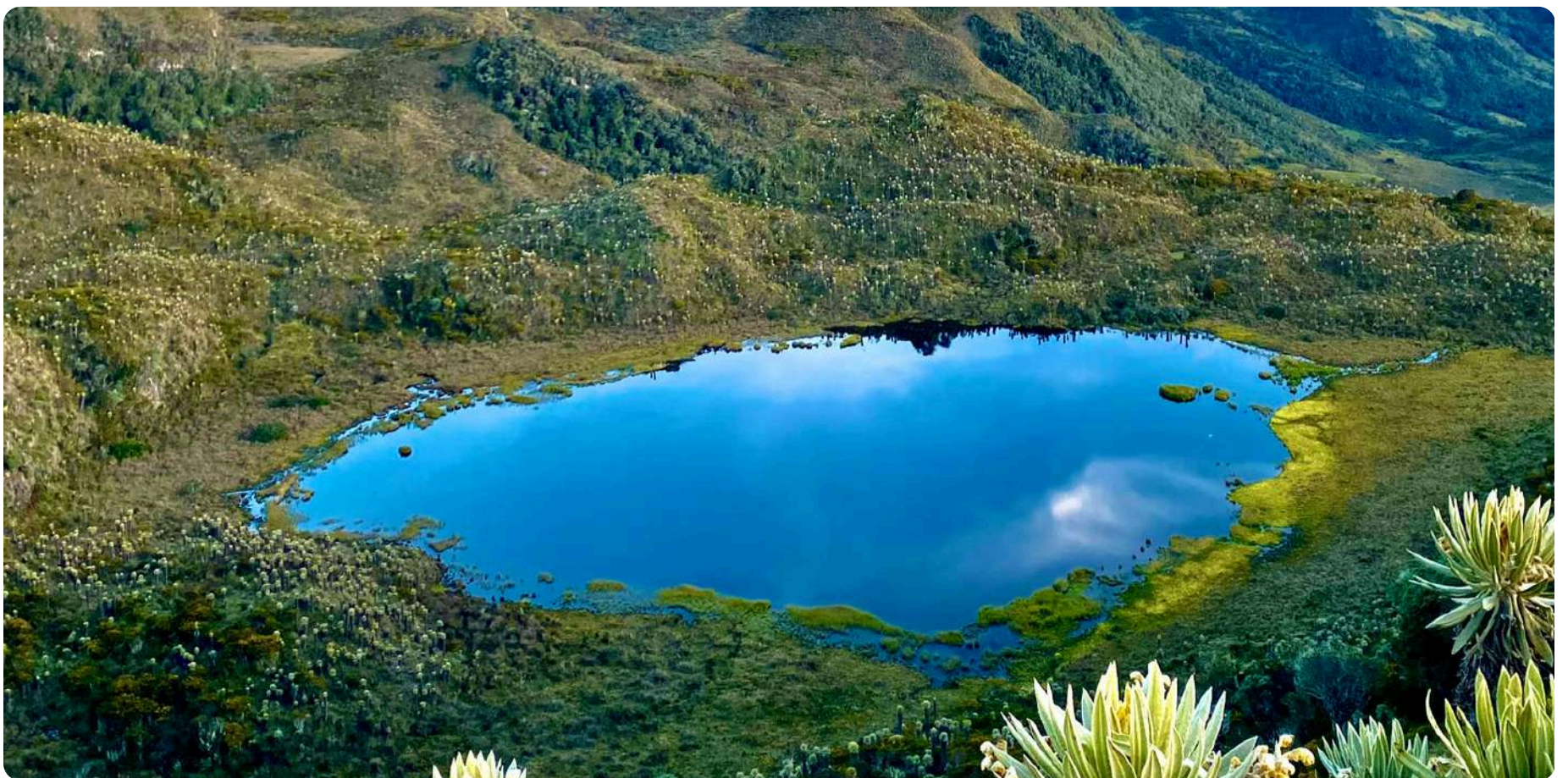
The Heartbeat of the Earth

