Greetings from the Friends of Pinson Mounds!

First let me introduce you to our organization. We formed as a 501C3 charity in 2019 for the purpose of supporting the Pinson Mounds State Archeological Park in its mission to preserve, interpret and education the public on the Indigenous Peoples structures within the park and the culture that inspired them. Included among our involvement and support to the state park are:

- ~600 – 800 volunteer hours annually from 2021-2025.
- Volunteers to assist with the park's annual Archeofest festival.
- Sponsorship of the Symphony in the Park event alongside the Jackson Symphony.
- Twice annual park work-days for clean-up and improvement.
- Annual Honey Bee Festival and Honey Harvest for fundraising.
- And many more!

In 2024, we launched our largest program to date to assist the state park in upgrading the museum displays available to the public. This planned upgrade includes a three-dimensional topographic map of the lands within the park and the Indigenous Peoples structures contained within. This display will highlight the results of recent archeological investigation using LIDAR mapping technology to provide detail not previously available. We feel this type of display will be a key addition to the museum to provide the public with a comprehensive overview of the scale and significance of these structures. It will also serve to aid the park staff in interpreting the site to those that may be mobility and sensory impaired and can't venture onto the grounds.

Our hope is to complete fundraising in 2025 through community support and grants. Our need is to raise \$25,000 to achieve this goal. To date, over \$10,000 has been raised and we would like to reach our goal by the end of 2026 to complete this project. We would appreciate any contribution or financial support you would consider.
