ANITTA

Bio: Anitta is a Brazilian singer, songwriter, and dancer known for her dynamic presence in the Latin music scene. With a mix of funk carioca, pop, and reggaeton, she has garnered international fame and worked with artists like J Balvin and Cardi B. She won the VMA (video music award from MTV) for Best Latin Artist three years in a row. She was also nominated last year for the GRAMMY Award for Best Latin Pop Album.

Genre: Pop, Funk Carioca, Reggaeton

ANAVITORIA

Bio: Anavitoria is a Brazilian indie pop duo composed of Ana Caetano and Vitória Falcão. Their music blends soft pop melodies with rich harmonies, creating an enchanting sound. Their lyrics often reflect love, life, and emotion. They have received multiple Latin Grammy wins, including Best Portuguese Language Song and Best Contemporary Pop Album in Portuguese. They won in 2017, 2019, and 2021, with notable songs like "Trevo (Tu)" and "Lisboa". Their work continues to be celebrated in the Brazilian music scene and internationally.

CAETANO VELOSO

Bio: Caetano Veloso is a legendary Brazilian musician, poet, and composer. One of the leading figures of the Tropicalia movement, his work spans a variety of genres including samba, bossa nova, and MPB (Brazilian Popular Music). His innovative sound and thoughtful lyrics have made him an iconic figure in world music. He has won 2 Grammy Awards and 10 Latin Grammy Awards, with over 50 international music award nominations.

DJONGA

Bio: Djonga is a Brazilian rapper whose powerful lyrics tackle themes of social issues, race, and identity. Known for his bold approach to hip hop, he has quickly become one of the most influential voices in Brazilian rap today.

LOCAL ARTISTS

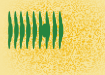

Attending the Festival

Braza Festival takes place at Victoria Square/Tarntanyangga — right in the heart of Adelaide CBD! It's easily accessible by public transport.

Tram: Catch any tram service running between Glenelg and the Adelaide Entertainment Centre.

Bus: Numerous city bus routes stop within a short walk from Victoria Square, including services along King William Street and Grote Street.

Parking: Paid parking is available at nearby locations such as UPark Grote Street and UPark Topham Mall, but we recommend using public transport or rideshare to avoid CBD traffic.

Gates Opening Hours:

Gates will open at 9:30 AM. Arrive early to catch all the action from the start!

What to Bring (and What's Banned):

Bring: Your tickets, sunscreen, a hat, comfortable shoes and your phone to take pictures.

Banned: Outside food and drinks, large umbrellas, professional cameras, and fireworks. No pets, sorry.

Cashless Info:

All purchases at the festival will be cashless. Be sure to bring your card or set up your digital wallet.

Emergency Instructions:

In case of an emergency, please follow the Event Staff's instructions and head towards the nearest exit. Emergency exits are clearly marked on the festival map. First Aid is available at the designated station near the toilets, in the back.

Weather Policy (What If It Rains?):

The festival will go on rain or shine! We got your back with our nice tents. But, in case of heavy rain with thunderstorms, the event will be cancelled for everyone's safety.
