After internal reflection, a unique set of rules specific to SPICE OPEN is proposed to leave more room for creativity and your desires.

- 1° The pom-pom dance is a choreography based on a specific non-imposed theme. (e.g.: soldier, school, etc.) where the match between music, costume and theme must be spotted by the judges from the 1st note of music.
- 2° Pompoms are an integral part of the choreography and are used to support the chosen theme, for example with visual effects.
- 3° The countdown to the choreography begins on the 1st note of music and ends on the last note.
- 4° Minimum number of compulsory elements: 2 waves,
- 2 floor passages,

3 formation changes.

Total occupation of the floor space.

- 5° Gymnastic elements are authorized (e.g.: wheels, forward and backward rolls, arabesques, flexibility movements). Elements with body throws, inversions and without hand placement are totally forbidden (e.g.: flips, salto, etc.).
- 6° Dance lifts are permitted, but must be performed in complete safety. (Cheerleading, stunt, etc. lifts are forbidden).
- 7° Release of pom-poms is authorized (pom-pom exchanges, etc.). Penalties will be applied for each pom-pom drop.
- 8° Accessories are permitted, but must not be bulky. They
  may be used during the choreography to enhance a desired visual effect
  but must disappear as quickly as they appear. These objects must remain within the confines of the
- 9° Pompoms may not be placed on the floor for more than 1x8 beats, after which a penalty will be applied.
