RESCUED

Luke 22:31-32 KJV

[31] And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: [32] but I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.

RUTHLESS

1 Peter 5:8 KJV

[8] Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

Steal, kill & destroy. The triple fold agenda of your adversary the devil remains constant. He is busy penetrating the different systems on the earth for one single purpose - DEVOUR AS MANY AS POSSIBLE.

The educational systems, the business systems, religious systems, the health systems, the entertainment systems, judiciary systems, marital systems......are adapting patterns which are completely contrary to kingdom standards.

More souls are won but they are won into the kingdom of darkness. Diverse spheres of influences are imparted but imparted with the EVIL ANOINTING. This anointing generates a self sustaining machinery of evil - There works of darkness effortlessly prevail.

Psalms 91:3 AMP

[3] For He will save you from the trap of the fowler, And from the deadly pestilence.

Fowlers have invested time in studying the path of wild birds. So they know exactly where to position their traps, so that these while birds walk straight into it. For a trap to be effective, it needs to look harmless or even go unnoticed by the targeted prey. Also when a trap is set, the fowler monitors his trap from a hidden corner. He does not just set the trap and abandon it. He watches over his trap, to ensure that it is effective.

Not every attack from the kingdom of darkness looks like an attack initially.

The kingdom of darkness is very organized. Their monitoring demons, very meticulous. They do not just attack you blindly. They take time to study and understand your path. So that they know exactly at what point to place their evil traps.

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

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PERCEPTION - ACTION - REACTION

Matthew 8:8-12 KJV [8] The centurion answered and said,

Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed. [9] For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it. [10] When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel. [11] And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven. [12] But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. 11

The centurion's action towards Jesus, revealed his true perception about Jesus. He wasn't coming after Jesus, with the mindset to TEST AND SEE, if Jesus could really heal his servant. As a matter of fact, he saw Jesus beyond His healing ministry. He recognized Jesus as the SOVEREIGN AUTHORITY. As a result of his perception of Jesus, his actions towards Jesus were influenced accordingly. He said no need to come to my home, you can heal her with your WORD OF AUTHORITY.

No one had ever taught this centurion to act in this manner - HIS ACTIONS WERE COMPLETELY INFLUENCED BY HIS GENUINE PERCEPTION OF JESUS. Actions reveal perception. The true value, reverence and trust you have in Jesus is revealed daily in your actions. Do you truly act in a manner that reveals Jesus as Lord over every area of your life?

October 7 PERCEPTION-ACTION-REACTION

Matthew 13:54-58 KJV [54] And when he was

[54] And when he was come into his own country, he taught them in their synagogue, insomuch that they were astonished, and said, Whence hath this man this wisdom, and these mighty works? [55] Is not this the carpenter's son? is not his mother called Mary? and his brethren, James, and Joses, and Simon, and Judas? [56] And his sisters, are they not all with us? Whence then hath this man all these things? [57] And they were offended in him. But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, save in his own country, and in his own house. [58] And he did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief.

If you see Jesus as "The the son of the carpenter", you will receive furniture from Him. If you see Jesus as "The son of God", you will receive salvation, healing, deliverance, breakthrough, empowerment, wisdom, direction.....much more, from Him.

It was the same Jesus who went about healing all who were oppressed of the devil. This same Jesus was present in his hometown but yet he did not do "many mighty works" there, because of their perception of him.

What is your perception of Jesus whom you read about from your Bible? Do you just see him as a religious entity? What is your heartfelt perception of the one you call LORD AND SAVIOR?

"..... because it's familiar does not make it regular"

"Who do you say I am ?"..... Jesus is asking.

THE ANOINTING OF PRAYER

Isaiah 50:4-5 AMP

[4] ¶The Lord God has given Me [His Servant] the tongue of disciples [as One who is taught], That I may know how to sustain the weary with a word. He awakens Me morning by morning, He awakens My ear to listen as a disciple [as One who is taught]. [5] The Lord God has opened My ear, And I have not been rebellious Nor have I turned back.

