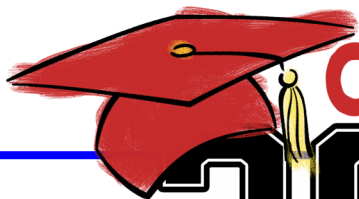
June 17 we will begin our Wednesday night services in the Children's Church upstairs as we have a break from Bible Seekers.

Garret is a member of Men for Christ and the National Honor Society. He completed over 30 credit hours of college courses through Western Piedmont and received his information Technology Support certificate.

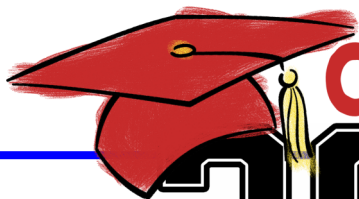

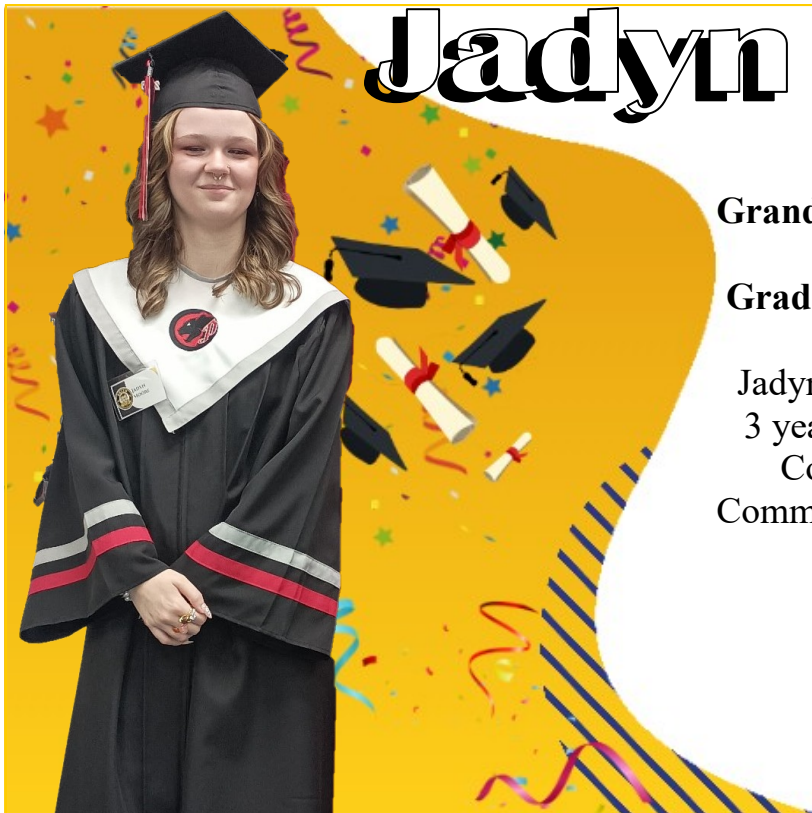

Jacob Weston Norville

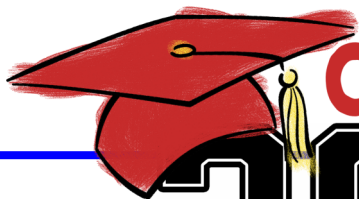

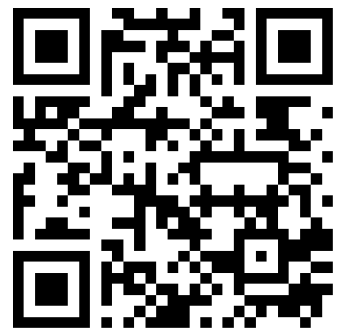
