DT 4:44-26:19

Key Verse 6:5

“Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.”

Good Morning. How is the conference so far? This conference is going to be the most memorable and even life-changing conference for me. It is not because of beautiful sight nor delicious German bread, but because God has given me one word of God which I can hold to live my life of mission.

This command is known as the first and Greatest command. (Mt22:36-38) “The First” and “Greatest” – double emphasis –definitely means it is important command which we may keep it as a matter of life and death.

In this passage, there are so many repetitions. Even Deuteronomy itself is repetition. Just finding repeated words or phrases in the passage, we can find out core message. Thank God for inductive Bible Studies.

After 40 years in the wilderness, Israelites were just about to conquer the Land that God had promised to give their ancestors.

In the lecture 1, Moses planted the faith in the promise of God that God will give them victory; God will fight for them. “Do not be afraid of them; the Lord your God himself will fight for you.” (Dt3:22)

In this lecture 2 which covers Moses’ second sermon, Moses teaches the next generation How to live as the kingdom of priests and a Holy nation in

the promised land which they are about to enter, by restating the Ten commandments and the laws.

Though the passage seems long and complicated with various kinds of laws, the theme is simple and clear: “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.”

Then, how can we love God with all our hearts? I pray that through this Bible Study we all may learn how to love God and become his people – the Kingdom of priests and a Holy nation.

- If Brother, or son, or daughter, or the wife you love, or your closest friend secretly entices you to worship other gods → put them to death / your hand must be the first (6-11)
- If A Town has been led astray to worship other gods → destroy it completely, both its people and livestock/completely burn the town(12-18)
- Other people might eat anything, but not you – for you are a holy people to the Lord(14:1-21)
- Learn to revere the Lord God always –by bring tithes to the Lord (14:22-29)

Do this so that innocent blood will not be shed in your hand.” (19:1-13)</p> <p>Witness – a matter must be established by the testimony of 2 or 3 witness / false witness – do to them as that witness intended to do the other party (19:14-21)</p> <p>War – <b>[Cities at a distance]</b> Make an offer of peace – if they accept, all people shall be subject to forced labor and shall work for you / if not accept, engage in battle – put all the men to death</p> <p>--<b>[Cities in the Promised land]</b> Completely destroy them/ Otherwise, they will lead to worship their gods.</p> <p>Unsolved Murder (21:1-9) / Marrying a captive woman (21:10-14)</p> <p>“you must not sell her or treat her as a slave...” / The right of the firstborn (21:15-17)</p> <p>“he must acknowledged the son of his unloved wife as the firstborn giving him a double share of all he has.”</p> <p>Various laws (21:22-22:12)</p>
