(Jesus' authority from his shepherd heart)

Mark 4,1 - 8,30  
Key verse 6:34

"When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. So he began teaching them many things."

Thank and praise God that he has called us as his disciples and royal priesthood for Europe and America and for the world mission with his great hope. Thank God for the GLEF 2021 and for the Study of Mark's Gospel, that we can ~~get to know~~ learn the spiritual authority of Jesus more deeply and ~~to be able to possess this authority and thereby~~ serve the mission of disciple making in this generation victoriously influentially.

Today, in chapters 4 ~~through~~ 8, we ~~want to learn about Jesus' authority in his early messianic work. We learn can see~~ that Jesus' authority ~~was rooted came from~~ in his compassionate shepherd heart for the people who, like sheep without a shepherd, were helpless disoriented and orphaned. Through Jesus' shepherding ministered to ~~d~~ifferent kinds of people ~~from his shepherd heart to were lead them to healing~~ and received new life. He Jesus helped his disciples that they might know his shepherd heart and have faith that offers five loaves and two fish to God so they can be great and in turn be used as shepherds for the needy people. From Jesus we learn his shepherd's heart which is to give spiritual food to the needy people and lead them to blessedness in the kingdom of God.

### 1. Jesus taught the kingdom of God (4:1-5:43)

In chapter 4, Jesus taught the shepherdless crowd who were like sheep without a shepherd through five parables how the kingdom of God grows and how to possess the kingdom of God.

In order to ~~The most important precondition for a person to receive~~ experience the kingdom of God ~~is~~ the right attitude of the heart is most important. There, where the heart is hardened, where thorns grow or where there is only stony ground, the kingdom of God cannot grow growth is stopped. But where a person has a good soil of heart, the word of God can penetrate, take root, grow, and finally bring many good fruits. Let us read 4:20 together: "Others, like seed sown on good soil, hear the word, accept it, and produce a crop --- thirty, sixty or even a hundred times what was sown."

Many people want to live a fruitful life. As we have learned through Genesis 1, according to God's creation goal, we should bring many fruits to God. In order to live a fruitful life we must hear the word of God. Just hearing the word is not enough to bring the fruit. Many Christians like to hear God's word to feel comfort. But our goal should not only be to hear the word, but to fight until then to accept the word of God and bear fruit.

Here "~~accepting~~hearing" means obedience to ~~at least one~~ word of God in ~~our~~ practical life. ~~If we hear God's word with a pure heart and obey it, Then we may will~~ experience the change in our lives through the power of the word and bring good fruits to God, sixty and a hundred times over. ~~May God bless us Let us to be good spiritual soil have good Soil of hearts and let a seed of the word continue to grow in us that produces much fruit~~ by cultivating good spiritual habits of ~~faithful the~~ daily bread and ~~writing testimony writing~~faithfully. ~~Then God will make our life fruitful and use us preciously as workers of the kingdom of God.~~ By building a 1 to 1 Bible study teams, let us sow the ~~good seeds~~ of the ~~g~~Gospel in our sheep ~~and children~~ and help them ~~to let it grow through practical obedience until it bears the good fruits through practical obedience.~~ Although this ~~spiritual seed of the Word~~ is as small as a mustard seed in the beginning, it will grow ~~within them~~ into a large tree through which many people will eventually find the ~~shadow-shelter~~ of the ~~g~~Gospel.

~~Joshua Elsholz is a precious child of God. But the experts said that he must attend a special needs school, since he will never be able to graduate from high school. Then he ~~also~~ rebuked his disciples for their lack of faith.

Let us read 4:40 together: "He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?" ~~Here we learn that From the burning shepherd's heart,~~ Jesus gave his disciples ~~this storm training so that they could learn faith. Later, by faith in Jesus, The disciples will experience various storms in their life of faith. the disciples overcame all kinds of storms, and they They should not remain fearful and helpless, but rather lead an overcoming and lived a~~ victorious life of faith through faith in Jesus and ~~doing~~ even greater works than Jesus.

