Reasons to oppose rezoning for a Mooresville Technology Park:

- No guarantees of a buyer/promises being fulfilled; and no clear plan
- No ability to perform noise or light pollution studies
- Tract requesting 500,000 gallons of water daily & are not drought tolerant – they could have access to town water, aquifers (well water), & Coddle Creek water (Don Howell Reservoir)
- It goes against One Mooresville and 2045 Horizon Plan
- 400+ Acre "Technology Park" with estimated 1.5 million sf footprint. Each building roughly 300,000 sf footprint. That equates to each building being an estimated 7 acres totaling 35 acres of buildings.
- Other towns have had issues with:
 - energy use & huge price increases
 - \circ sediment clogging well pumps
 - \circ light and noise pollution
- Data centers have an average lifespan of 15 to 20 years
- Public water & sewer could bring PUDs and/or other industrial sites
- Residential needs to stay residential and We LOVE our rural area