The trajectory of Prayer is not from "Man to God" it is from "God to man". I speak of the dimension of prayer called "The sweet fellowship of The Holy Spirit". This is the dimension which the prophet Isaiah tasted when he spoke in the verse above. To everyone is given the "hour of summoning". A time when the anointing of the sweet fellowship of

The Holy Spirit wakes you up to pray. The prophet's ear was opened by God to hear Him. He was not rebellious to the awakening of The Lord at His hour of summoning. So he was taught by God and his tongue spoke great wisdom.

Do you rebel at your hour of summoning?

When you wake up suddenly and feel the urge to pray but yet you go back to sleep. You reset your alarm to pray when you think it is most convenient for you. You perceive a leadership from within to pray at a particular time of the day yet you keep covering up with layers of excuses. Your hour of summoning is your most fruitful time to pray. In that hour, God is the one coming after you. He invites you to teach you and talk with you. The strength of the tongue is the ear. If you won't hear Him (God), your tongue will be impotent. This is why many pray but only few make POWER AVAILABLE.

SPIRIT - CARRIABLE

Ezekiel 37:1 KJV

[1] The hand of the LORD was upon me, and carried me out in the spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley which was full of bones,

Have you ever woken up from a dream and it felt so real? As though you were literally there. Infact you when you woke up, you were even surprised to still find yourself in bed? When you woke up, you even felt like you just entered back into your body - It felt like you woke up suddenly and forcefully. These are not just dreams. They are visions. These revelations carry great meaning. This is God trying to communicate a particular thing to you. The spirit of a man is the candle of The Lord. When God wants to reveal things

to you, He speaks to your spirit. Daily activities distract a lot of people and this weighs on their spirits. It makes it difficult for the spirit of men to hear and see what God is trying to show them.

So God chooses the time when He can have the undivided attention of your spirit - so that He can light it up with His revelation and show you the things He wants you to know. This is usually when you are asleep. When your body is asleep, the weight of distractions upon your spirit is significantly reduced.

Practicing praying and meditating on God's word just before you sleep is very important. It makes you "HOLY SPIRIT - CARRIABLE". This means that The HOLY SPIRIT easily accesses your spirit - He can easily transport you to grounds of revelation and show you the things He seeks to reveal to you. A disciplined life of prayer keeps the antenna of your visions up.

OPTIONS

Deuteronomy 30:19-20 AMP [19] I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you today, that I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse; therefore, you shall choose life in order that you may live, you and your descendants, [20] by loving the Lord your God, by obeying His voice, and by holding closely to Him; for He is your life [your good life, your abundant life, your fulfillment] and the length of your days, that you may live in the land which the Lord promised (swore) to give to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob."

At every point in time, you have options to choose from. 1,2,3,.....10 options? Maybe, but there are always options. You are reading this devotional right now but you could choose to do

something else - watching a movie, scrolling through Facebook, sleeping, eating, doing laundry etc

You can choose to keep a bad company of friends or you can choose not to. You can choose to serve God or you can choose not to. You can choose to study your Bible or you can choose not to. You can choose to be obedient to God or you can choose not to. Choices are made out of options.

Every option falls under either of this categories - LIFE OR DEATH. Every choice you make will either keep you alive or draw you closer to death. You must think wisely before making your daily choices. Every option which is not in conformity to God's word, is an option which leads to death. Options born out of obedience to God are options which bring life - Jesus is the way, the truth and the life. Choose Him always.

October 11 OPTIONS 2

Deuteronomy 30:19-20 AMP [19] I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you today, that I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse; therefore, you shall choose life in order that you may live, you and your descendants, [20] by loving the Lord your God, by obeying His voice, and by holding closely to Him; for He is your life [your good life, your abundant life, your fulfillment] and the length of your days, that you may live in the land which the Lord promised (swore) to give to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob."

God has placed 2 bold options before you - Life or death? He encourages you to choose life. To "choose life" goes beyond you saying "I choose life". In the verse above, God clearly expantiates

on what it truly means to "choose life". God explained 3 things - as seen in verse 20:

- 1) By loving The Lord your God
- 2) By obeying His voice
- 3) By holding closely to Him

Do you love God? Are you completely obedient to His voice (His word)? Do you have a close relationship with God? Are you fully dependent on Him. If your answers to these 4 questions are yes, yes, yes and yes, then it means you have "chosen life" indeed.