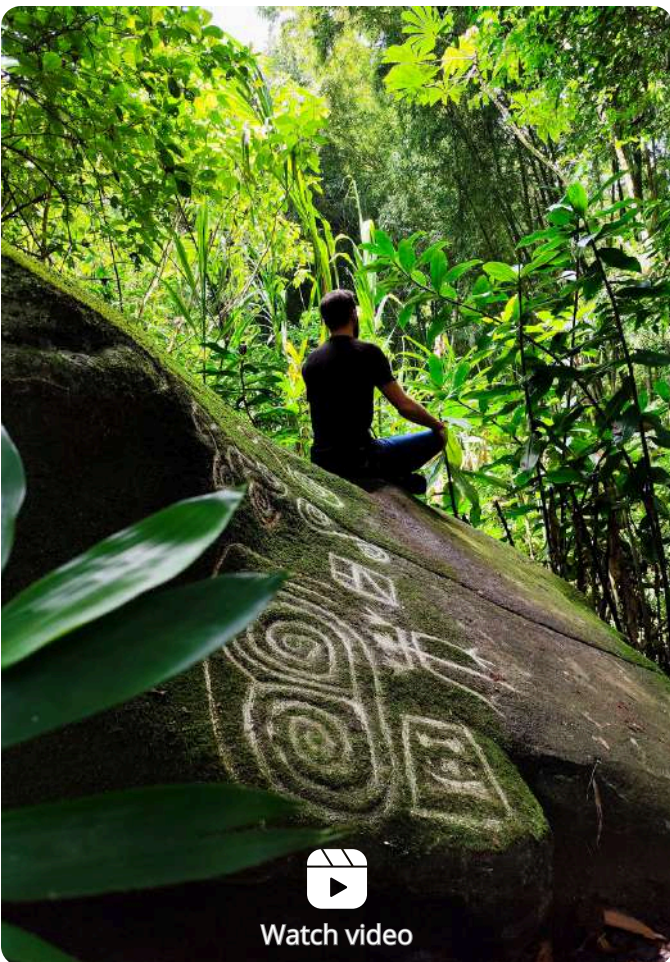

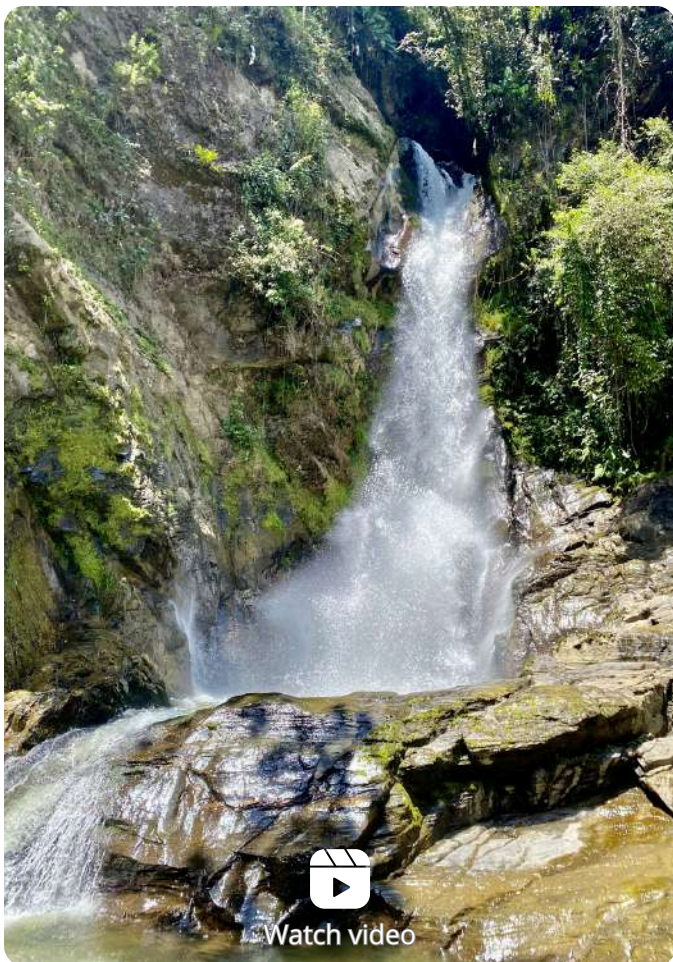

