"Dress-Up Race" Game

Objective: Teach kids the correct order of getting dressed while making it fun and interactive.

Materials:

- · A large felt board or magnetic board
- Felt or magnetic clothing pieces (shirt, pants, socks, shoes, hat, etc.)
- A character figure (boy/girl or animal) to dress up
- Timer (optional)

📤 How to Play:

- 1. **Set the Scene:** Tell a short story like "It's a sunny morning and our friend needs help getting ready for school!"
- 2. Game Start: Lay out all the clothing items in a mixed-up pile.
- 3. **Turn-Based Play:** Each child takes a turn picking the correct item and placing it on the character in the right order (e.g., underwear → shirt → pants → socks → shoes → hat).
- 4. **Race Option:** For a more active version, have kids race to dress up a doll or themselves using real clothes in the correct order.
- 5. **Discussion:** After the game, talk about why we wear clothes in a certain order (e.g., socks before shoes).

- Encourages independence
- Enhances fine motor skills
- Reinforces vocabulary (shirt, pants, etc.)