God does not just want you to live, He wants you to experience "Life in abundance". God wants you to enjoy the same quality of His life and to enjoy it in full - Nothing missing, nothing broken.

As you continue to do those 3 things listed above, you will be full of life.

OPTIONS 3

Deuteronomy 30:19-20 AMP [19] I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you today, that I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse; therefore, you shall choose life in order that you may live, you and your descendants, [20] by loving the Lord your God, by obeying His voice, and by holding closely to Him; for He is your life [your good life, your abundant life, your fulfillment] and the length of your days, that you may live in the land which the Lord promised (swore) to give to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob."

When you choose life (choose to love God, obey Him & hold closely to Him), you are actually making a choice that lives after you. The verse above says "you shall choose life in order that you

may live. You and your descendants."

Life or death could be the inheritance in a genealogical lineage. If your parents, grandparents or greatgrand parents chose life - it will almost be like a family custom for your present generation to love God , obey Him and depend on Him. The "life of God" can be handed down from generation to generation.

When you understand this, your choices from the daily options which stare at you in the face, will be intentional. You will make daily decisions that will keep you "walking in the life of God." Lois, the grandmother of Timothy, set the standards for her descendants. Nothing was said about the generations before Lois. She was the cut of point - she introduced a transgenerational order of life - this flowed unto her descendants - Timothy -The spiritual son of the great Apostle -Paul. What order are you setting for your descendants?

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Discipline - A Watch Dog

Hebrews 12:1 AMP

[1] Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses [who by faith have testified to the truth of God's absolute faithfulness], stripping off every unnecessary weight and the sin which so easily and cleverly entangles us, let us run with endurance and active persistence the race that is set before us,

Athletes run as light as possible. Every extra pound, produces a minus speed. To maintain the required speed, they maintain the required weight. To maintain the required weight, they maintain the required discipline. Discipline on when to eat, when not to eat, what to eat, what not to eat, when to exercise, how to exercise, kind of exercise, what to drink,

what not to drink.....the list is endless. This thick rod of discipline they endure is to achieve their desired goal - To win the race.

As a Christian, you are like an athlete. Your christian journey can be likened to a race. The verse says "stripping off every unnecessary weight and the sin which so easily and cleverly entangles us" The process of weight loss is one of discipline. No one attempting to lose weight maintains an indiscipline lifestyle. If you must go through your christian race successfully - fight the good fight, finish the race and keep the faith - YOU MUST BE DISCIPLINED.

Disciplined in prayers, disciplined in Bible study, disciplined in mentorship, disciplined in sleep, disciplined in the kind of friends you keep, disciplined in the places you go to, disciplined in time management, disciplined in character....be disciplined 24/7.

Discipline - A Watch Dog

Hebrews 12:1 AMP

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Now let's talk about the sin which so easily and cleverly entangles us, as written in the verse above. Everyone has a "weak point". Something which easily entices and has the power to get you hooked, if not well mastered. For some people it's taking alcohol - sometimes they go overboard and consume to much - which makes them misbehave.

For others it's gluttoning - they eat so much - throughout the day and night -in large quantities - this makes them so heavy - feel sleepy during the day and cannot wake up early to pray.

For some, it's watching movies. It hits like an addiction. They can watch movies for 5 hours non-stop but cannot pray for you to 5 minutes. This makes the movies their idol - they practice idolatry ignorantly.


You need to study yourself to know your "weak point". This is what it means to be a step ahead of your enemy. If you know your weak point and master it so well - it will become your strong point. Esau did not know he had a weak point of jealousy. He failed to master it and it entangled him. Apostle Paul proclaimed that he disciplines his body and masters it, so that he will not fall after preaching to others. Train your self to be led by The Holy Spirit not the desires of your flesh.

