BASHA is the founder of Absgraff®, a contemporary visual language that treats graffiti as civic infrastructure rather than subculture. Developed in Salt Lake City, the practice examines abstraction, signal, and control systems governing movement, authority, and desire across architectural and urban space.

Operating across studio, installation, and institutional contexts, BASHA's work positions graffiti-derived abstraction as a functional visual system—one that reflects how order, power, and behavioral cues are embedded within civic environments. His practice engages painting, spatial intervention, and site-responsive work within both private and public-facing contexts.

Visual Language

Absgraff® (founded 2013)

Absgraff® is a system-based visual language merging abstraction, graffiti, and signal systems to examine how visual order governs behavior within civic and architectural environments. The work emphasizes rhythm, repetition, interruption, and coded form, treating visual composition as infrastructure rather than expression alone.
