**NUMBERS LESSON 4 (NUM 26:1-30:17)**

“Say to them, : ,This is the offering made by fire that you are to present to the Lord: two lambs a year old without defect, as a regular burnt offering each day. Prepare one lamb in the morning and the other at twilight.” (Num 28:3,4)

## RECALL NUMBERS LESSON 3 (NUM 17-25)

- The Israelites came up to their 38th year in the desert.
- Generation change marked by deaths of Miriam and Aaron
- Salvation from venomous snakes
- Victory for the next generation over Og & Bashan, kings of the Amorites
- Thwarting the curses of the Moabites (Balak & Balaam)
- Adultery and idolatry at Moab

If no daughters, to brothers, if no brothers, then nearest relative (kinsman redemption).

Regarding the making and fulfilling of vows, for different kinds of people

1-2: men: must keep

3-5: young unmarried women: father can forbid

6-8: married woman: husband can forbid

9: divorced or widowed women: must keep

10-15: husband of married woman can confirm or forbid his wife's vow

16: clarification: this issue of vows is fundamentally about relationship between husbands and wives; fathers and daughters.

# I. THE SECOND CENSUS (26:1-27:33)

26:1,2: „After the plague the LORD said to Moses and Eleazar son of Aaron, the priest, ,Take a census of the whole Israelite community by families—all those twenty years old or more who are able to serve in the army of Israel.““

## IA) THE SECOND CENSUS (26:1-65)

- The first census was 38 years earlier (Num 1:2)
- Consequence of unbelief: all the first generation except for Caleb & Joshua died
- The second census: God's faithfulness, sovereignty, and grace
- Emphasis of first census: fighting
- Emphasis of second census: allotment of land
- Levites counted separately in both censi.

