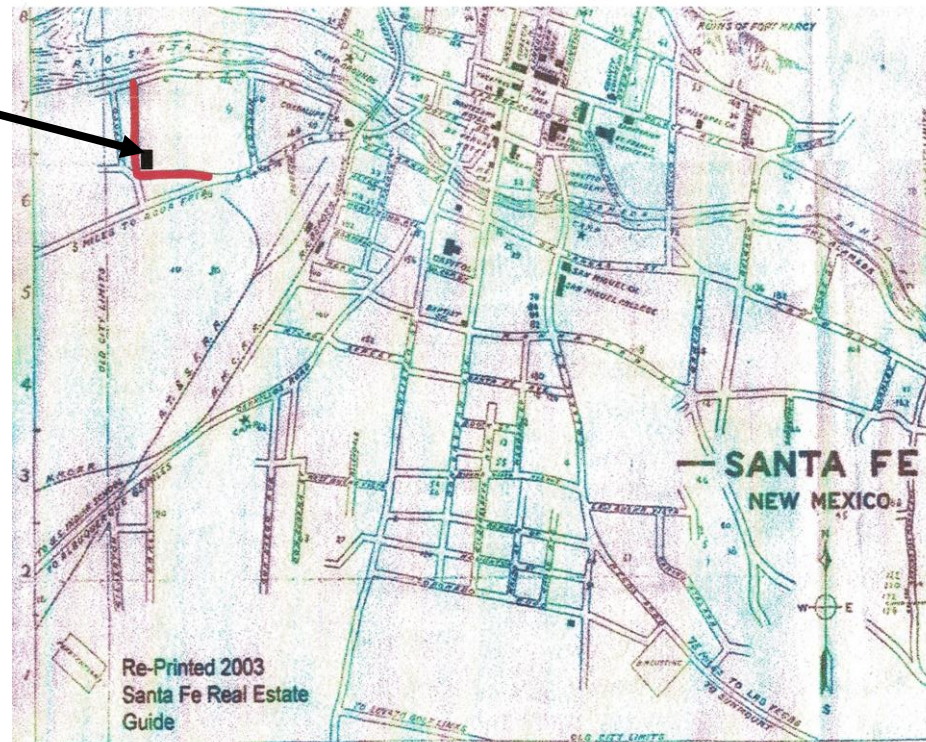

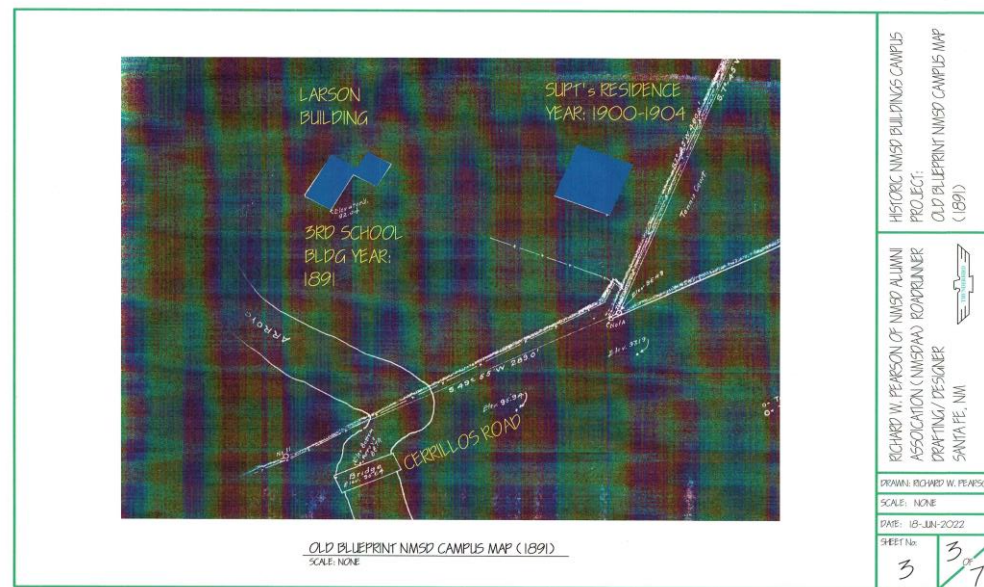

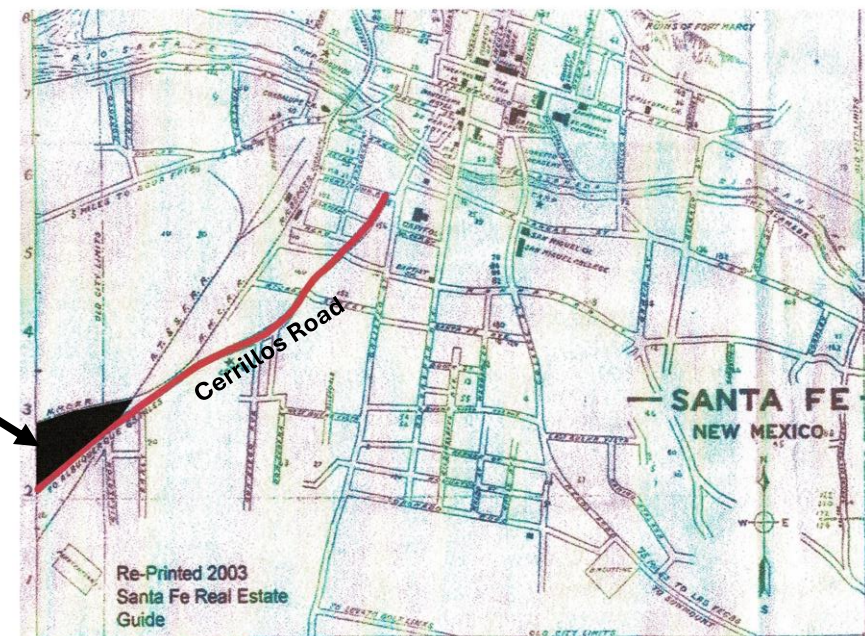




New Computer Aided Design (CAD) overlap old Blueprint NMSD Campus

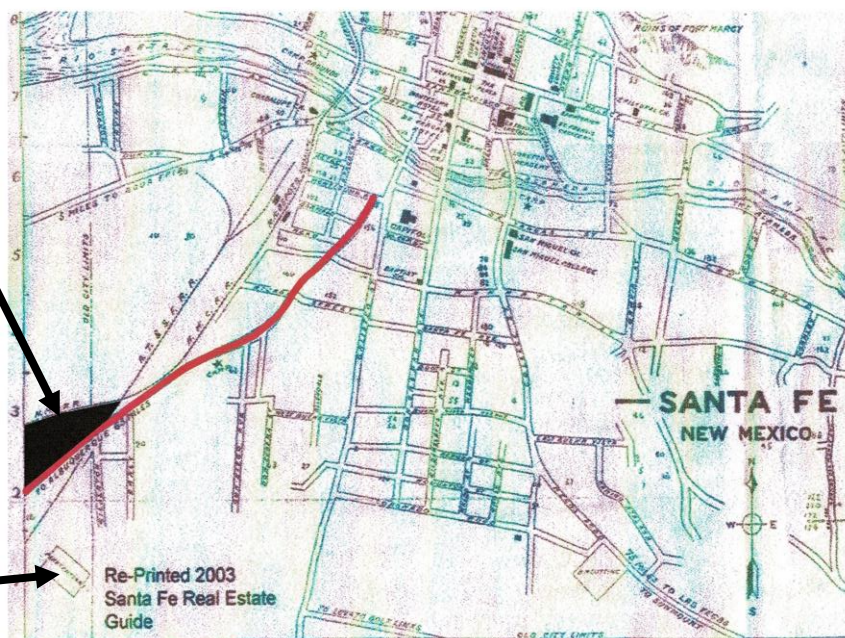

The Front Bricks of Fourth School Building came from the Old Territorial State Prison. Built in 1906 after demolished in 1937. The front campus flagpoles occupied the area until Alumni Memorial Plaza was built in 1987. The original bricks showed on the surface of the Alumni Memorial Plaza Statues.

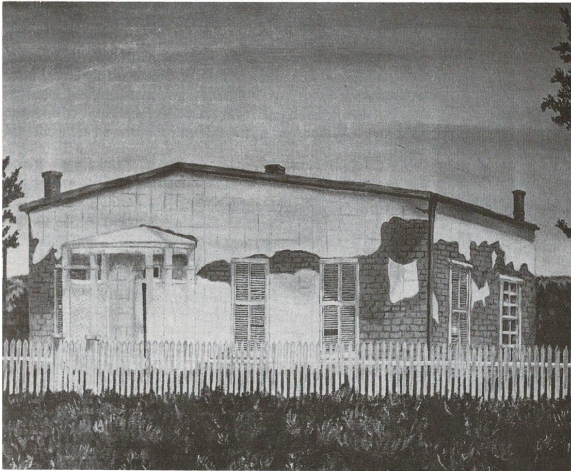
The inmates making bricks at the St. Francis Drive and Cordova Road at the Old Territorial State Prison around 1900. The Prison was demolished after 1956.



