

4.2. FS Presentation Schedule:

During all presentations (team & external), (part of) your team is expected to be present as a sign of respect and engagement.




5.Locations

- General terrain use





- A 700m fence surrounds the official event space (marked in red). Do not cross the fenced boundary; this separates our area from industrial property.
- Chill area, including tables and a bar
- Tracks of participating teams

Facilities:

- There is **no water** on-site. We suggest every team member bringen 2L of waters each day.
- Account for no standard power outlets on-site. We do arrange the following general 230V outlets:
 - one outlet per work area
 - some shared ones for the showcasing stands
 - one per demonstration place
- Requested power will be arranged by the organization based on pre-discussions in the app groups.
- Portable toilets are available.




• The event bar offers drinks throughout the day for a payment.


Floorplan per team showcase and workareas:





General Information:

- Large sports hall used for overnight accommodation.
- Each team has a designated sleeping zone.
- Curtains will be provided for basic privacy.

Facilities:

- Available: Toilets, showers, basic sleeping floor space.
- Not available: Beds, mattresses, duvets, kitchen or cooking facilities.

Bring your own sleeping mat, bag, and pillow. You can buy an inflatable mattress for 10 Euros at the Action in Veendam if you need one.

Food:

Catering has been arranged based on the forms your team submitted in advance.

Please note that **no food outside the catering** is allowed in the accommodation. The kitchen cannot be used during the stay outside of the catered meals. You can buy drinks and snacks over the counter of the bar.

House Rules:

- Respect sleeping hours (Lights out at 23:00, on at 7:15).
- Breakfast 7-8.30, Dinner 19-20.30. This means at 8:30 and 20:30 the catering place closes, so be sure you come well in advance.
- Keep shared spaces clean.
- Emergency exits must remain free at all times.
- Behave according to the contract you signed, using the accommodation is at your own risk.