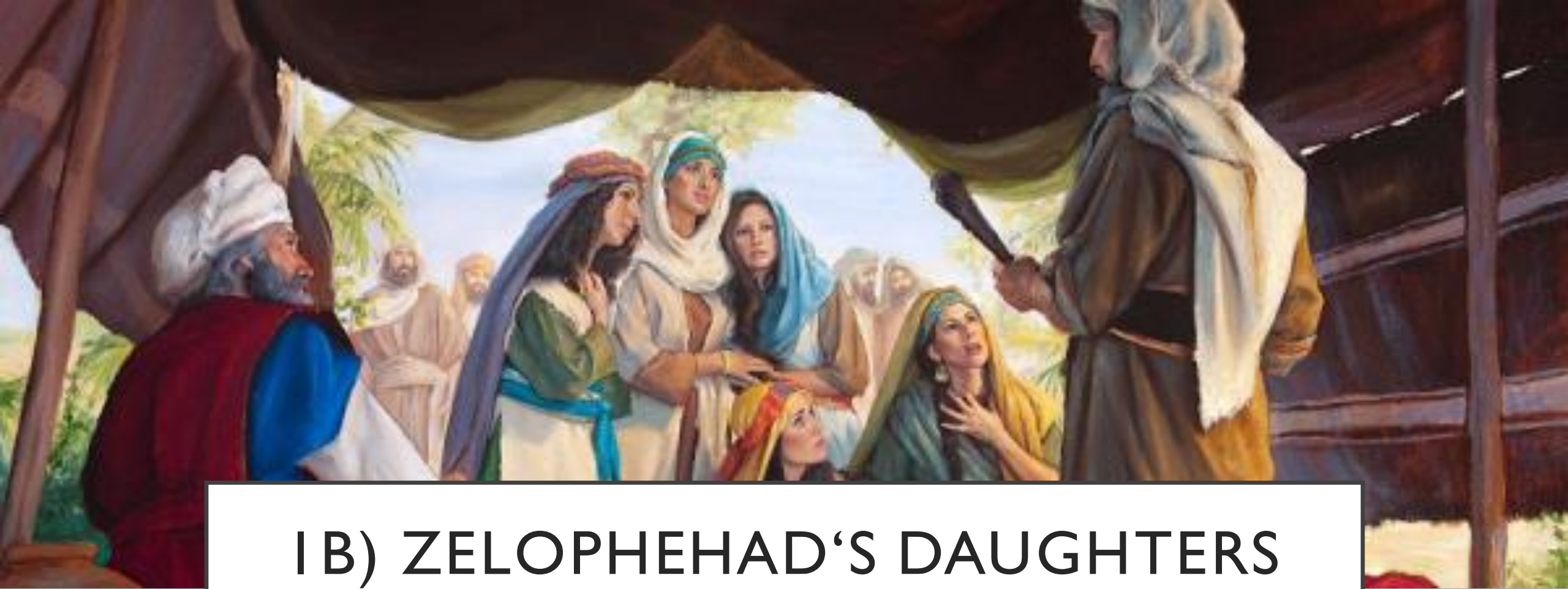
## A CENSUS OF THE UBF NEXT GENERATION


## 27:1-11: ZELOPHEHAD'S DAUGHTERS

Zelophehad was a great-great-grandson of Manasseh, one of the sons of Joseph.

Zelophehad had 5 daughters (Mahlah, Noah, Hoglah, Milcah and Tirzah) and NO SON. (Dr. Andrew Park from Baltimore.)

Who could receive inheritance?

No one among Zelophehad's descendants.



## 27:1-11: ZELOPHEHAD'S DAUGHTERS

If they looked at themselves, Zelophehad's daughters would remain fatalistic and bitter. Their father's line would die out.


If they didn't care about the inheritance, they wouldn't even have a problem.

(Num 27:1b-2)



## 27:1-11: ZELOPHEHAD'S DAUGHTERS

- Moses brought their case before the LORD (5)
- God was pleased with their faith and granted them property among their relatives (6-7)
- God made a new inheritance rule (8-11): daughters or brothers can inherit in the place of sons



27:1-11: ZELOPHEHAD'S DAUGHTERS

They had faith in God's promise.

They looked at **God** and valued his given **inheritance** more than they looked at themselves and valued their own lives.

- May God raise among us now many Joshuas who can shepherd God's people and lead spiritual warfare for God's honour.

