

### 5-Game Tournament Rules

Our Tournaments are intended to be for the enjoyment and development of the players.

Players and their parents take their lead from the team's coaches.

You are their role model.

Rosters must be submitted via the USA Softball website and teams must have copies of roster and birth certificates on hand for potential challenges.

This tournament is sanctioned by USA Softball and governed by its rules with the only exceptions in this document. Regardless of this, the umpire's decision is *FINAL*.

- There will be no pre-game warm-up allowed on infields. Pitchers may use foul territories to warm up.
- All players must be eligible for the age group they are playing in, per the USA Softball Age Rule chart
- All rosters must be loaded into the USA Softball website at NortheastFP.com. Any player participating in the event MUST be on your roster on the site. If there is a challenge, and a player is not on your roster on the site, your team will receive an Out before the next batter on your team bats.

# **Tournament Format (all ages):**

- Pool play: no new inning after 1hr 20min. At 1hr 30min, last batter will be called and the score will not revert. Ties are allowed.
- Bracket play: no new inning after 1hr 20min. Tied games will go to ITB the inning after time has expired.
- Seeding tie-breakers are:
  - Record
  - o Head to head record
  - o Runs given up
  - o Total run differential from all pool games
  - Coin flip

### Game Format (all ages except where noted):

- Mercy rules apply for all games 12 runs after 3 innings, 10 runs after 4 innings, 8 runs after 5 innings.
- Pool play: Farthest traveling team calls the coin toss for Home/Away. Bracket play: Higher seed can choose Home/Away.
- 12U Only: No "Butcher Boy" hitting. Fake bunting and swinging away is <u>NOT</u> allowed. If this occurs, a dead ball will be called. The batter is out, and runner(s) return to their original bases.
- Games are 7 innings. No run limit per inning. Three outfielders play the field.
- Teams can bat in any of the formats allowable by USA Softball.
- Any base can be stolen and continuation is allowed on walks. Dropped third strike, infield fly and look back rules are in effect.
- In an attempt to get in full games, a continuing pitcher will receive 4 warm ups the first inning, 3 every inning thereafter. A new pitcher will receive 4 warm ups.
- USA Softball standard substitution rules apply
- Only one mound trip is allowed per inning per pitcher; all subsequent trips in the inning must be to replace the pitcher.
- <u>Stalling will not be permitted</u> as determined by the umpire if so determined; the umpire may override the time limit if a team is determined to be intentionally stalling.
- No infield or outfield warm up balls allowed after the first inning.

#### **Courtesy Runners**

- Courtesy runners are allowed for pitchers and catchers at any time.
- The courtesy runner is a substitute not in the game (if not batting entire line-up), or the last batted out (if batting entire line-up).
- The pitcher and catcher are identified as the last players who physically played that position.

### Weather

- Inclement Weather in the event of inclement weather it may be necessary to play shortened games
  or to adopt an alternate format for the tournament. We reserve the right to change the tournament
  format as needed.
- We reserve the right to adjust the rules, schedules, brackets, and field locations, if necessary, in order
  to complete the tournament. Every attempt will be made to honor the game minimum however, if a
  situation develops where a team forfeits or the weather does not cooperate, every attempt possible
  will be made to reschedule, shorten or cancel games in order to complete the tournament.
- Rain and cancellation policies can be found on our website

#### **Score Reporting**

- Both coaches should text the game score to 908.291.7010 immediately following the game
- The Tournament Directors have the final say on all disputes.

## **Other Information**

Umpire decisions are final. No protests allowed. Video replay does not exist.



- Game time is forfeit time to be enforced by the Umpire and/or at the Tournament Director's discretion. In rain situations, please do not leave the fields as the schedule may be adjusted without prior notice.
- Please do not impede the progress of the game. Any signs of poor sportsmanship, actions that demean opposing players, fans, or the umpire may be grounds for the offender(s) to be removed permanently from the game and premises. And, if serious, the possibility of their team forfeiting the game. Any coach/player ejected from a ball game by an official, will also be suspended from the team's next game (at minimum) with further penalty if warranted.
- Alcohol is forbidden at ALL complexes. There is no smoking allowed inside any park. Walk to the roadway or parking areas.
- Teams are responsible for cleaning out their dugout! PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE ANYTHING BEHIND and put all trash in the proper containers or bag. WE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN PROPERTY! Please have the girls, coaches and parents clean up after themselves.
