For Parents:


- **Time blocking** (Morning lesson, after lunch outdoor time, personal breaks)

- Habit stacking (pairing tasks: e.g. dhikr while folding laundry)
- Digital detox hours

- Create **"I do / We do / You do"** learning structures to foster independence




Task: What key skills are needed for a successful curriculum?


