# 1. Is Dr. Smuel Lee a charismatic leader?

- “It’s leadership, stupid!”
- “Iron sharpens iron” (Pro. 27:17)
- Socrates: leadership develops vision, creates value, follow direction, & serve as a model
- Harry S. Truman “A leader is a person who has the ability to get others to do what they don’t want to do, and like it.”
- “Leader are not born but made.”

# Charismatic Leadership (1)

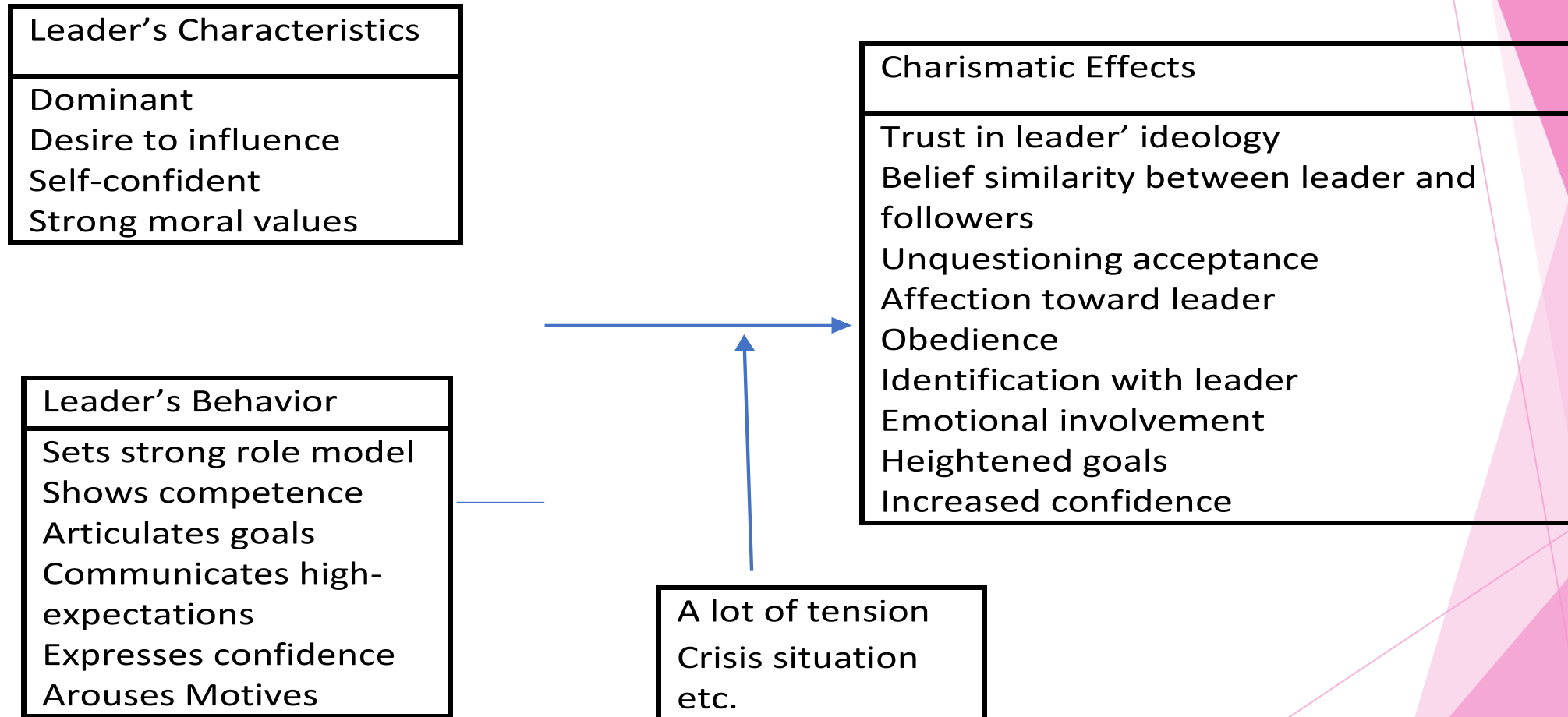
- ▶ 1947 by Max Weber “the gift of heaven”
- ▶ Three Legal source of Authority:  
Traditional, legal-rational, and charismatic
- ▶ Attachment of an individual to an extraordinary, superhuman strength of heroic power

## Charismatic Leadership (2)

- ▶ Charismatic Leadership Factors:  
leader,  
Situation,  
Member

\*Charisma does not make a great leader. Great leadership makes for charismatic leadership.

#### 1) Leader's Characteristics:

Dominant

Desire to Influence

Self-confident

Strong Moral Values

\*Dr. Samuel Lee's self-confidence made himself attempt to influence others.

## ▶ The Model of Charismatic Leadership (2)

### 2) Leader's Behavior

Sets strong role Model

Shows competence

Articulates goals

Communicates high expectations

Expresses Confidence

Arouses Motive

\*"We should be soldiers of Christ full of warm battle friendship, who love each other, wiping each other's tears and rescuing them from the enemy line at the risk of our lives."



## ▶ The Model of Charismatic Leadership (3)

### 3) Charismatic Effects:

Charisma emphasizes the effect.

The effect is maximized when the situation, the members, and the leaders are well combined.

## 2. Charismatic Servant Leadership

- ▶ Two Qualities: Humility & Shepherd Heart
- ▶ The Greatest Christian Influence: Servant Leadership
- ▶ “Having loved his own” (Jn 13:1), Jesus washed his disciples’ feet and said, “I have set you an example” (Jn 13:15)