~~\_\_\_\_\_~~ In chapter 5, ~~we learn that Jesus had a compassionate shepherd's heart for the shepherdless people.~~ Jesus showed his compassionate shepherd's heart for a man suffering from a legion of evil spirits. Many people were afraid of him and handcuffed him with chains. ~~Nobody wanted to develop a relationship with him.~~ But Jesus came to him and asked him his name: "What's is your name?" ~~Jesus showed his pure interest in him.~~ Jesus understood ~~and felt the misery of this man who was tortured day and night his obsession and agony with a~~ by a legion of evil spirits who ~~tortured-obsessed~~ him. ~~For his broken shepherd heart Jesus did not hesitate to He invested a lot to help this one person and even sacrificed 2,000 pigs for it in order to save one lost soul. To Jesus this one person was very precious as a universe and did not hesitate to heal him. The demon possessed man became the first missionary in the region of Decapolis. It was not important for Jesus how the people there would feel uncomfortable, and they would reject Jesus. His priority was to make free this man, imprisoned by Satan, through the power of the word and to raise him up as a missionary and witness of Jesus in this region. Here, We learn from Jesus that we can have spiritual authority when we are ready to put our priority on the work of salvation of this generation and to invest our everything to save one lost soul in it.~~

2. You give them something to eat! (6:1 - 8:30)

~~Chapter 6 is about the next step of Jesus' discipleship, namely his shepherding. So far, the disciples had only observed. Now, but Jesus wished his disciples to share his compassion shepherd heart and to grow as to be good shepherds for God's flock of sheep. Jesus first trained his disciples by sending them out two by two. The disciples should not all-trust in other things, but only in Jesus. During their missionary trip, they preached repentance, cast out evil spirits, and healed many sick people. It was a mighty work of God. The disciples were able to learn that God is with them when they obey him and are dependent completely on him.~~

The apostles came together with Jesus and reported everything they had done and taught. Jesus told them, "You go to a lonely place alone and rest a little" because the disciples had no time for food. So they went in a boat to a lonely place for themselves. But a large crowd came unannounced and disrupted Jesus' fellowship with his disciples. ~~The disciples wanted to send these people away immediately.~~ But Jesus did not send them away. Let us read verse 34 together: "When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. So he began teaching them many things." Jesus did not see them as a disturbing crowd. Rather, he saw their inner desire to hear the Word of God. He knew that without God's Word they were ~~disoriented and helpless~~ and full of sorrow, like sheep without a shepherd.

~~Here "compassion" means something like deep pity or sympathy. Perhaps one of them was about to throw his life away because he could not find meaning for his life. Another suffered from the unresolved lust problem. And yet another was trapped by the love of money and lived in a broken relationship with God and with neighbors. Who could help these sheep? But Jesus saw beyond their current situation that without God's Word they would be lost~~

~~forever in their sins. That is why he could not remain silent, but was eager to give them God's word, which could open the door to the kingdom of God for them. This is the reason why Jesus preached the word of God to them all day long until the sun set. He wanted to help them to know God's love, to come back to Him and to take hold of eternal life. This compassionate heart is also the heart of God. He did not let people get further lost in their sins but sent his only Son as the Lamb of God, although it meant that he had to suffer much and die to the shameful death on the cross. John 3:16 describes these hearts of God. "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."~~

~~The disciples of Jesus waited patiently. But a servant of God came to Germany and saw the German young people who were helpless in disbelief and deceived by humanism. He had compassion on them because they were like sheep without a shepherd. That is why he began to serve all kinds of people from his burning shepherd's heart. A drug-addicted hippie, a cold-hearted computer man, a fearful chameleon, a businessman who had a full of secular vision, he served with the long sermon day and night and with the life together until they changed into Jesus, even raised up as the responsible leaders and shepherds for the spiritual awakening in Germany and Europe.~~

~~On the evening of that day the disciples could no longer be patient. They suggested that Jesus send the crowd to surrounding villages so that they could buy bread for themselves. It was a reasonable and practical proposal. This would solve the crowd's bread problem and give them peace of mind and body at the same time. But Jesus gave them a surprising command: "You give them something to eat!" In this way Jesus wanted to help his disciples to get to know his shepherd heart and to work together for the work of God's responsibility.~~