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Discipline - A Watch Dog

Hebrews 12:2 AMP

[2] [looking away from all that will distract us and] focusing our eyes on Jesus, who is the Author and Perfecter of faith [the first incentive for our belief and the One who brings our faith to maturity], who for the joy [of accomplishing the goal] set before Him endured the cross, disregarding the shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God [revealing His deity, His authority, and the completion of His work]. [Ps 110:1]

Before you can have a clear view of a specimen with a microscope, you need to focus the lens of your microscope adequately. For the scientist to focus the lens, he needs to intentionally "look away" from the surrounding objects

which are in his visual field. Apart from his specimen, every other object in his visual field is a distraction to him at that time. The process of "focusing" are the intentional steps taken by him - ignoring all other objects - and fixing his eyes on that one specimen.

In the visual field of your life, you have many distracting objects. However, you are called upon as written in today's verse ,to fix your eyes on Jesus. Just like the scientist, this process is not automatic. You will have to go through the process of "focusing" . Focusing your eyes on Jesus entails that you ignore all the distractions on your visual field and keep your eyes only on Jesus. The intentional steps taken to ignore distractions are found only on the staircase of discipline. WITHOUT DISCIPLINE YOU CANNOT FOCUS YOUR EYES ON JESUS. It is an intentional climb - you will go through this staircase everyday - so you can stay focused.

Discipline - A Watch Dog

Hebrews 12:2 AMP

[2] [looking away from all that will distract us and] focusing our eyes on Jesus, who is the Author and Perfecter of faith [the first incentive for our belief and the One who brings our faith to maturity], who for the joy [of accomplishing the goal] set before Him endured the cross, disregarding the shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God [revealing His deity, His authority, and the completion of His work]. [Ps 110:1]

A distraction is only a distraction because it has the power to take you off focus. This calls for premeditation and applied wisdom. A set of calculatory operations must be engaged. Newtons 3rd law of motion states " for every

action, there is an equal but opposite reaction ". One force is the "action" and the other is the "reaction". These paired forces are always equal in strength and opposite in direction. When you set out in spiritual motion and take the action of "focusing" on Jesus, there is a reaction lurking by called distraction. According to the spiritual laws of motion, you must apply the AR3 formula to the action force (focus). This gives you power to surpress the reaction force (distraction).

AR3 = Anticipate, Recognize, Resist & Refire.

We will expound more on this formula in tomorrow's oracle. But I want you to note that the AR3 formula is enforced by discipline. Discipline is the antidote for distraction. No matter how widespread the venom of distractions maybe in your life, GET UP AND APPLY DISCIPLINE.

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"A" in AR3

2 Corinthians 2:11 AMP [11] to keep Satan from taking advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his schemes.

The A in the AR3 formula stands for ANTICIPATE. The above verse admonishes us not to be ignorant of the schemes of Satan. It further explains that if we are ignorant - satan will take advantage of us.

The schemes of the adversary are not always "big things". Most times he utilizes "small things". He knows that you are up & alert, ready to cast and bind the "big things" in prayer - which gives you an urge over him - paralyzing his strategies against you.

One of the "small things" the adversary can use against you are DISTRACTIONS. Distractions are often very subtle and usually do not get noticed by the believer as a potential scheme of Satan. But Satan understands the power that a single distraction can have against you.

It took only one distraction from Delilah to render brother Samson a captive to his enemies. The same enemies he has been given great authority to subdue. All Satan is working hard to do, is to entice you with something potent enough that will distract you from looking at your focus - Jesus.

When you anticipate that distractions may come, then you will enforce your guard against what looks like a distraction in your life. Don't get comfortable with anything which dilutes your focus on Jesus.

"R1" in AR3

2 Corinthians 2:11 AMP [11] to keep Satan from taking advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his schemes.

The R1 in the AR3 formula stands for RECOGNIZE. If you can recognize a potential distraction, then you can avoid it. You cannot stop what you do not know. You cannot overcome what you have not yet perceived.

Your adversary loves his plans to remain unrecognized. In this state, he strikes without being noticed. So he masquerades distractions to resemble CASUAL OPTIONS - things which are good for relaxation, pleasure or which look profitable at that particular point.

He presents the option of you taking a 7 figure job offer - it promises to rain millions, career growth, open doors influence. But the job comes with the option of working from Monday - Sunday, early morning to late at night. No time to pray - Worst, you are asked to compromise your kingdom standards. You need to embrace bribery, corruption, party Spirit & spiritual Luke warmness.

