## What is a Maternity Nurse?

A Maternity Nurse, also known as a *Newborn Care Specialist* or *Night Nurse*, is an expert in newborn care and parental support. They assist with pre-birth and post-birth care to ensure a smooth transition for both the baby and parents.

#### Services Provided by Maternity Nurses:

Services are tailored to each family's requirements so services and assistance vary, below are some areas a Maternity Nurse can benefit you and your newborn.

- Pre & Post-Birth Home Consultations: Assistance with preparing for the baby's arrival and post-birth care.
- Day/Night Care: To allow mothers to rest and recuperate.
- **Nursery Duties**: Bathing if required, feeding, bottle preparation, sterilising, and diaper/nappy changing, settling baby after feeds.
- Sleep & Feeding Routines: Helping to establish healthy patterns from the start.
- Feeding Support: Assistance with breastfeeding, combination feeding, bottle feeding, and weaning.
- Developmental Milestones: Guidance on fostering newborn growth.
- Activities for Newborns: Play-based activities to promote development.
- Health & Safety: Setting up safety strategies for home and outings.
- Nanny or Domestic Helper Training: Enriching your Nanny and/or Domestic helper with skills to follow routines, newborn baby care, home safety and how to interact developmentally with the baby.
- Attachment Support: Helping to build a secure bond between parents and baby. And so much more...

## Service Options

#### **Night Care**

Start Time: By 10 pm, minimum of 8 hours. Rates: Varies according to job description Available for 1 to 7 nights per week, flexible contract terms.

#### Day Care

Minimum of 4 hours per day. Same rates, deposit, and contract terms as night care.

#### 24-Hour Care

Round-the-clock support for single or multiple babies.

#### **Specialised Medical Care**

Tailored services for newborns with specific medical needs.

#### **Consultations**

Duration: 30 minutes or 60 minutes All consultations are prepaid and include agency fee

Focused on key areas like pre and postnatal care, establishing sleep and feeding routines, child development and so much more. Available via home visits, in Hong Kong, virtual online video calls or phone calls.

#### A Guide for Budgeting

Rates vary according to job description, *and are subject to change*, see below as a guide to help with budgeting.

Single newborn: HKD 380-420/hour Twin newborns: HKD 450+/hour 24hr care: Please <u>contact us</u> for more details Specialised medical care: Please <u>contact us</u> for more details.

#### **Booking and Fees for Maternity Nurse**

Agency Placement Fee: 20% of contracted hours (payable upon contract finalisation). Bond: Secures booking (used towards final payment, non-refundable if contract is shortened or cancelled).

Transport Charges: May apply for remote locations or outlying islands.

Additional Information:

Maternity Nurses can assist with all feeding choices but may recommend additional lactation support if necessary.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Why are there so many names for Newborn Care?

Different countries have different terms and legal requirements e.g. many USA states use Newborn Care specialist instead of Maternity Nurse. In Hong Kong and Elite Childcare Consulting we primarily use Newborn Care Specialist and interchange with Maternity Nurse, Night Nanny and Newborn Nurse.

#### Who pays the Maternity Nurses tax?

The Maternity Nurse is responsible for her own tax payments and filing of tax.

#### Are the Maternity Nurses employed by Elite Childcare Consulting?

No, all Childcare professionals are independently employed and use Elite Childcare Consulting as a recruitment agency.

#### How soon do I need to book to secure a Maternity Nurse?

Any time is a good time to book a Maternity Nurse, many clients like to secure their booking early in their pregnancy and others after baby is born.

We recommend if you know you would like newborn care support the earlier the better to ensure you can secure the duration and type of support you need.

Please consider a discovery call with an Elite Consultant to determine what would work best for your family and budget.

#### What languages do your Maternity Nurses speak?

Our Maternity Nurses speak English, Cantonese, Mandarin, French and German.

#### Can I claim Newborn Care Support on my Medical Insurance?

All our Maternity Nurses are fully vetted, experienced, and legal to work in Hong Kong. CVs and references can be provided upon request or at an interview.
