
Racquel Marshall (Diana) was born and raised on the exotic island of Trinidad in the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago. She fell in love with Diana Ross as a little girl, lip-syncing to her records with a pair of stockings for hair, a hairbrush for a microphone, and the river stones where she played were her adoring fans. Racquel came to America after winning an International Performing Arts competition in her home country, which awarded her various opportunities as well as a scholarship to further her studies in New York and Hollywood. She is a celebrity in the Caribbean community as an actress, host, and spokesperson. Racquel is also known for her non-profit work with children, youth, the homeless, and the otherwise underserved in her community, both in the US and in "sweet T&T".

Amberlin Morse (Florence Ballard Cindy Birdsong) is a singer/songwriter, born in Torrance, CA, with a vision of hope and a desire to use music to bring change to the world. In addition to her Singing, Amberlin plays multiple instruments. When she was twelve, she worked in the strawberry fields outside Seattle, WA to earn enough money to buy her first guitar. She started writing songs in high school. "My theater teacher was very encouraging. He thought my song 'Homelessness' was an old Negro spiritual. Even back then, my bandmate and I were talking about social issues."

**Virginia Trent** (*Mary Wilson*) is an actress, musician, and dancer, born and raised in Los Angeles. She holds degrees in both theater and film from UCLA, with an emphasis in musical theater. Virginia's talents have been showcased in numerous productions as a singer, actress, dance captain, model and voice-over actress. She is excited to a part of the cast of "diana – The Show" as Diana Ross was her inspiration to become a performance artist at a young age. Virginia is a committed advocate for the advancement of diversity and equity throughout the entertainment industry.

Mike Terrell (Johnny Bristol/Lionel Richie) Mike is a Philadelphia native now based in Los Angeles. He is a Grammy-nominated singer, songwriter, and professional actor with a career spanning music, theater, and screen. He has performed and recorded with legendary artists including Kanye West, Chloe Bailey, Stevie Wonder, Post Malone, and most recently toured with Jonathan McReynolds and Jon B. His stage credits include numerous regional theater productions and Off-Broadway appearances. On screen, Mike has appeared in hit series such as Empire, The Chi, Chicago PD, Twenties (BET), and Wu-Tang: An American Saga. He is honored to join this incredible cast in celebrating the timeless legacy of Diana Ross.

**Siobhan Martin** (pronounced "Shah-vaughn") is the choreographer for "diana – The Show". A native of Trenton, NJ, Siobhan holds a Masters' degree in dance and a business degree from Appalachian State University. She was a captain for the cheerleading squad for the NFL Carolina Panthers when they played in Super Bowl 50 and was named "Sports Illustrated Cheerleader of the Week" that same year. Siobhan currently lives in Los Angeles and is a working actress, singer, and dancer.