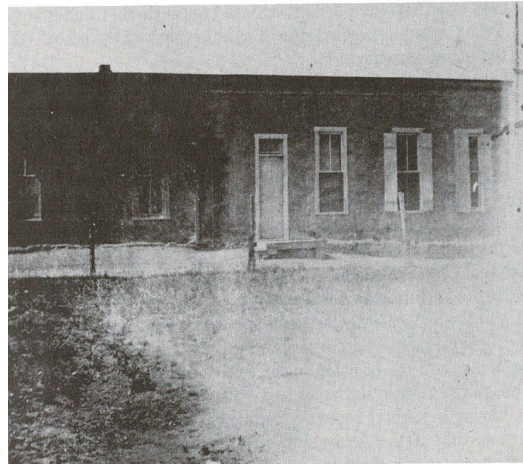

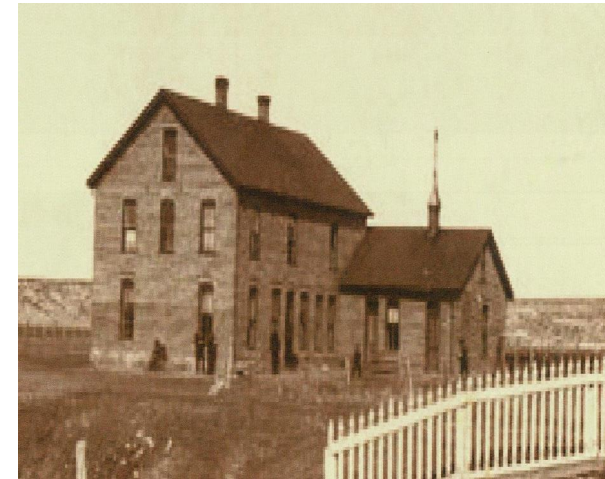

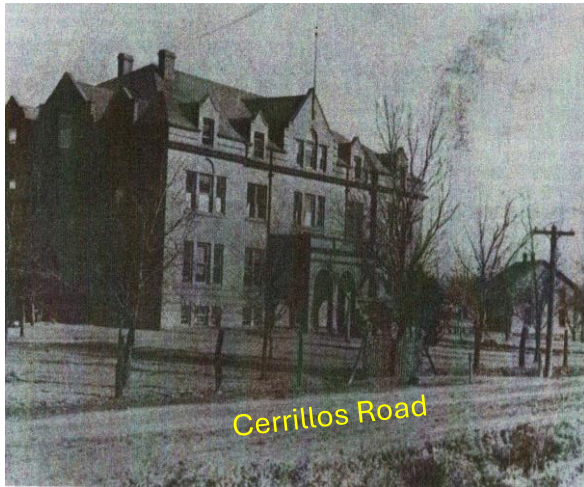

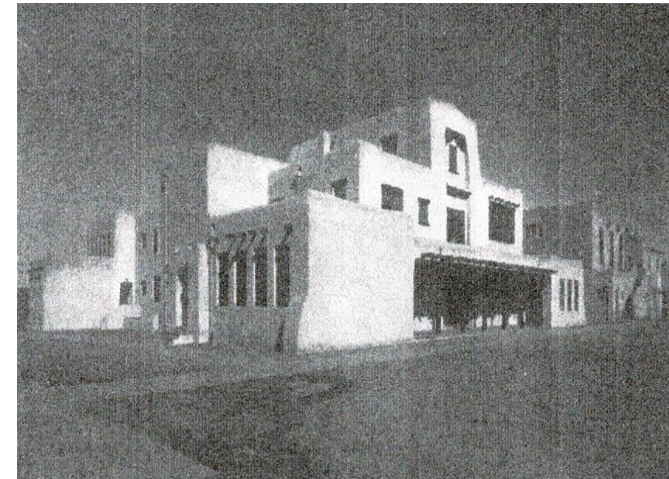

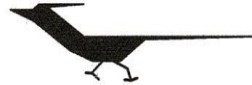

