Skateball

Roller Ball is a team sport played on skates, combining speed, skill, passing, and goal-scoring. Two teams compete to score the most goals using a ball, following clear rules of safety, movement, and fair play.

Roller Basket

Roller Basket is a skating sport inspired by basketball, where players move on skates and score through a hoop. Points are awarded based on shooting zones, and the game emphasizes agility, control, and high-speed movement

Roller Dodge

Roller Dodge is a fast-paced skating game focused on dodging and quick reactions. Two teams compete to eliminate opponents by hitting them with a ball, requiring balance, timing, and sharp reflexes



Refereeing and Basic Rules

Leadership, Committees, and Affiliates of the World Skate Ball Federation

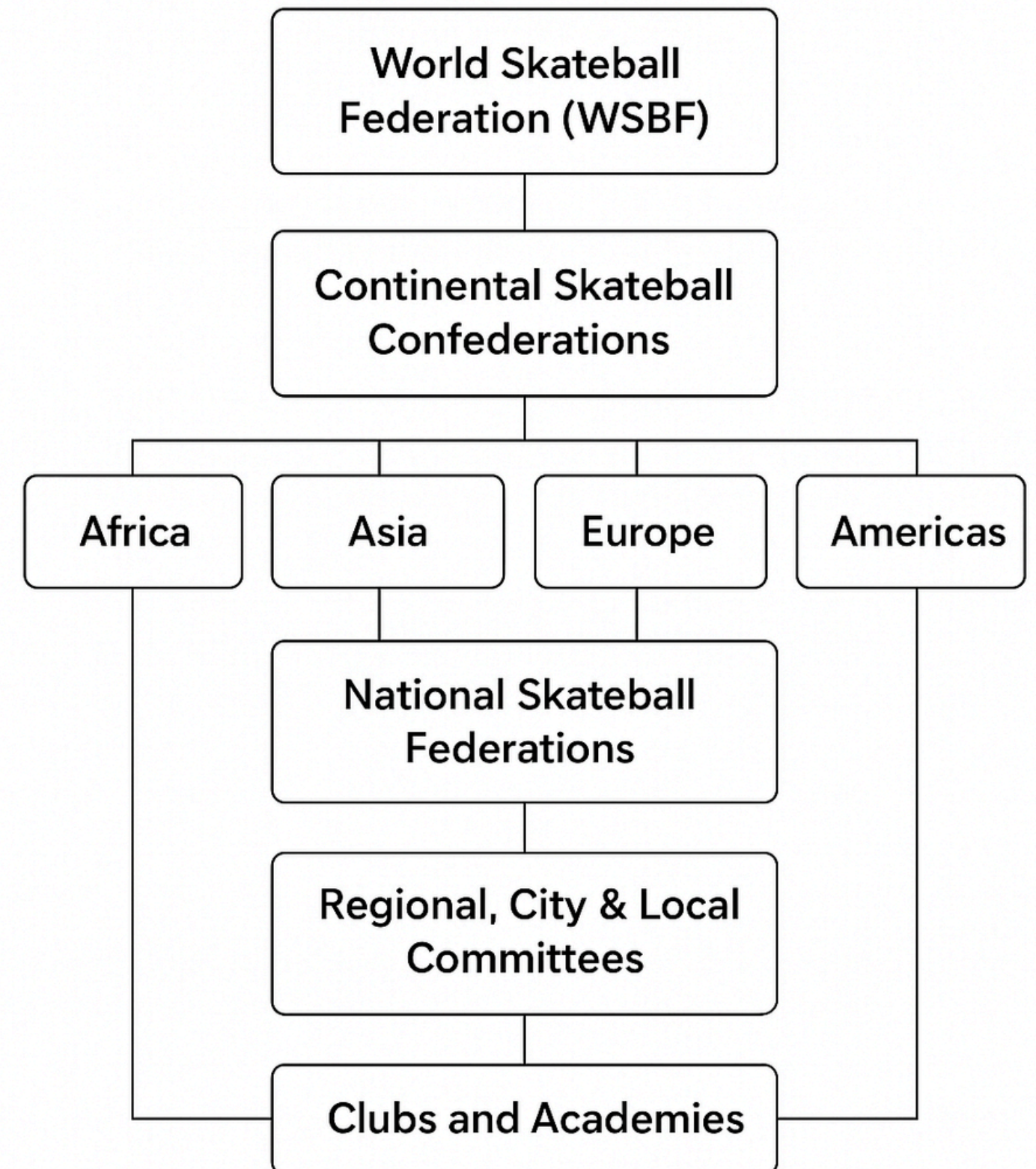
Skateball is governed through a clear three-level system: the World Skateball Federation (WSBF), Continental Confederations, and National Federations.

- WSBF sets the global rules, manages international events, and oversees worldwide development.
- Continental bodies organize regional championships and support member countries.
- National Federations run local leagues, train referees and coaches, and manage national teams.

This structure ensures unified rules, fair competition, and continuous global growth of the sport.