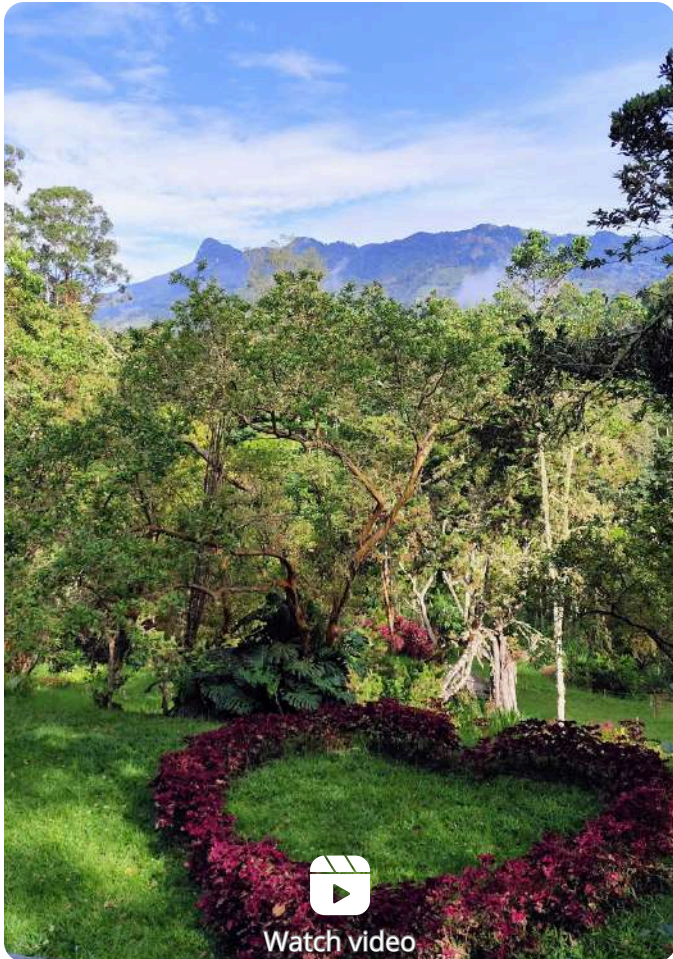

CHAPTER II — STRENGTH & HORIZONS