Let us read 6:37 together: "But he answered, "You give them something to eat." They said to him, "That would take more than half a year's wages! Are we to go and spend that much on bread and give it to them to eat?" For the disciples, Jesus' command "You give them something to eat!" was a great and enormous challenge. Some grumbled and thought it was excessive or impossible. Jesus asked them again: "How many loaves do you have?" Now Andrew went off and came back with a little boy's food box: "Five loaves and two fish." It looked like a joke kind of funny. But Andrew's greatness is that he did not remain in impossibility or complaining but that he brought had faith that Jesus could do something with these 5 five loaves and 2 two fish to Jesus. Jesus was amazed by his co-working spirit and faith. Jesus accepted the Andrew's -small gift, gave thanks for it and had the disciples distribute it to everyone. Under Jesus' blessing, the loaves were multiplied so that five thousand people men were fed and even twelve baskets of leftovers remained. When they Andrew came to brought Jesus through faith with 5 five loaves and 2 two fish to Jesus, Jesus blessed them abundantly and revealed his glory that he is the Christ of God.

~~Jesus' authority comes from his compassionate shepherd's heart. Jesus wanted his disciples to know his heart too, finding a way to serve this crowd with a giving spirit and a sense of responsibility. Jesus gave shepherd training to his disciples. He Jesus helped his disciples, them, first, to overcome their physical limits by having shepherd hearts for God's sheep. Jesus taught his disciples to take responsibility for the people. In fact, the disciples~~

~~had served the mission so far and had come back from the mission trip. They missed their break to serve the crowd when Jesus gave his long sermon. But Jesus did not let the disciples rest as they wanted but trained them to overcome their limits with the shepherd's heart and to serve the needy people God's sheep until the end despite their own tiredness and hunger due to a long mission journey.~~

Second, Jesus helped his disciples overcome ~~their "calculation faith" fixed thoughts and unbelief. Calculation faith is the same as unbelief. Calculation faith makes leaders helpless and powerless. He challenged them: "You give them something to eat!" and "How many loaves do you have?" Faith is over our reason and logic. In order to acquire Jesus' authority, we must overcome human calculation and act by faith in God who is the Faith means getting out of our limited thoughts and believing in the Almighty Creator. What is impossible with men is possible with God. However, God works through the faith and obedience of one person. God used Ezekiel's obedience to restore his people when he prophesied God's word to the dead bones by faith. Jesus used Andrew's faith and obedience when he found five loaves and two fish and brought them to Jesus to feed the 5000 men.~~

~~Jesus' authority comes from his compassionate shepherd's heart. Jesus wanted his disciples to know his heart too, finding a way to serve this crowd with a giving spirit and a sense of responsibility. If Jesus had rested at this crucial moment or let his disciples having a rest from his human love, the shepherdless people would have been lost further and the disciples would have remained in their limit, and they would not have learned any faith. We can experience God's miracles only if we overcome our limits by faith and obedience to Jesus' words.~~

~~When Georg Muller started the orphanage mission, he only had three plates and four forks and knives. He did not receive any support from the government or from a specific wealthy donor. But out of love and his responsible shepherd heart and vision for the orphaned children, he came to God every morning and asked for his care. When George Müller accepted God's word from Psalm 81:10: "Open wide your mouth and I will fill it!" And started the orphanage mission, he only had 3 plates and 4 forks and knives. When they obeyed, they did not remain dependent on others. They were able to start living a giving life and learned a giving live and they sent out many self-supporting missionaries for the world~~

mission. ~~Until today, so~~ Korea ~~serves isas still used as~~ a royal priesthood ~~today and missionary sending country.~~

Jesus also wants us to grow as ~~responsible~~ shepherds with a sense of responsibility for his flock of sheep and for world missions. He does not ask us: How much time, money or ability do you have? He asks us: How many loaves and fish do you have? You give them something to eat! Let us not think that this command of Jesus is only for our parents or for others. ~~Jesus gives this command to each of us very personally. "You give them something to eat!"~~ Jesus wants us, the next generation, to grow as responsible shepherds, leaders and pioneers for the spiritual re-building and re-awakening and the world missions in our generation. How can we have such great faith? We can have such great faith when we learn from the servants of God just as the disciples learned from Jesus when co-working with him.