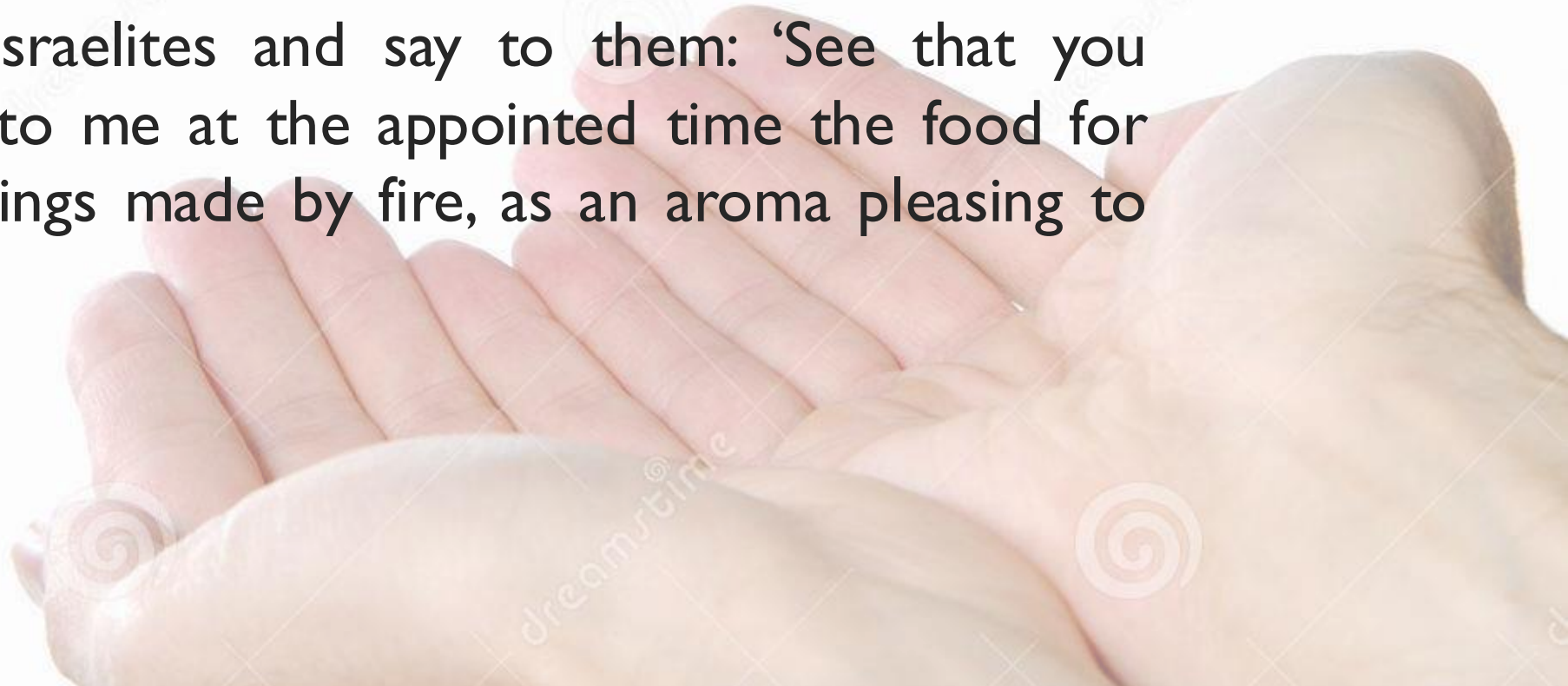

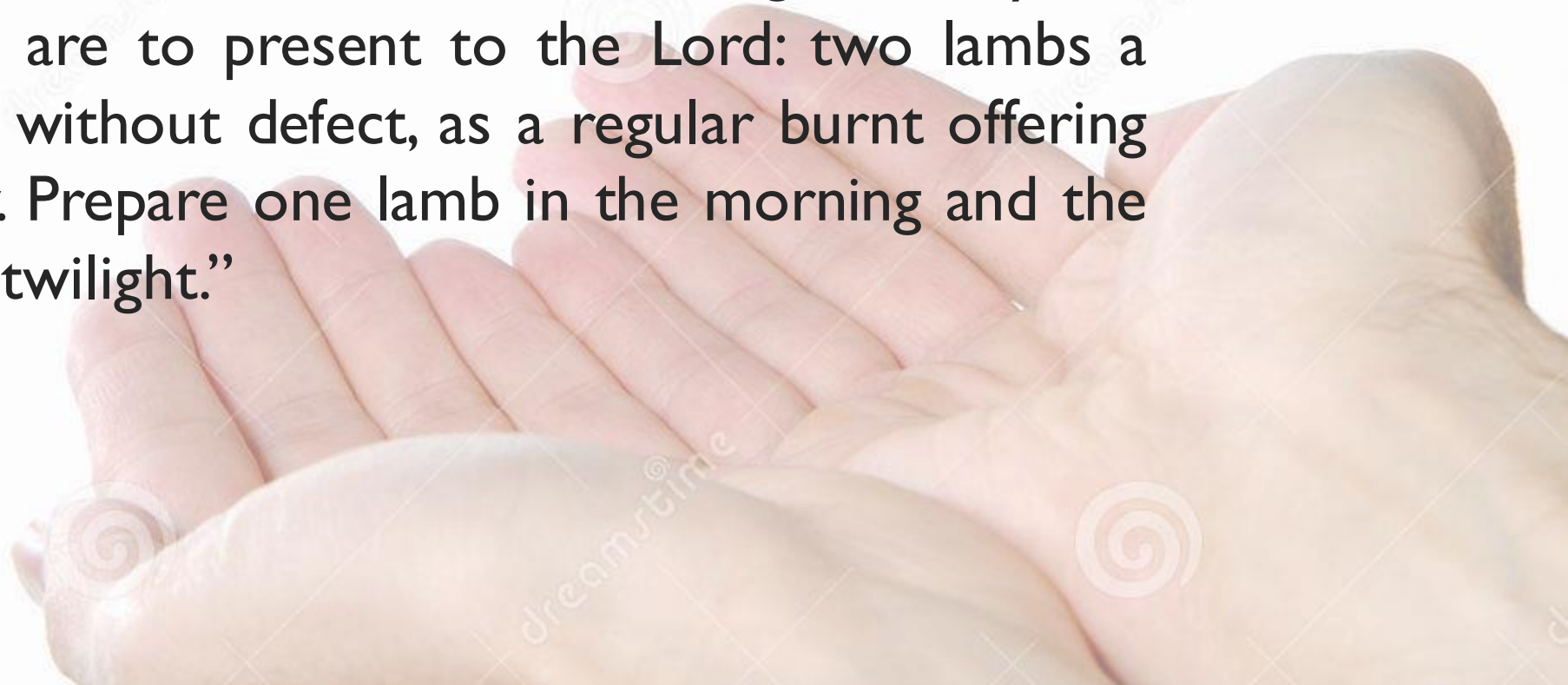

