Azerbaijani Representatives of the REFRESH Project Participated in a Study Visit to EU Higher Education Institutions

Within the framework of the REFRESH project, a study visit was organized to the Technical University of Denmark (DTU) with the participation of representatives from UNEC and several Azerbaijani partner universities. The visit focused on improving curricula in the field of renewable and alternative energy. During the program, DTU experts delivered lectures and workshops on sustainable energy technologies, energy forecasting, and modern teaching approaches, while participants also discussed curriculum development and program improvement. The visit concluded with Training of Trainers (ToT) sessions for the partner universities.



From 3–7 June, a study visit to the University of Barcelona (UB) was organized within the framework of the REFRESH project, coordinated by the Azerbaijan State University of Economics (UNEC). The visit brought together representatives from UNEC, Azerbaijan University of Technology, Ganja State University, Mingachevir State University, Lankaran State University, and Sumgayit State University. During the program, participants attended presentations and discussions on sustainability, renewable energy education, and the coordination of REFRESH project activities, while also learning about UB's master's program in Renewable and Sustainable Energy and initiatives in circular economy. The visit concluded with a seminar on the role of university–industry cooperation in developing innovation ecosystems.

As part of the REFRESH project coordinated by the Azerbaijan State University of Economics (UNEC), a study visit was organized to the KTH Royal Institute of Technology (Sweden) with the participation of representatives from UNEC and several Azerbaijani universities. During the visit, participants attended seminars on renewable energy, environmental sustainability, and digital tools in higher education, while also exploring KTH's energy research activities and laboratories. The program concluded with a REFRESH project management meeting to discuss upcoming tasks and future cooperation.