The blessings of God makes you rich and adds no sorrows. In His presence is fullness of joy. If that "blessing" takes you out of God's presence, IT IS A DISTRACTION. You don't need a prophet to prophesy "what is " and "what's not" a distraction in your life. You have the inherent ability to RECOGNIZE. When you do, don't ignore your discernment. It takes only one foothold to METAMORPHOSE INTO A STRONGHOLD.



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"R2" in AR3

James 4:7 AMP

[7] So submit to [the authority of] God. Resist the devil [stand firm against him] and he will flee from you.

The R2 in the AR3 formula stands for RESIST. After anticipating and recognising a "distraction", the next step is to resist it. Don't indulge it, don't give in to it. The verse above shows us the source of our "resisting power".

"Submit to the authority of God......"

Your submission to God, clothes you with the power to resist every distraction thrown at you. Just before Jesus' death, He faced a major distraction. He thought of the possibility of escaping death. He prayed and asked God for the cup of suffering to be taken away from Him. Then Jesus ended up His prayer by seeking the will of the father, not His own. Though fully God, Jesus was also fully human - You will not consciously want to experience a painful suffering right? It was a difficult moment. However He focused His eyes on the glory ahead - which will come after His death and resurrection. He refused to give in to the thoughts of distraction. Because Jesus focused, mankind received salvation.

Jesus drew strength from God - through submission. He submitted His will to God and embraced God's will. Distractions may serve as a temporal root of escape or a pleasurable shortcut BUT hear what The Holy Spirit is saying:

"Focus on me, so that you may fulfill the purpose you were created for. Submit to me and I will strengthen you. I have good plans for you".

"R3" in AR3

Hebrews 12:2 (KJV) Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

The R3 in the AR3 formula stands for REFIRE. After uccessfully resisting that distraction, the next important step is to RAISE UP A DEFENSE. When one scheme fails, satan tries another. Your adversary has a full bag of options - option A, B,option R,S.....and more from where the previous distraction came. This calls for wisdom. You need to REFIRE so that you will not be FIRED. In the verse above, it is revealed how Jesus refired Himself - so that He could stay focused.

.....for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.....

Jesus reminded Himself of the reason why He was going through the suffering in the first place. This reason was what fueled His focus. Oh! The joy of saving you, your family and every single person you know - kept Him going. The joy of resurrection - giving you a brand new life - The very life of God - kept Him going.

Because of this joy, Jesus endured the cross and despised it's shame. He faced the distraction and prevailed. This joy, which He beheld, fueled an even stronger focus.

Each time you feel the weight of distractions, ask yourself "What made me to start doing what I'm doing?". This will ignite the joy and vision that made you choose to start. Just like Jesus, you will be refired.

Discipline in Prayers

1 Peter 4:7 (NLT) The end of the world is coming soon. Therefore, be earnest and disciplined in your prayers.

Have you ever tried to encourage a loved one to pray? You will hear statements like "I'm busy" "I don't have time to pray" "I don't know how to pray" "I don't know what to pray" " I don't remember to pray".....the list is endless.

Maybe you are the one who is being encouraged by a loved one to pray and one of the statements above is your national anthem. You are struggling with building consistency in prayers. You often get overwhelmed with your daily activities and find it hard to create quality time to talk with God. You lack discipline in prayers.

Even if you pray consistently but pray at the time and in the manner you choose, you still lack discipline in prayers. You need to pray as The Holy Spirit leads you. If you are led to always pray in the morning before starting your day, then do so. Do not wait until the night time, when you are exhausted - then you pray saying "Lord, thank you for today, Amen"......then off! You fall asleep.

The verse above teaches us to be disciplined in prayers - as a prerequisite in preparing for the end of the world. We are in the last days and evil is greatly multiplying. To escape this evil and keep the fire of God burning within you, you need to be disciplined in your prayers. It's not a suggestion, it's an instruction from God. As you pray consistently, you will become more alert in the spirit. Your discernment will be sharper and you will hear God better. You need the voice of God to lead you in these last days.

