There are three different kinds of bees in a beehive: workers, drones, and a queen. Read on to learn more about bees.

MAKING HONEY

To make honey, a honeybee will drop nectar into its honeycomb and fan it with their wings.

One hive can make 20-60 pounds of honey in a year.




BEES ARE COOL!

Honey bees talk to each other through a special "waggle dance".

Bees collect nectar and pollen to make honey and feed the other bees in the hive.

Worker bees are female. Drone bees are male.



QUEEN BEES

The queen bee rules the hive. She lays all the eggs in the hive, and can lay one million eggs in her lifetime.

The queen is the largest bee in the colony.

WORKER BEES

An average worker bee makes one teaspoon of honey in its life.

The worker bee is the smallest of the honey bees.
