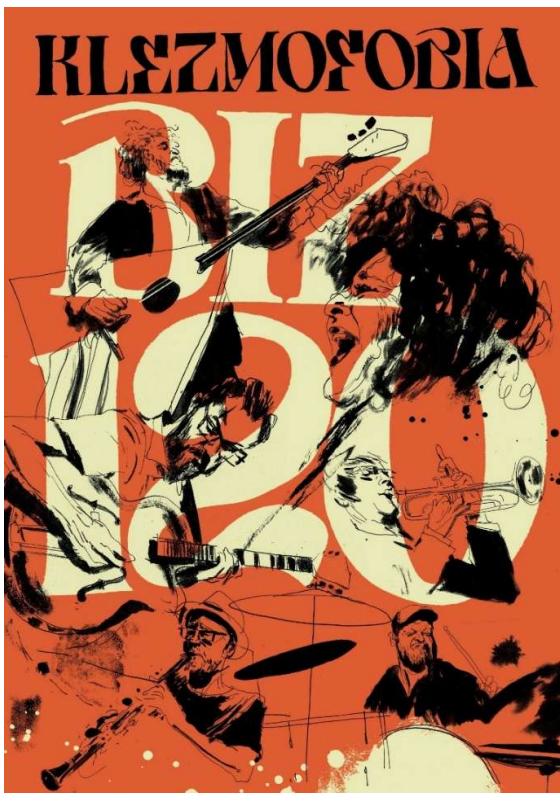
This is music that brings people together: hard-hitting yet deeply embracing at the same time. Music you can dance to, cry to, and lose yourself in.
