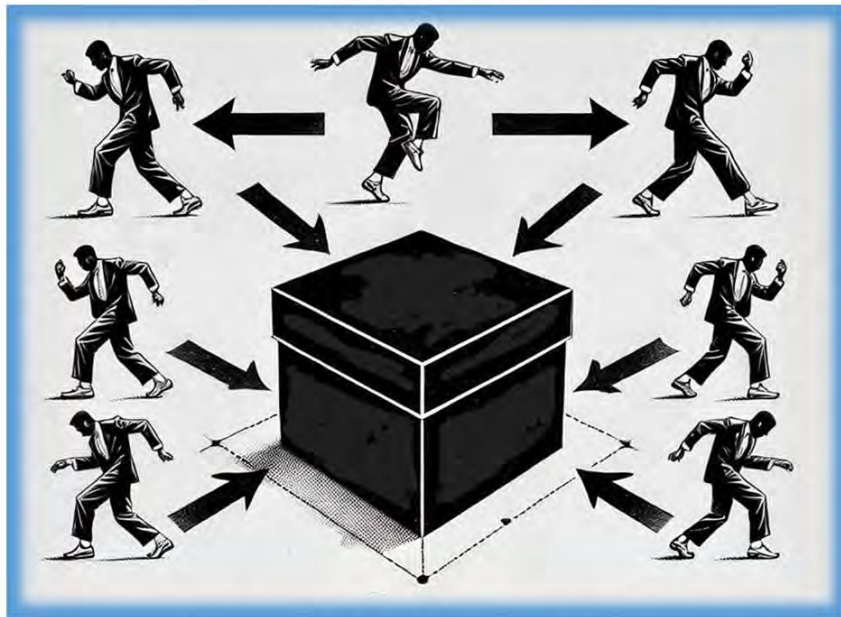

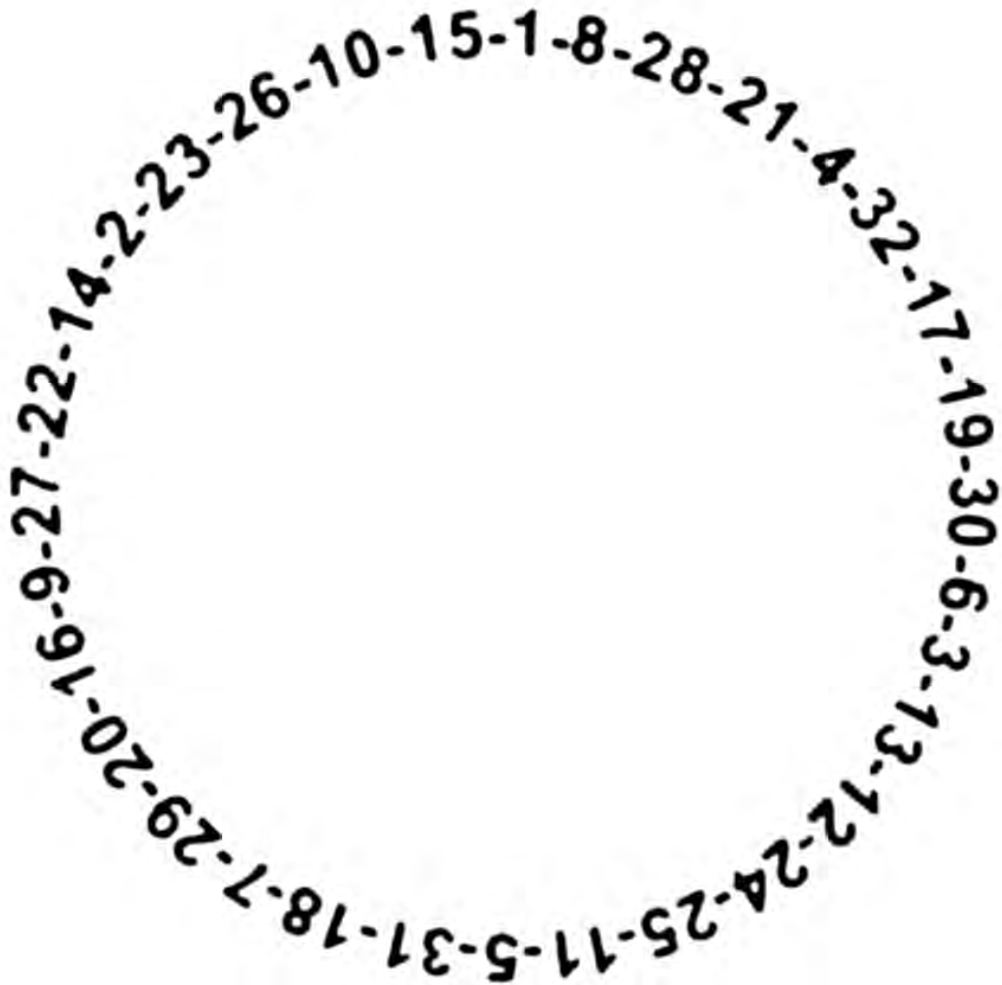

What am I?



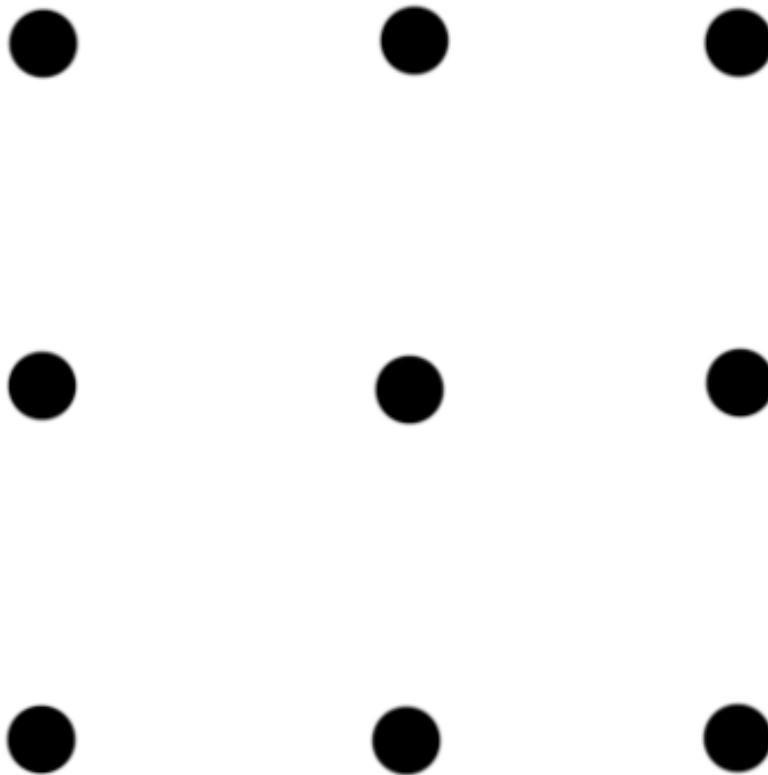
Answer: Circle of Squares

Any two adjacent numbers add up to a perfect square.

For example: $1+8=9$. The square root of 9 is 3.

The numbers in the circle are from 1 to 32 and don't repeat!

Connect all 9 dots with a single straight line



Roll the paper into a cylinder
so a single straight line can be
drawn connecting the dots.