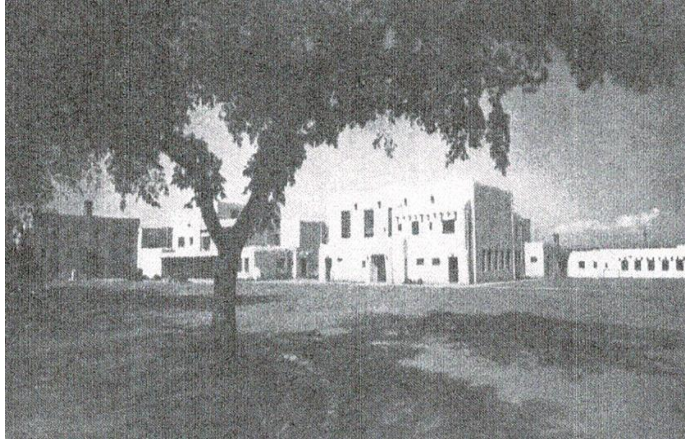

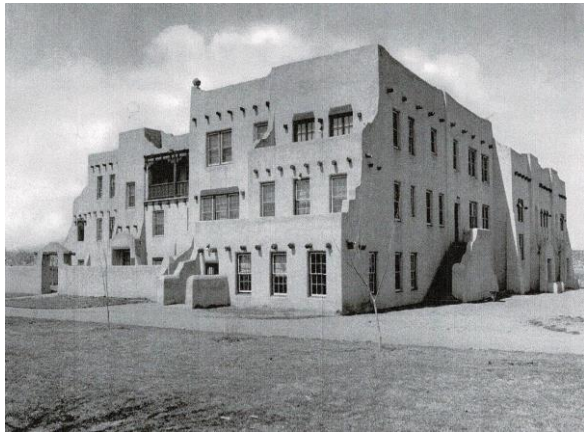

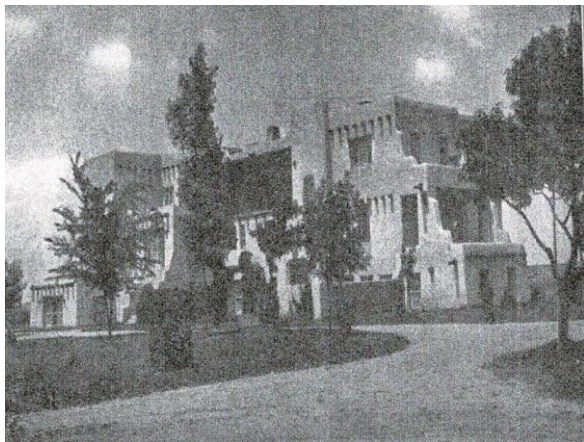

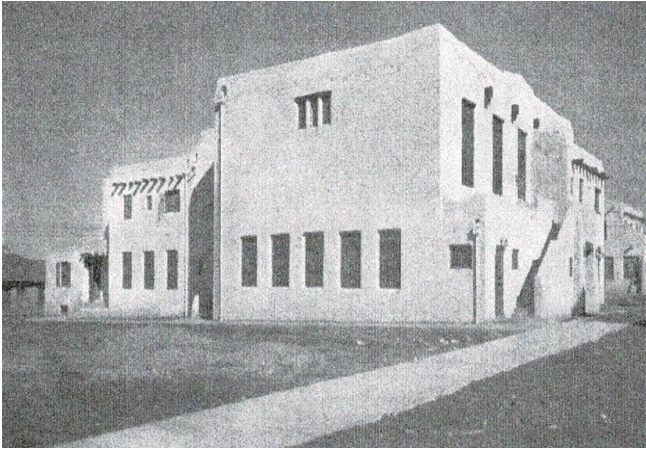

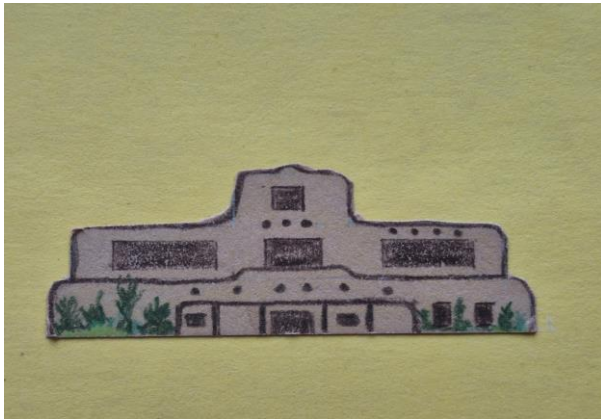

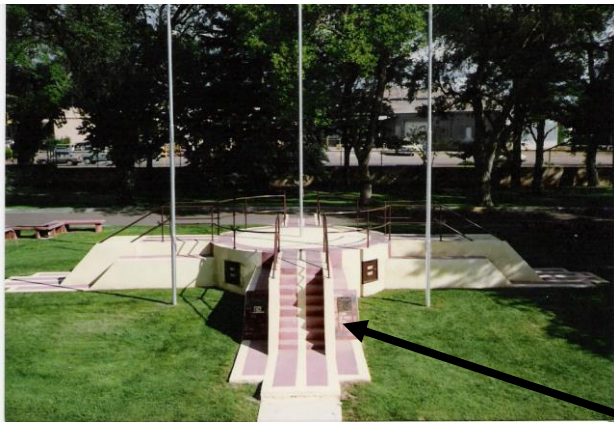