Discipline in Bible Study

1 Peter 2:2 (KJV) As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:

Healthy living teaches you to eat 3 meals a day. An intentional act of nourishing your body. Some emphasis is even laid on what to eat more - like vegetables, fruits etc You know that you should eat more of these, so that you can be stronger and live longer.

Just as you pay attention to your physical diet, you need to pay a greater attention to your spiritual diet. You can't just abandon your spiritual nutrition to your Pastor's Sunday sermon only. You are too busy to create quality time to study your Bible - so you just look for a Christian preacher and listen to him on your way to work.

Listening to christian messages especially by preachers who are mature in the faith is very good but you need to create quality time for your Bible study daily. Even if you will still be listening to the same Christian preacher's message, but you will be doing so during your sacred time - A time devoted to God alone. A time void of distractions.

Just like your physical body, your spirit needs an intentional nourishing from you. Be careful what, where, how and when you eat your spiritual food - The Word of God. Don't rush over the word of God. Take time to study your Bible. If you dedicate 15 minutes for Bible study daily, make sure every fibre of your being is fully engaged in the process. Stop texting on WhatsApp, taking phone calls or talking to people around you while studying your Bible. Be focused and disciplined. Make personal Bible study your daily practice.

Seek Him Early

Mark 1:35 (KJV) And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed.

In medicine, there is a kind of treatment called prophylactic treatment. This treatment is prescribed in anticipation for a complication. For example, a doctor anticipates the possibility of a bacterial infection following an abdominal surgery - so he places his patient on antibiotics, though his patient has not acquired an infection. This antibiotics will serve as a defense within the patient - preventing him from being infected by the bacteria he has been exposed to. Each day comes with it's own trouble, obstacles and temptations, which the adversary has casted on your path.

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However, in the leadership of The Holy Spirit it is possible to overcome all this and keep walking steadfastly on the path of righteousness. This is exactly what early morning prayer does. It opens you up to absorb God's wisdom and counsel required for each day. You don't need to go though each day like everyone else - kicking their feet against the stones which the adversary has placed on their path. Early morning prayers are prophylactic prayers - they go ahead of you and prepare your day. Your day will be most productive when you start it in prayers. Take your time to intentionally seek God in the early hours of the morning. When everyone else is asleep, get up and talk to God. Don't rush through your prayers, don't recite memorised prayers either. Practice talking to God from your heart, you will find Him there.



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Reliance on God

Rom 9:11 KJV (For the children being not yet born, neither having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works, but of him that calleth;)

Relying on God has become an offensive topic for many believers, whose discomfort stems from the fact that it implies us having to set aside our strengths and abilities to take up his own. In the normal logic of many, "God is slow" or waiting/relying on God not only takes longer but yields undesired results. And so we find many Christians stock with their will, pressing to have their way and this in itself has become a trap, which satan has set for the church. because serving God can Never be done our way because that would not mean service.

Service can only be done in the way the one who calls you to serve wants. We serve him as he wants, not as we want. If this is true then the passage above tells us that works - all forms of personal efforts, strength, skills and endeavors are irrelevant as long as they don't align to His will. We must first understand the concept of the call, before we can ever execute the call.

We must know that we are called into His strength, into His will and into His way and this is from birth. It says having done nothing good or bad so that it will be all about God and nothing of man, God chose us before we could ever do anything to merit it. And now he says it is him that has called us.

This simply means all we can do is rely on him. I developed the slogan " rely on the call" "Trust in the call" because you've got the callers backing. All we need to do is seek His will, know His ways and obey Him BLINDLY, Trust Him BLINDLY and follow Him BLINDLY.

How Things Work

Rom 9:13 KJV As it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated.

Patterns are principles that govern the heavenly. In the courts of men, protocols and procedures reign. Everything has the way it is supposed to operate or needs to be operated to ensure smooth and proper functionality. In order to succeed anywhere we go, we must first of all learn the procedure and the protocols of that place.

In this scripture Even before birth, God who knows everything declared his hatred for Esua and his love for Jacob. Esua had never committed any offense neither was jacob being rewarded for a good job. The love of God found him before any good or bad deeds.

