




When mom has a minute, she's going to want to sit down and drink her coffee. It's just a small desire... she's not expecting much.





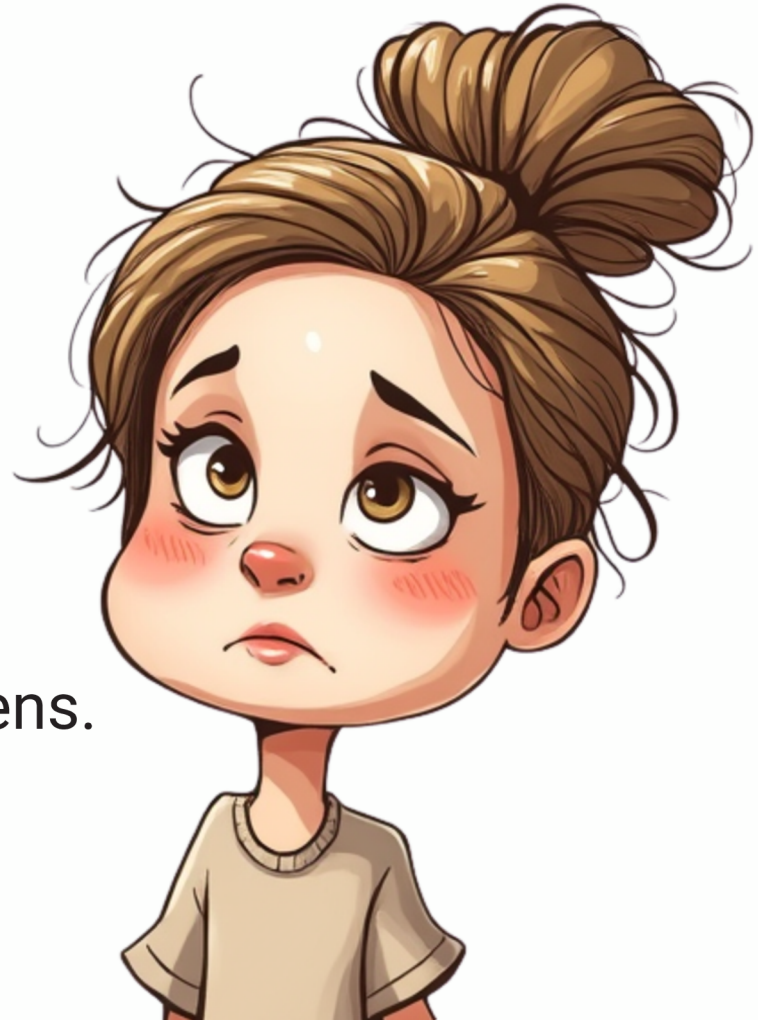


When she pulls the chair out from

socks on the floor.

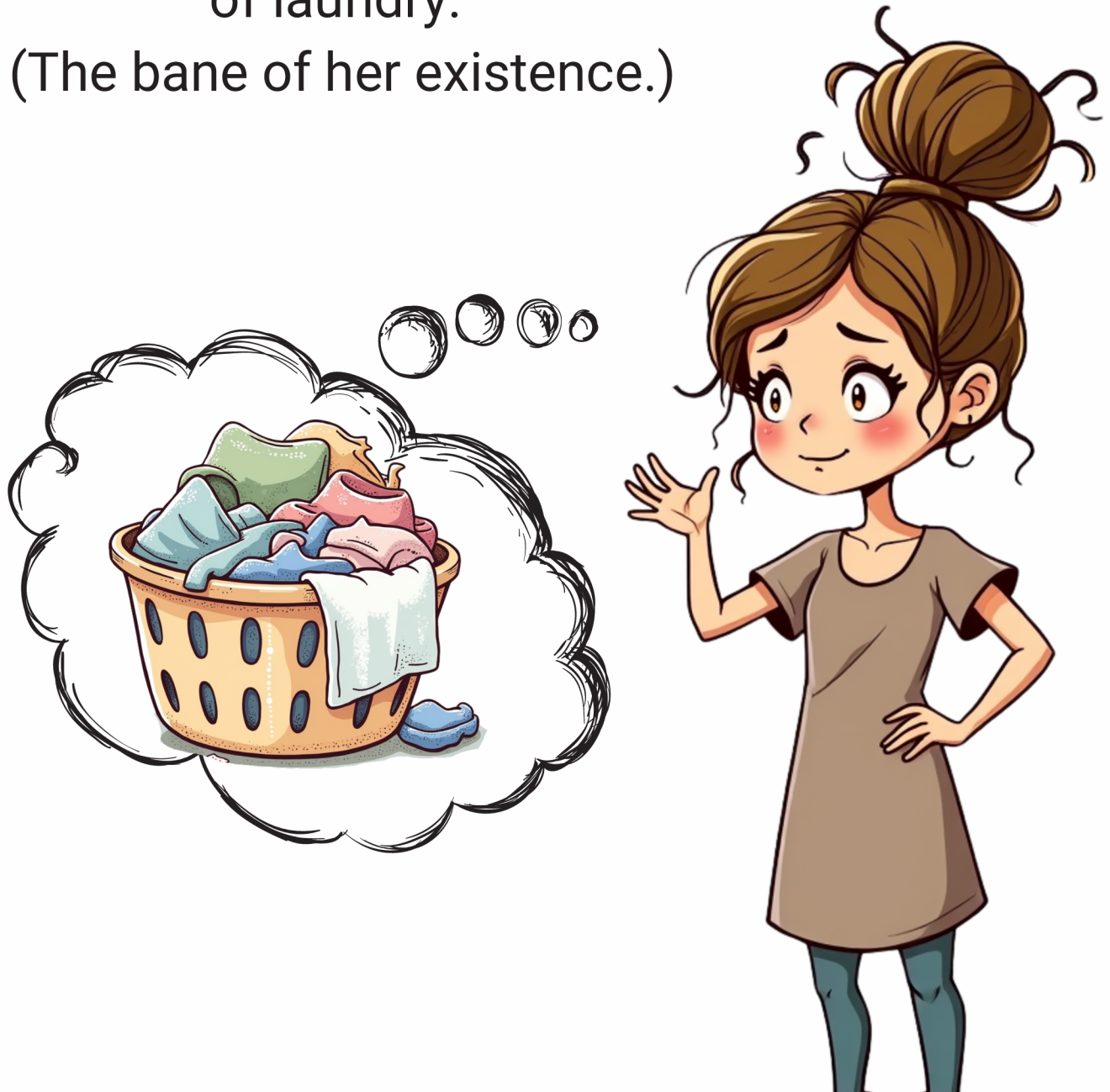
Not that anyone listens.