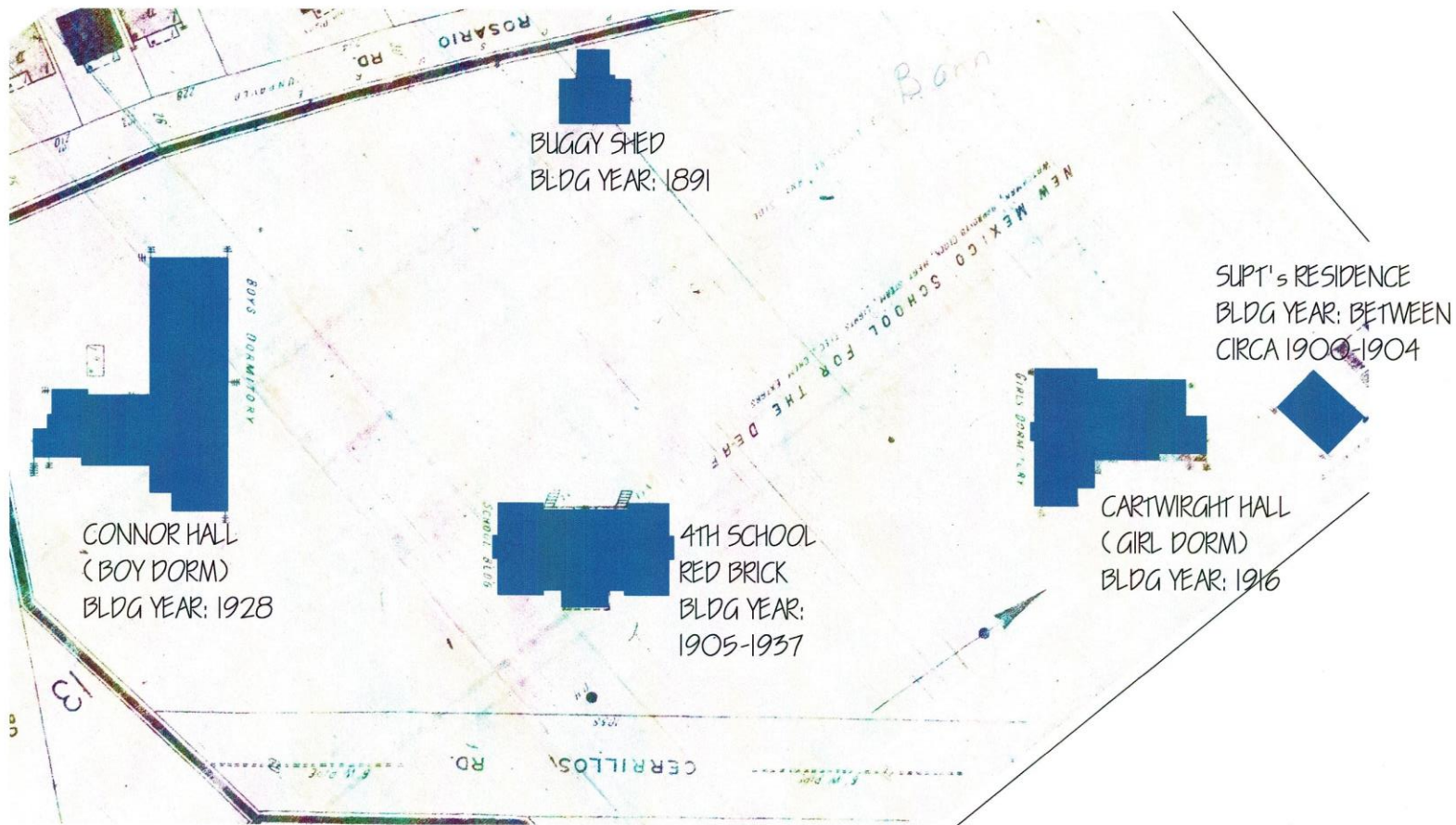

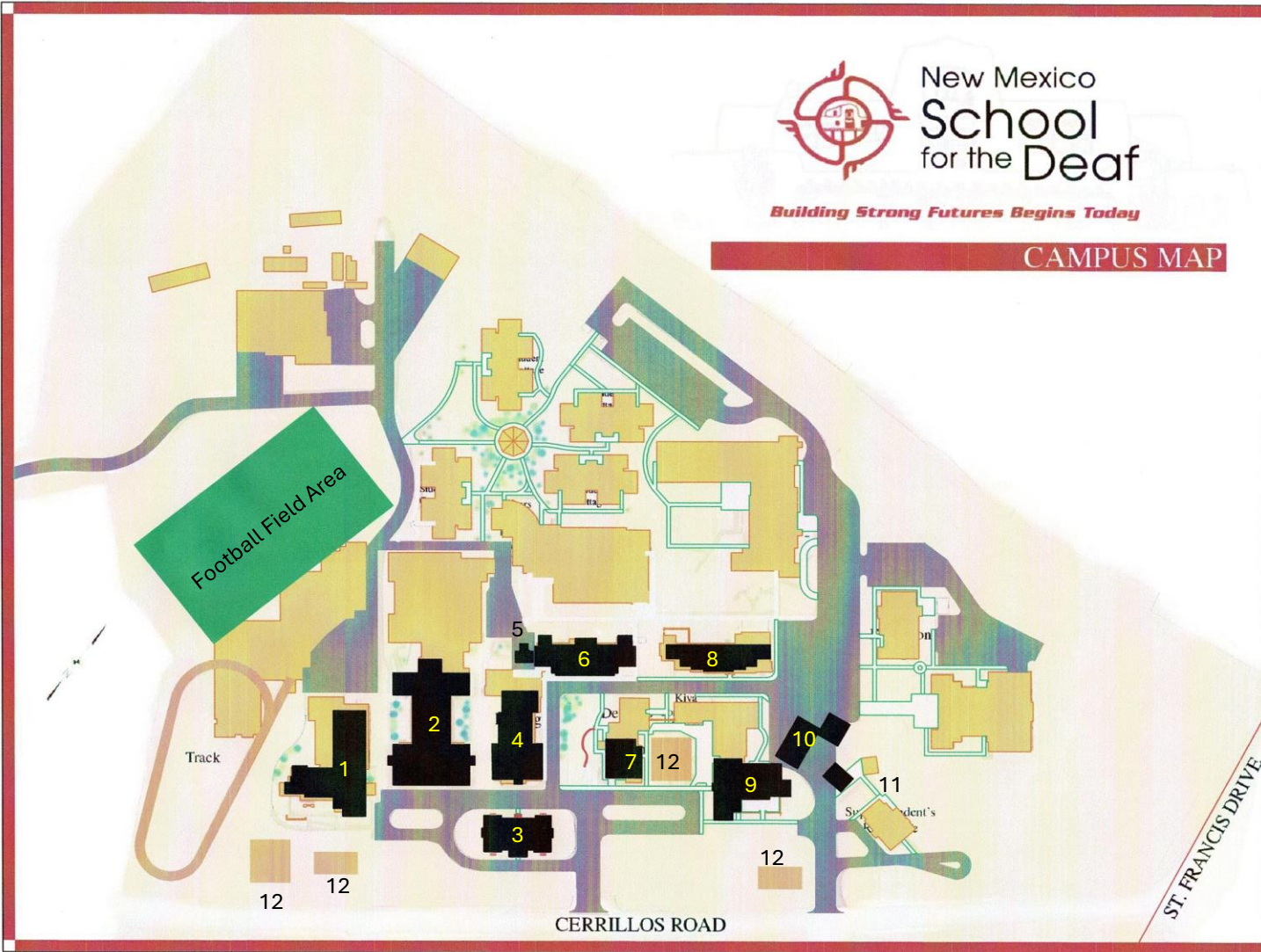

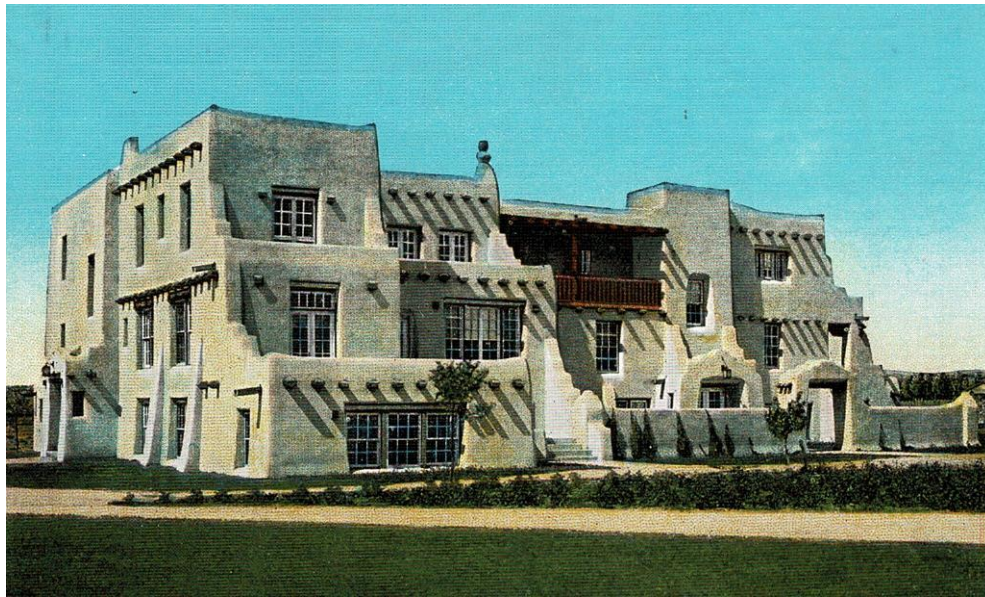

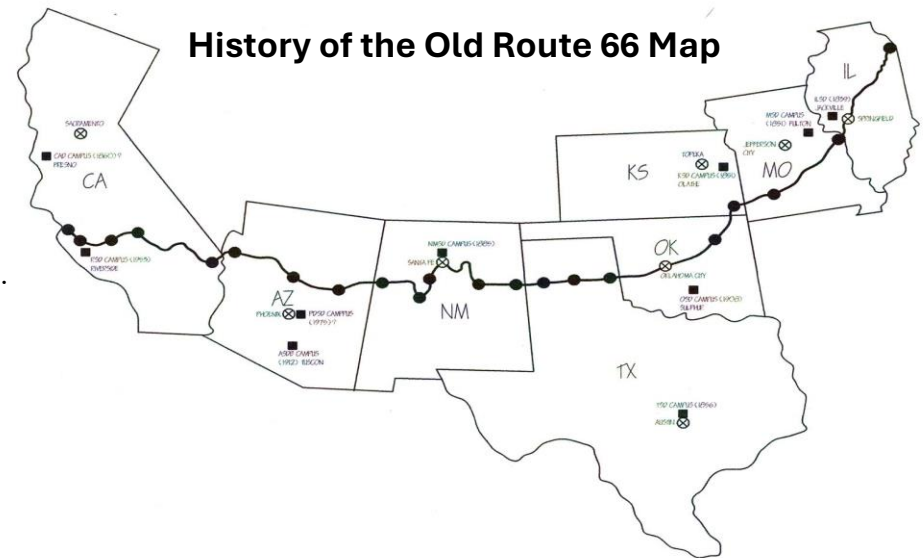

The old Route 66 through downtown Santa Fe between the years of 1926 thru pre-1937 and passed the New Mexico School for the Deaf on the Cerrillos Road. NMSD Campus in Santa Fe Loop is only one of 8 states of the Historic US Route 66. The "Mother Road" was established old Route 66 in 1926 Was 2,448 miles from Chicago to Santa Monica (Los Angles). The other States School for the Deaf campus (Illinois, Missouri, Kansas, Oklahoma, Texas, Arizona, and California) not even closer thru the old Route 66.