In the protocol of heaven this is how things are done. It is and has always been all about His love. His love does not reward, His love only loves. God's absolute will prepares us even before birth so that we can exist and function in this world. We must take advantage of this love and depend on him entirely.

Train yourself to depend on this love to overcome your weaknesses and disperse your doubts. Since we now know he loves us from birth we can also grow in that love each day. Let us live in His love. Walking fully in the consciousness of God's love everyday. A love that found us just as we are. Jesus loved you, He loves you and He will always love you. Loving you is His sovereign choice. Nothing and no one can change that - not even you. That is how things work.

A Focus on His Mercy

Rom 9:13 KJV As it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated.

The above passage of the bible describes to us a very simple way of following God. A way that is completely independent of all our efforts and determinations. A way that is so simple yet difficult because of the battle for self recognition and personal appraisal. One which completely blinds us to the benevolence of Christ towards us, His brethren and keeps us continuously vulnerable to the errors of Eve, who although was already like God in every sense still wanted to be like Him of her own efforts. Such efforts only keep us away from what He has freely made available to us and that is His mercy by choice.

God's mercy is by His free Will, He is not compelled, Neither is It demanded of Him by preasure. Everything is done of His own accord and He wants it to be all about Him who shows mercy.

What we must do is to lean on him and look to him for that mercy to be shown to us. We must focus and depend on his mercy to work and speak for us every day of our lives. His mercy knows no bounds and without the mercy of God No one will ever be able to achieve anything with God; because our human nature is filled with weaknesses and limitations. In all our totality at best we will still be found wanting. God's mercy exempts us from the punishment we truly deserve. We must allow this sink in only then can we truly embrace the blessings of God's Mercy towards us. A focus on his Mercy will guarantee our success in Him Amen.

Moving By His Dictates

Absolute Obedience to the voice of God is a prerequisite to experiencing a victorious and adventurous walk with God. Christianity can either be a perilous journey filled with one huddle to another or a lifetime of one triumph to another. God prescribes His will and Your obedience dictates the outcome.

Gen 2:17 KJV But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

The passage above shows God's clear will and intention for man which was that he should leave for ever, in absolute dominion, representing Him to all creation.

This was the life He had destined for man but His plans for man were incumbent upon man's response to His directives. "Don't eat from that tree "
That was the simple command and all man had to do was obey. But the prescription of God's will was altered by man's action of disobedience. This created an outcome different from what God had wanted.

We are not always experiencing failures as a result of God's will. Most of the time, the failures are the outcome of our own will, evident by our actions and words which contradict God's perspectives. Every action outside God's will, WILL produce a monster for you and that situation might be your undoing, if God does not show Mercy. Let us make it our passion to obey His commands.

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The abilities of God cannot be questioned. So many people believe in the vastness of these abilities. What do I mean by the vastness? I am talking about the scope to His abilities, which are not questionable, neither is the existence of these abilities doubted in the very first place. What most people turn to doubt is the direction or the particularity of these abilities.

Dan 3:17 KJV If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand, O king.

The three Hebrew boys stated categorically that thier God possessed the ability to save them from Nebuchadnezzar's fire.

But in Dan 3:18, it is written "But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up"

They began to doubt the objects and subjects of these abilities. Meaning they doubted in the willingness of God to demonstrate His endless abilities in their lives. The problem of Many believers is not that God cannot do it but if God will do it for them. That's the question satan always uses to cast his doubts in the hearts of God's own people.

Child of God, I stand here to say that God cannot only do it but He wants to do it for you and me. His abilities are not for Himself. They are useless to him His abilities are meant for you and me to benefit from. In Acts 4:12 Apostle Peter said there is no other name Given UNDER HEAVEN by which we can be saved.

You see here that even though Jesus laboured and was rewarded with a name above every other name, He did not take the name to heaven He left it behind so that you and me can profit from that name. God wants to do it for you. He won the battle for you, His stripes are for you. God does not need healing He created healing for you and me to enjoy. He does not need deliverance He only created deliverance so that we can be delivered. The bible says all things are for Us. Let us rise up with this belief and begin to claim all that heaven can afford. Reach out now and claim your Health, breakthrough and deliverance in Jesus mighty name amen.

