- 4. What suggestions did James make concerning the Gentile Christians? (19-21) What is the significance of the four things the Gentile Christians were to abstain from for them? What decisions did the apostles pass on in a letter to the believers in the Gentile cities? (23-29) Through whom and how did the Jerusalem church edify the Gentile Christians and the world mission? (31.32)