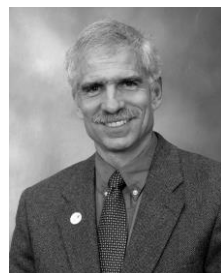

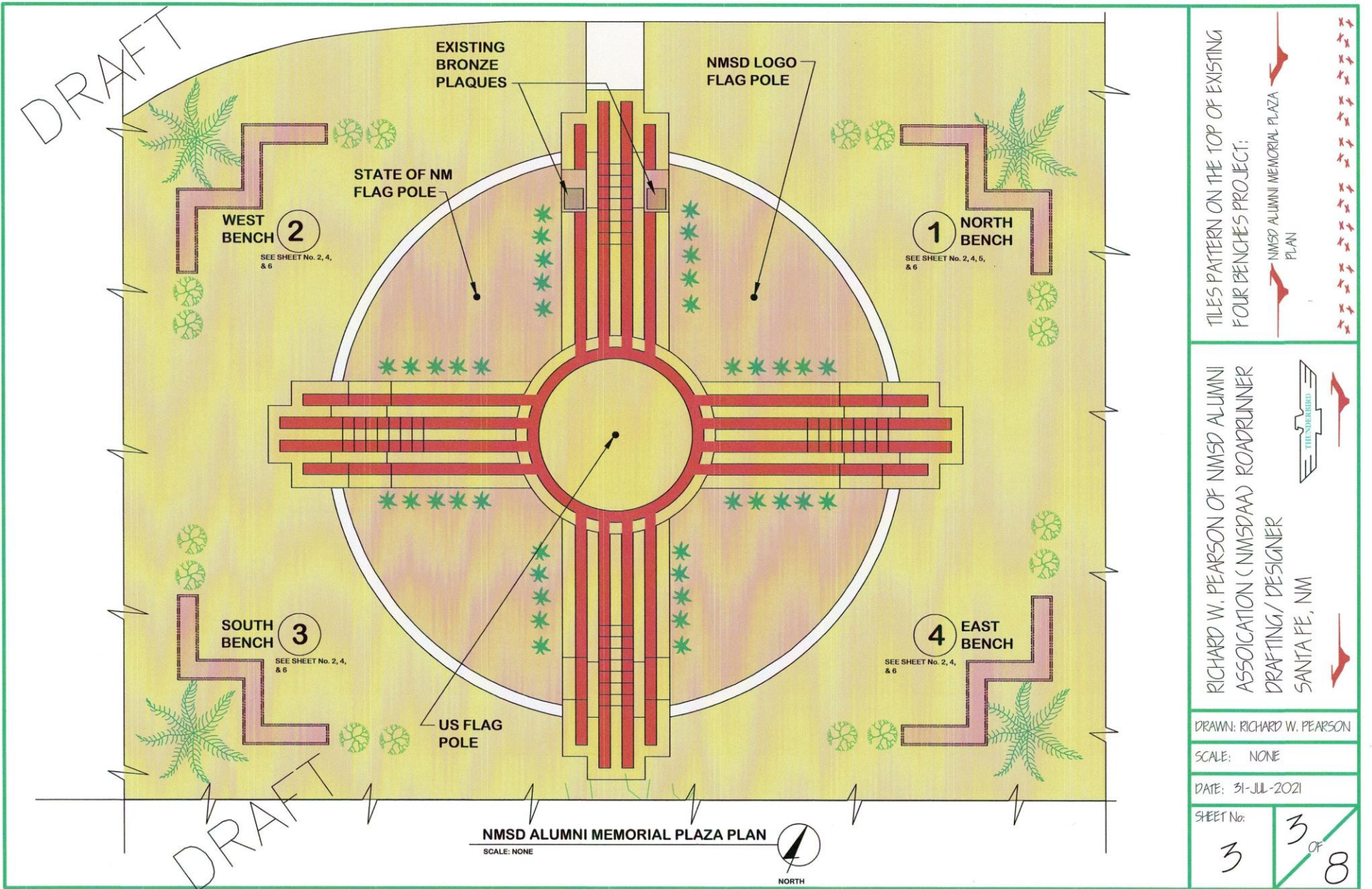
