

Winter Wonderland Kashmir



6 days in Gulmarg & Srinagar (Day Trip - Aharbal Waterfall, Peer Ki Gali, Doodhpathri)

DAY 01 : ARRIVAL SRINAGAR – GULMARG(51 Kms – 2 Hrs One Way)

Upon arrival at Srinagar Sheikh Ul Alam Int'l Airport (This must be one of the Most Scenic Flights in the World). Drive to Gulmarg via Bye-Pass for overnight stay. Gulmarg, called the "Meadow of Flowers". Gulmarg is at an altitude of 8700 – ft. Gulmarg also referred to as Meadow of Flowers is a famous Ski Resort & the world's highest 18 hole Golf Course. The place was prominent during British time. Gulmarg's legendary beauty, prime location and proximity to Srinagar naturally make it one of the premier hill resorts in the country. Originally called 'Gaurimarg' by shepherds, its present name was given in the 16th century by Sultan Yusuf Shah, who was inspired by the sight of its grassy slopes emblazoned with wild flowers. Gulmarg was a favourite haunt of Emperor Jehangir who once collected 21 different varieties of flowers from here. Today Gulmarg is not merely a mountain resort of exceptional beauty- it also has the highest green golf course in the world, at an altitude of 2,650 m, and is the country's premier ski resort in the winter. On arrival, check in to the pre-arranged Hotel. Rest of the day is free at leisure. Dinner & Overnight stay at Hotel.

NOTE : In case of snowfall, our vehicle will be able to drop you at Tangmarg only (10 Kms before) from where you need to hire a Snow Jeep (chained vehicle) directly. Else Vehicle will drop you at Gulmarg Hotel only from where you can either hire ponies / ATV bikes or can go by walk for Gondola Ride as vehicles are not allowed for sightseeing or any movement.

DAY 02 : IN GULMARG (LOCAL SIGHTSEEING) – NO TRANSPORT

After a leisurely breakfast, One Can go for the Gondola Ride up to 1st or 2nd Phase. The Gulmarg Gondola is a tourist attraction in itself. It is one of the highest cable cars in the world, reaching 3,979 metres. The two-stage ropeway ferries about 600 people per hour to and from the gondola main station in Gulmarg to a shoulder of nearby Mt. Affarwat Summit (4,200 m (13,780 ft)). Gulmarg is also called the "heartland of winter sports in India", as it is a gathering ground for all things extreme sports and outdoors related. In the winter, the diverse and extreme terrain combines with torrential snowfall to create a snow destination that is among the best in the world. From the Kongdoori station, Skiers can ski down a groomed trail through the woods that descends 450m in about 3.8 km. There are also countless off-piste possibilities through the beautiful Khilanmarg meadows on the foot of Mount Affarwat, which offer a scenic view of Nanga Parbat. The Affarwat ridge at 3850+ metres offers an avalanche controlled ski area that offers a wide field of snow to descend 800 m in approximately 3 km of skiing, and is for advanced skiers only. Due to Gulmarg's steep terrain, the region is popular amongst advanced and extreme skiers from around the world and has been visited by a number of ski professionals and featured in a number of ski films also. Return by the evening for Dinner & Overnight stay at Hotel.

Note: As per the new rules from Cable Car Corporation all Gondola tickets has to be pre-booked online only (www.jammukashmircablecar.com) by the Guest with valid ID proof only to avoid on site inconvenience

DAY 03 : GULMARG – SRINAGAR (51 Kms – 2 Hrs One Way)

After a leisurely breakfast, check out from the Hotel & transfer to Srinagar. On arrival at Srinagar, check in to the pre-arranged Hotel. In the afternoon, we took a visit to Mughal Gardens, Nishat Garden known as 'Garden of pleasure' built in the 16th century (1633) by Mughal King Asif Khan. Then visit Shalimar Garden known as 'Garden of love' built in the 16th century (1619) by Mughal King Jahangir for his beloved wife Noor Jahan or (Mehr-un-Nissa & Chashmashahi (The Royal Spring). The Chashmashahi Mughal garden in Srinagar had been loved by emperors and picnickers alike. In the evening you take a shikara ride on world famous Dal Lake, where you visit the floating vegetable gardens & Open Dal Lake. While riding the Shikara's there are plenty of opportunities for bird watching with plentiful species including Kingfisher, Little Bittern, Common Pariah Kites, Grebe etc. Dinner & Overnight stay at Hotel.

DAY 04 : SRINAGAR – DOODH PATHRI – SRINAGAR (42 Kms – 2 Hrs One Way) – SUBJECT TO WEATHER CONDITIONS

After an early breakfast, leave for a full day excursion to Doodhpathri. "Doodhpathri" - known as the Valley of Milk is a tourist destination and hill station in Kashmir. It is located in Budgam district of Jammu & Kashmir, located at a distance of 42 km from state summer capital Srinagar. It is said that the famous saint of Kashmir Sheikh ul Aalam Sheikh Noor din Noorani has prayed here, and once when he was in search of water in the meadows to offer prayers, he pricked the ground with his stick to search water, and milk came out, he asked the milk that you can only be used for drinking and not performing ablution. Hearing this milk at once changed its state to water and the meadow got its name DOODHPATHRI. The water which is at present flowing through the meadows looks like milk from a distance and remains very cold throughout the year. The lush green grasses over the vast meadows and silver shining stream running over the large stones further increase its beauty. Doodhpathri is sloping grassy landscapes with a diversity of multicoloured flowers up to Chang. The natural meadows, which are covered with snow in winter, allow the growth of wild flowers such as daisies, forget-me-nots and butter cups during spring and summer. Return by the evening to Srinagar for Dinner & Overnight stay at Hotel.

DAY 05 : SRINAGAR – AHARBAL WATERFALL – PEER KI GALI - SRINAGAR (135 Kms – 4 Hrs One Way) – SUBJECT TO WEATHER CONDITIONS

After an early breakfast, leave for a full day excursion to **Aharbal Waterfall**, often referred to as the "Niagara of Kashmir," is a breathtaking natural wonder located in the Kulgam district of Jammu and Kashmir. Cascading from a height of 25 meters, the waterfall is fed by the Veshu River, creating a mesmerising sight as the water plunges into a deep gorge surrounded by lush greenery and pine forests. The area is perfect for picnics, photography, and simply soaking in the tranquility of nature. From Aharbal, a scenic drive or trek takes you to **Peer Ki Gali**, a high mountain pass in the Pir Panjal range. Situated at an altitude of 3,490 meters, Peer Ki Gali offers panoramic views of the surrounding mountains and valleys. The pass is a part of the historic Mughal Road, which connects the Kashmir Valley to the Poonch and Rajouri regions. The journey to Peer Ki Gali is filled with picturesque landscapes, making it a favorite spot for nature lovers and adventure enthusiasts. Together, Aharbal Waterfall and Peer Ki Gali provide a perfect blend of natural beauty and serene landscapes, offering an unforgettable experience for travellers seeking to explore the lesser-known gems of Kashmir. Return by the evening to Srinagar for Dinner & Overnight stay at Hotel.

DAY 06 : DEPART SRINAGAR (FLY OUT)
