DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN BAKU - CITY TOUR

Arrival & Check-in

Transfer to the famous Nizami street (Fountain Square) Nizami Street is a large pedestrian and shopping street with its fascinating view. The street also accommodates the embassies of many countries. The architecture of the street reflects a harmony of old and new period; the street's history dates back to Baku's town-planning project of 1864. It runs from west to east, beginning at Abdulla Shaig Street in the mountainous part of the city and ending near a monument to Shah Ismail Khatai in the area known as the "Black City." Along Nizami Street, you'll encounter a blend of historic and modern architecture. The street is adorned with elegant buildings, trendy boutiques, and inviting cafes.

Transfer to Baku Old City Tour also known as "ICHERI SHEHER" Old City or İçərişəhər is the historical core of Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan. The Old City is the most ancient part of Baku, which is surrounded by walls that are well protected. In 2007, the Old City had a population of about 3000 people. In December 2000, the Old City of Baku, including the Palace of the Shirvanshahs and Maiden Tower, became the first location in Azerbaijan to be classified as a World Heritage Site Overnight in Baku.

DAY 2: ABSHERON TOUR + HEYDAR ALIYEV CENTRE

Breakfast at hotel

Visit to Ateshgah (Fire Temple) & Yanardag (Fire mountain). The Temple of Eternal Fire - Ateshgah - The Baku Ateshgah also known as "Fire Temple, is a castle-like religious temple in Surakhany town, the temple was used as a Hindu, Sikh, and Zoroastrian place of worship. built during the 17th and 18th centuries.

Yanardag – Fire Mountain - is a 116 meter hill located on the top of a natural gas pocket causing continuous flame eruption. This is the nature of this burning mountain. This natural gas fire blazes continuously on a hillside on the Absheron Peninsula on the Caspian Sea 25 KM northeast of the Baku city. Tour continues with the visit to the charming example of modern architecture - The Heydar Aliyev Center– a 57,500 m2 building complex in Baku, Azerbaijan designed by Iraqi-British architect Zaha Hadid and noted for its distinctive architecture and flowing, curved style that eschews sharp angles. The center is named after Heydar Aliyev, the first secretary of Soviet Azerbaijan from 1969 to 1982, and president of Azerbaijan Republic (photo stop) Overnight in Baku

DAY 3: GABALA TOUR

Breakfast at hotel, Post breakfast departure to Gabala city

Yeddi Gozel Waterfall, also known as the Seven Beauties Waterfall, is a captivating natural wonder located in Gabala, Azerbaijan. The waterfall is situated approximately 6 kilometers from Vandam village and 3 kilometers from the main track over Puskan. Water from various ravines converges to create this stunning seven-step waterfall. Although only two small waterfalls are visible from below, the entire cascade is a sight to behold.

During winter, the waterfall freezes completely, making it challenging to access. However, in spring and summer, it comes alive with rushing water. Gabala's modern amenities, combined with its traditional charm, make it an ideal getaway for travellers seeking both adventure and tranquillity.

Visit to Nohur Gol lake - The Nohur Lake (Nohurgöl) is one of the most picturesque places of Gabala that have magnificent view to Caucasus Mountains and surrounding villages with fresh air and water where you can take a boat and catamaran ride to enjoy the surrounding landscape transfer to Tufandag mountain resort

Tufandag, just 4 kilometers from Gabala city center, offers 12 kilometers of slopes, with a mix of challenging reds and blacks for experts and easy options for beginners. Guests can also take advantage of snowmobile, sledges and quad bike tours. In summer visitors can enjoy plenty of outdoor adventures, from hiking and cycling to paragliding and jeep tours. There is also a Cable Car which lets you go up to the higher peaks and explore the beauty of the mountains and nature from up. Overnight in Baku

DAY 4: GÖBÜSTAN TOUR + BOULEVARD + SHOPPING

Breakfast at a Hotel. Visiting Göbüstän National Park and Mud Volcano

Göbüstän petroglyphs are exceptional testimony about the lifestyle of ancient people: collective labour, hunting, harvest, ritual dance yalli, images of animals, food around the fire, images of women and men etc. On this territory there are many traces of primitive inhabitants of people belonging to the period of the Paleolithic and Mesolithic.

There are over 300 mud volcanoes in Azerbaijan. 100 of them are located near the Göbüstän reserve alone. There are giant volcanoes, such as Toragay and Great Kanizdag in Göbüstän, with a total elevation of 400 metres. The Goturdag volcano in Göbüstän is the world's only continuously erupting volcano; mud squeezing as the specialists put it, has been observed there for many years

Highland Park Tour

Departure for evening tour - Famous Baku Boulevard tour

Baku Boulevard was established in 1909 which is also known as the National Seaside Park in Baku. The Boulevard is popular with museums, shopping malls, entertainment centers including the modern panoramic amusement ride – The Devil's wheel, which has a beautiful view over Baku bay. Baku Boulevard serves as a vibrant hub for relaxation and leisure, embodying the spirit of the city. Guests can take advantage of tour of Little Venice what is a charming network of man-made canals that wind through the area and canals are interspersed with small islands connected by stone bridges, reminiscent of the iconic Venetian architecture, The most preferred and main attraction of Boulevard – Ferris Wheel give foreigners and the local people unforgettable enjoyment and memories.