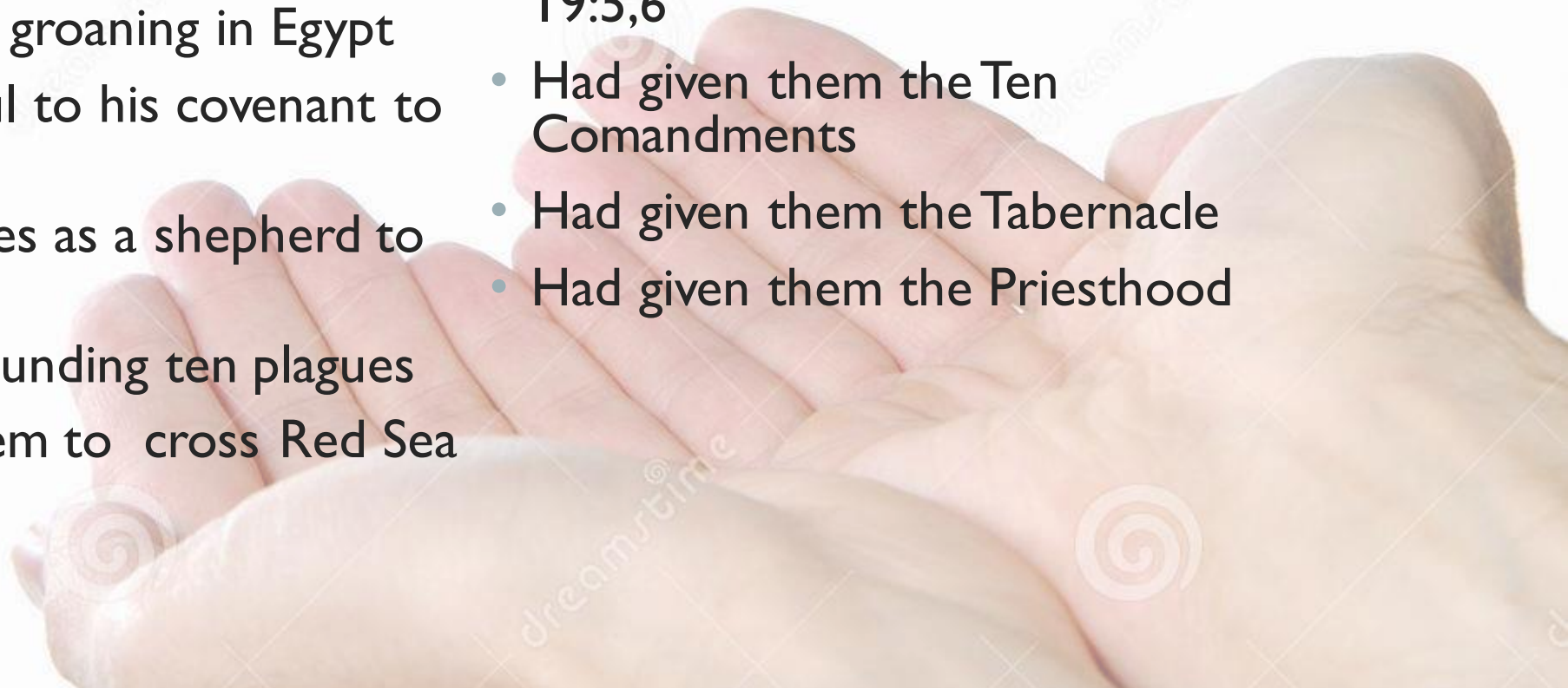
## THE OFFERING SYSTEM: WHY?

