The Grinch is a green, furry creature who lives alone on a mountain. He does not like Christmas or the people in the town below. The Grinch thinks the people are too loud and happy.




At the end of the story, the Grinch returns everything to the town. He joins the people, and his heart grows three sizes. Now, the Grinch loves Christmas too.