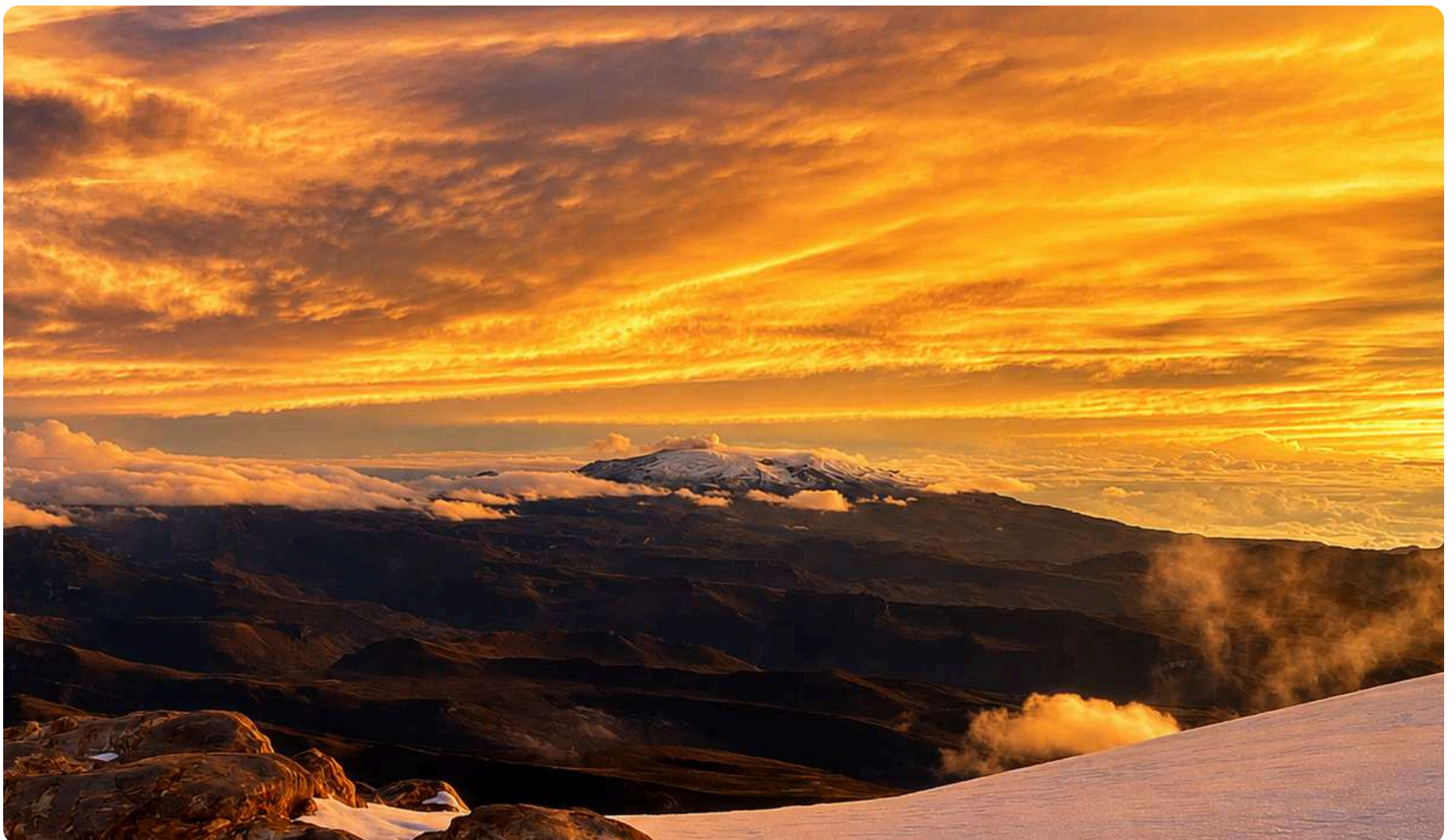

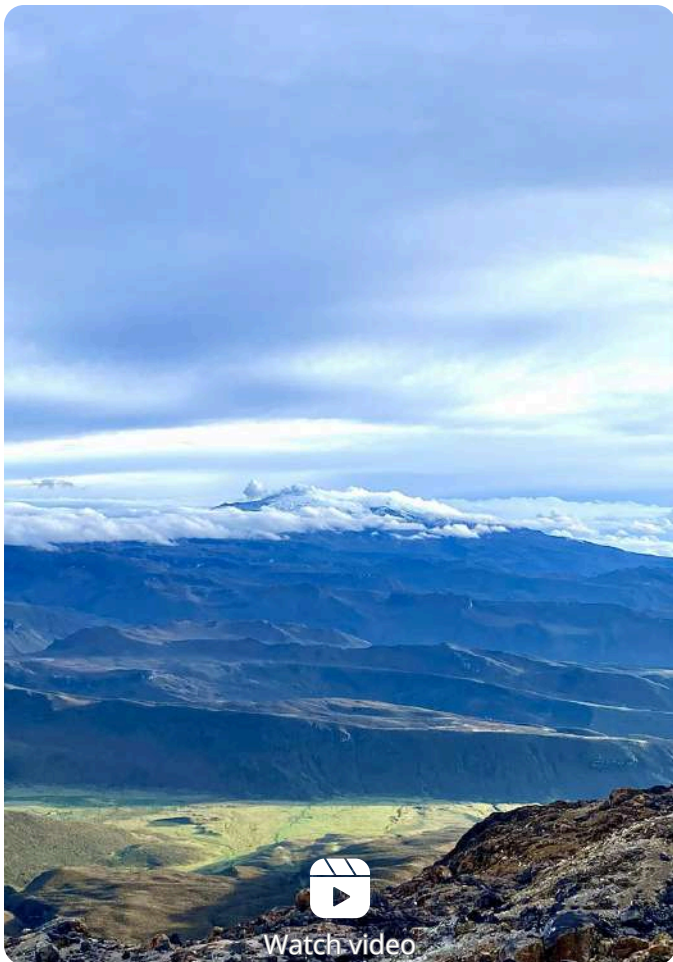