- i. To recognize God's mercy
- ii. Trust in God's faithfulness to fulfill his promise



## THE OFFERING SYSTEM: RECOGNIZING GOD'S MERCY

- Had chosen Israel
- Had heard their groaning in Egypt
- Had been faithful to his covenant to Abraham
- Had raised Moses as a shepherd to lead the Exodus
- Had shown astounding ten plagues
- Had enabled them to cross Red Sea
- Had given them his promise in Ex 19:5,6
- Had given them the Ten Comandments
- Had given them the Tabernacle
- Had given them the Priesthood



## THE OFFERING SYSTEM: RECOGNIZING GOD'S MERCY

- Active „thank you“ to God, knowing who they were
- From spiritual babies, to a mature relationship with God
- In fact, it was God who had been faithfully raising them
- Overcome slave mentality, grow in love relationship with him (from slaves to royal and holy priests)
- What God had done for them was incomparable with what he asked of them



## RECOGNIZING GOD'S MERCY TO US

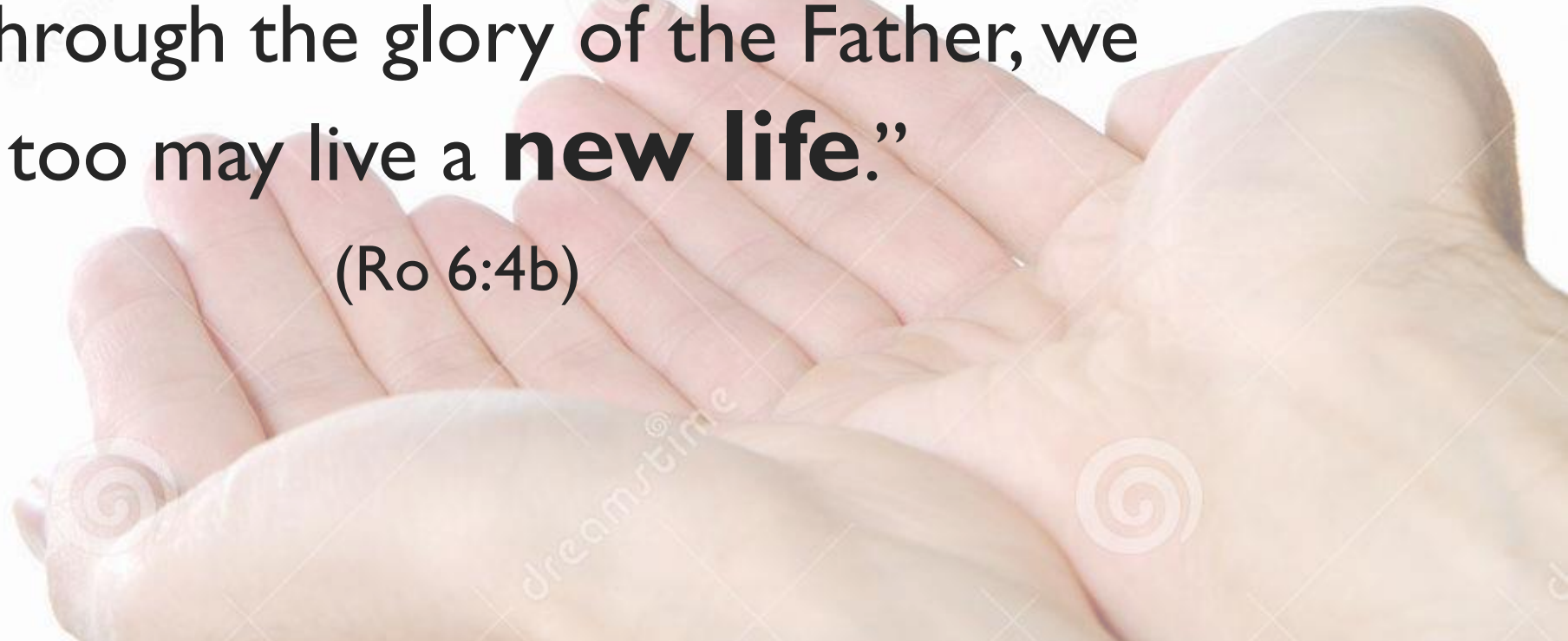
- We were: slaves to sin, enemies of God

