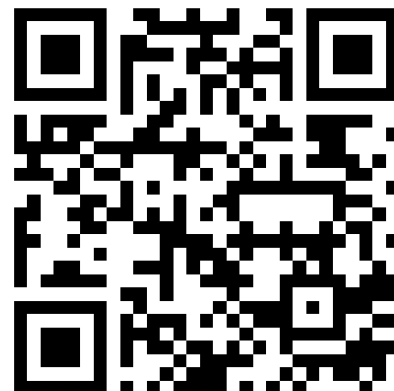


The "One Family Service"
