I. Pray with Gratitude



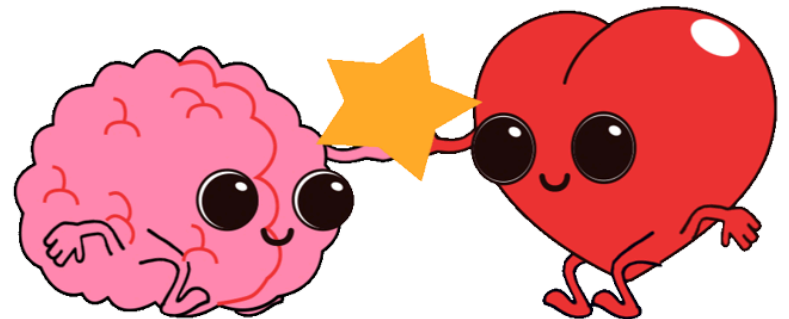
A. Give thanks in **all circumstances.**