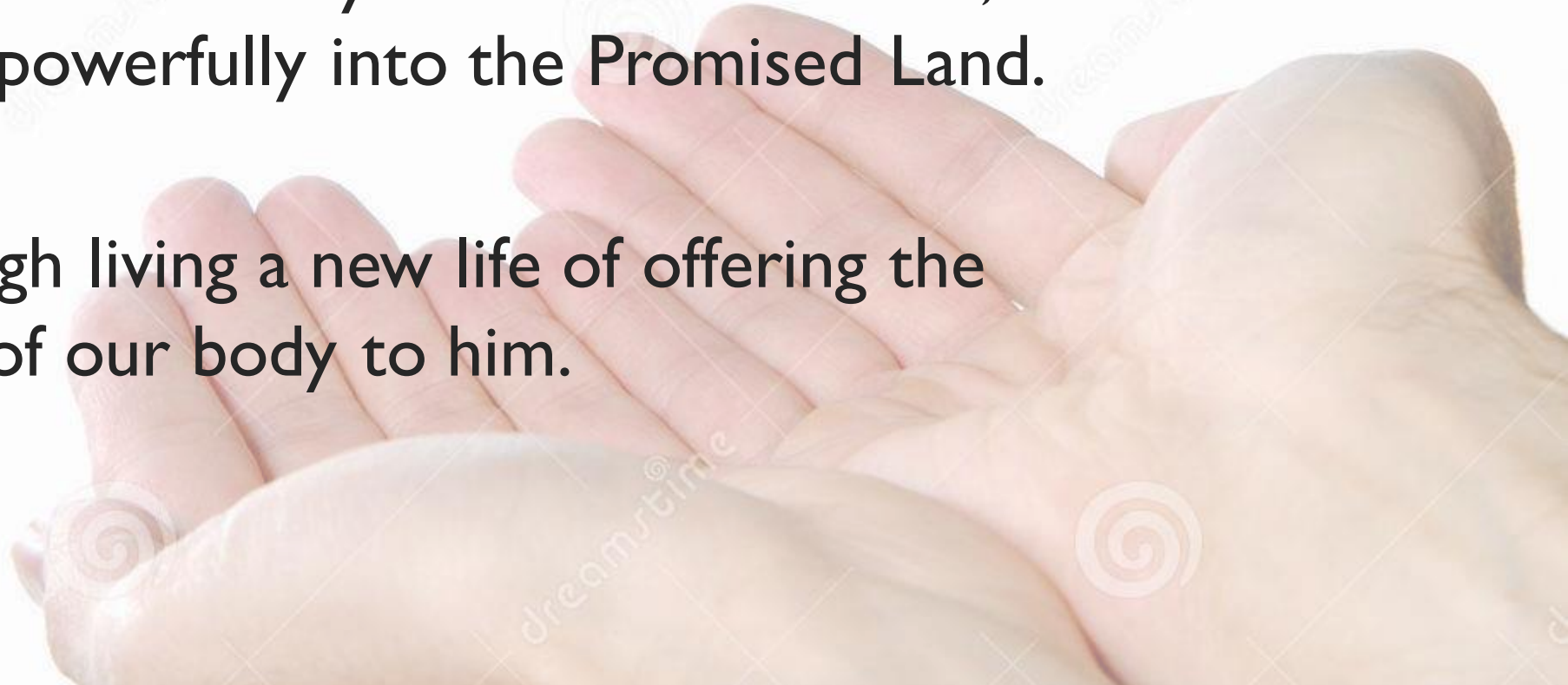
“and just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a **new life.**”

## OFFERING TODAY

- We can either stay stuck in our old life, or move powerfully into the Promised Land. How?