When Dr. Peter Chang and M. John Park prayed for the next generation, they did not remain helpless, but they brought GLEF as five loaves and two fish to Jesus. The also brought KBC mission as five loaves and two fish to Jesus for M mission. It looks so small and seems to have many problems. But the important point is that Jesus accepted their -our five loaves and two fish of daily bread and early prayer and GLEF graciously for the spiritual mobilization of the next generation and the worldM mission and he will continue to bless them -blesses them abundantly.

We have many five loaves and two fish. Our five loaves and two fish are: Daily bread, 1 to 1 Bible study, Testimony Writing and Sharing, Campus Prayer, Coworking in Orchestra and Online mission. -God will bless Let's bring our five loaves and two fish that we bring to of 1 to 1 Bible Study to Jesus by faith and with an attitude of spiritual responsibility to feed God's sheep in our school and campus in Europe and America. -Jesus prays for us to build 10,000 ZBS teams and and even build three basecamps in the M countries by 5 Loaves and 2 Fish-Faith.

Peter could confess: "You are the Christ!" It is crucial to know Jesus and to confess him as the Christ. Jesus wants us to know who he is. He is not just any good person~~

~~who solves our bread problem and improves our conditions. He is the Christ, the promised Messiah, who came into the world to save us from the power of sin and to give us eternal life. This Christ gave his life out of his compassionate shepherd heart as a ransom offering for you and for me. This Jesus is our true King who deserves our worship and rules our new life. Who is Jesus to you? We want to make this commitment together. "You are the Christ!"~~

~~When I was obsessed with rebellion Because of my arrogance about church or belief, and I hurted and criticized Church people with my words. Nno one wanted to develop a deep relationship with me. In my deep heart I was lonely. But my shepherdess was pure interest in me and my soul and served me every week with the BS and with the delicious food. She wept because of her pity for my stubborn heart and did not give up on me, so that I could finally repent according to Gal 2:20 about my miserable life under the power of sin of pride and mistrust and selfishness and accept Jesus as my Savior.~~

~~Without the compassionate shepherd heart of my shepherdess in Korea I would have long since gone into the world and could have lived disoriented and hopeless or, because of the meaninglessness of life, I could have ended my life myself. Without the compassionate shepherd heart and the teachingspiritual servanthip of M. Peter and M. Sarah I would never have recognized my sin problem of desire and pride and still could/would have continued a fruitless, miserable life, betrayed by the spirit of the time and my ego. Thank God that I could have the shepherds at my important moments of life. They could just treat me as their daughter in law, but they saw me as Jesus' disciple and gave me the shepherd training. Wennhen I was pregnant with my first kidchild and had a severe morning sickness, I thought I could not help but lie down on the bed all day long. But M. Peter gave me Jesus' command „Go to campus and You give the them something to eat!“ I thought that it is impossible and wanted to care aboutonly for myself. But I obeyed and prayed at the campus, and I could learn Jesus' shepherd heart for his lost sheep. On that day I invited two Sstudents to bible study and worship service and they came. Through this training I could learn faith and shepherd heart that overcomes my physical limits and my calculation and grow one step more as to a shepherdess for Jesus' sheep and as a mother of faith. had a compassionate shepherd's heart for me, taught me many things through Bible study and served me practically with their 5 loaves and 2 fish of the life together and led me to my true shepherd Jesus.~~

~~Jesus did not hesitate to come for me a thirsty, self-centered woman through his servants to give his life as a ransom for me. He restored my broken relationship with him by asking me, "Do you love me? Feed my lambs!" I want to confess courageously that Jesus is my Christ and my Lord. From now on I will dedicate my life as an obedient servant according to Luke 1:38 and Mt 6:33 for Jesus' flock of sheep.~~

~~I repent that I have still lived the Lord of my life and to remain within my limits. Before the challenges and tasks, I thought of my comfort first as God's honor and his mission. When I knew that I could preach a message for GLF, I immediately thought of the reasons why I can't or won't, be it "I'm a little old than others" "I'm a mother of two young children", "I can't English" etc. God helped me to repent of my unbelief and laziness and to do my best for God's mission and for the glory of God and to be used as a messenger of the word for the historic GLEF 2021. God helps me to be healed of my sick way of thinking and disposition~~

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~~and to attract a healthy disposition based on the words "It was very good!" And "You give them something to eat!" to bring to God.~~