You Have a Role To Play

Amos 3:3 KJV Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

In a football match, there are 22 players, 11 playing for each team. There is also a referee and two linesmen. There are rules and each of these men on the field have their roles to play in strict obedience to the rules, inorder for the match to be successful and interesting. A break down of the A Team would include a striker, a middle fielder, a defender, a goal keeper, reserve players and many more. All of these individuals are trained to handle their roles professionally, as doing so is key for the success of the Team. In the same way, in every relationship there are rules and there are roles.

Our passage for today tells us that there will never be a successful journey for two if they don't first of all agree. This agreement is definitely about what role each of them is supposed to play in the pursuit of their walk.

Today's devotional is a Triple Standard Advice aimed at calling us to the consciousness of the fact that

- * We are in a relationship with God and therefore we have our role to play inorder for us to see God at work. Our main role is prompt and unquestionable Obedience.
- * In our relationship with our partners for those who are married take your responsibility and play your role in obidience to The guidance of Gods word, so that your marriage will be successful.

* In our professional lives be it business or circular jobs, we must know the art of role playing in strict obedience to the rules of the job and the standards of Gods word for our lives. We must be professionals and at the same time be Evangelists, knowing that as children of God we are constantly on the radar. The lord gives us strength amen.

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What to do when you are desperate

Rom 10:13 KJV For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

I have come to realise that everything is in stages. And the worlds classification of things are in stages. For example you have a first class to a third class degree in most systems of Higher education. And also you have first to a third world countries according ratings for development. All grades are not the same. for example, in the medical field diseases are graded based on their level of progression. The higher the number of the grade, the worst the situation is. Believers all over must learn to discern when to bring God in. He is not far off, He is close by, just waiting for us to introduce Him into the scene. How do we bring God into the scene? IT IS BY CALLING UPON HIS NAME!!!

Pro 18:10 KJV "The name of the LORD is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe'. We must learn to run to the name of the Lord. That's the only place where our security and safety is guaranteed.

What is it that you are going through?? What stage have you reached. Has it entered the desperate level?? Then position yourself and join me call on the name of Jesus these three times. WITH A SHOUT LETS GO!

JESUS!!!

JESUS!!!!

JESUS!!! rescue me NOW. I DECLARE a miraculous recovery, escape, turn around for you in JESUS MIGHTY MATCHLESS NAME AMEN.

The dangers of worrying

Luk 21:34 KJV And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day comes upon you unawares.

Worries seem normal but it has become a potent tool in the hands of the enemy which blinds our eyes to the realities of God's word. Worries short circuit the flow of the intervention power of God, from moving with speed into the matter. The world may paint a faint picture about worries but truly the dangers are underrated. Worries are the main reason for stress and stress can shut down the organs of your body from functioning properly. It obstructs liver enzymes, affects fertility, it causes high blood pressure, it may cause heart attack and

many more. It is what the Bible calls a wounded spirit. No doubt the scriptures say a wounded spirit who can bear.

In our passage above, we are cautioned by the Holy Spirit not to let our hearts be heavy with the cares of this life, lest that day comes and leaves us behind. This means worries can make you lose your salvation. Minding the cares of this life can lead you into unwanted spiritual crises. It may make you backslide from God's grace. Many have not come to terms with the dangers of worries. JESUS tell us not to border on what to eat or drink that God knows we need these things. I have come to learn that truly God knows our needs and He is ready to meet them at the nick of time. This has been my personal experience as I have seen God miraculously provided just when I truly needed it the most. The cares of life or worries suffocates the word of God from taking root in your life.

It stops the word from baring fruits in your life. The parable of the sower describes it like this, it's like the seed that falls amongst thorns. The word of God cannot prosper in the heart that is filled with worries. Because worries shines the light more on the problem than on the solution. Worries lead to mummuring and mummuring angers God. Every believer must practice casting their cares upon Him for He cares for us. Jesus has offered to carry our burdens for us He wants to worry about our needs, so that we can focus on His words and obey them.

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