## OFFERING TODAY RECOGNIZING GOD'S MERCY

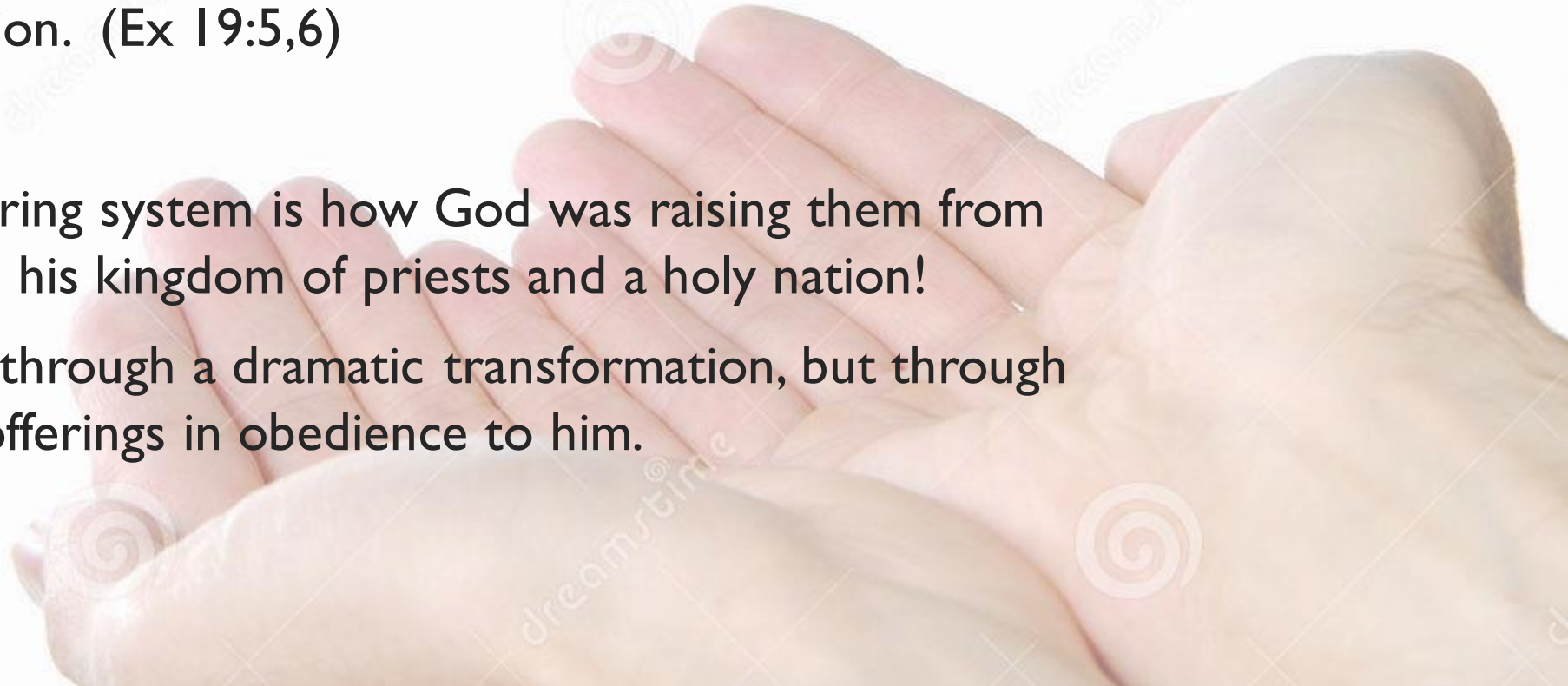
- We are no longer slaves (e.g. of addictions and self-serving and self-centeredness)

## THE OFFERING SYSTEM: HOLDING ONTO GOD'S PROMISE

- God is raising his people as his kingdom of priests and a holy nation. (Ex 19:5,6)
- How?
- The offering system is how God was raising them from slaves to his kingdom of priests and a holy nation!
- It is not through a dramatic transformation, but through faithful offerings in obedience to him.



## THE OFFERING SYSTEM: HOLDING ONTO GOD'S PROMISE

Offerings can be quite costly...

How can we offer to God instead of keeping for ourselves, and feeling like it was a waste?





## THE OFFERING SYSTEM: HOLDING ONTO GOD'S PROMISE

- Instead of focusing on the cost to me, focus on the promise of God!
- Mt 6:33 says: “But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.”



## THE OFFERING SYSTEM: HOLDING ONTO GOD'S PROMISE

- Through offering, God's people are disciplined as kingdom people, with no worries but with absolute faith in God.
- People who worry about money and physical survival cannot be royal priests or a holy people.
- They are not transformed in their fundamental motivation, but the same as all other people: living and working for bread (Jn 6:27)!
