Key facts

- About 40 million people are blind worldwide, with the highest burden in Sub-Saharan Africa.
- The core barrier is people power. Many regions have about 1 effective ophthalmologist per million people.
- Cataracts are the leading cause of avoidable blindness. Surgery is quick and highly effective and can cost as little as 100 dollars per case.
- Every 100 dollars raised can restore sight to someone who would otherwise live in darkness.

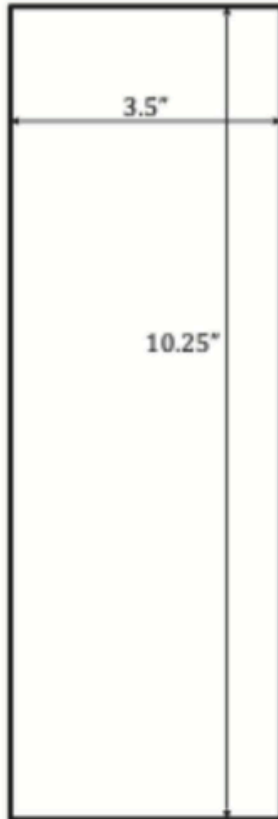

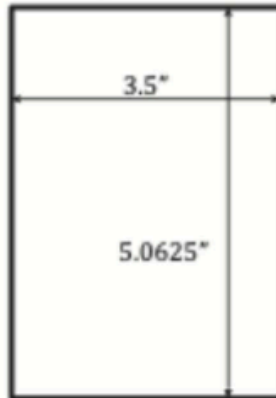
