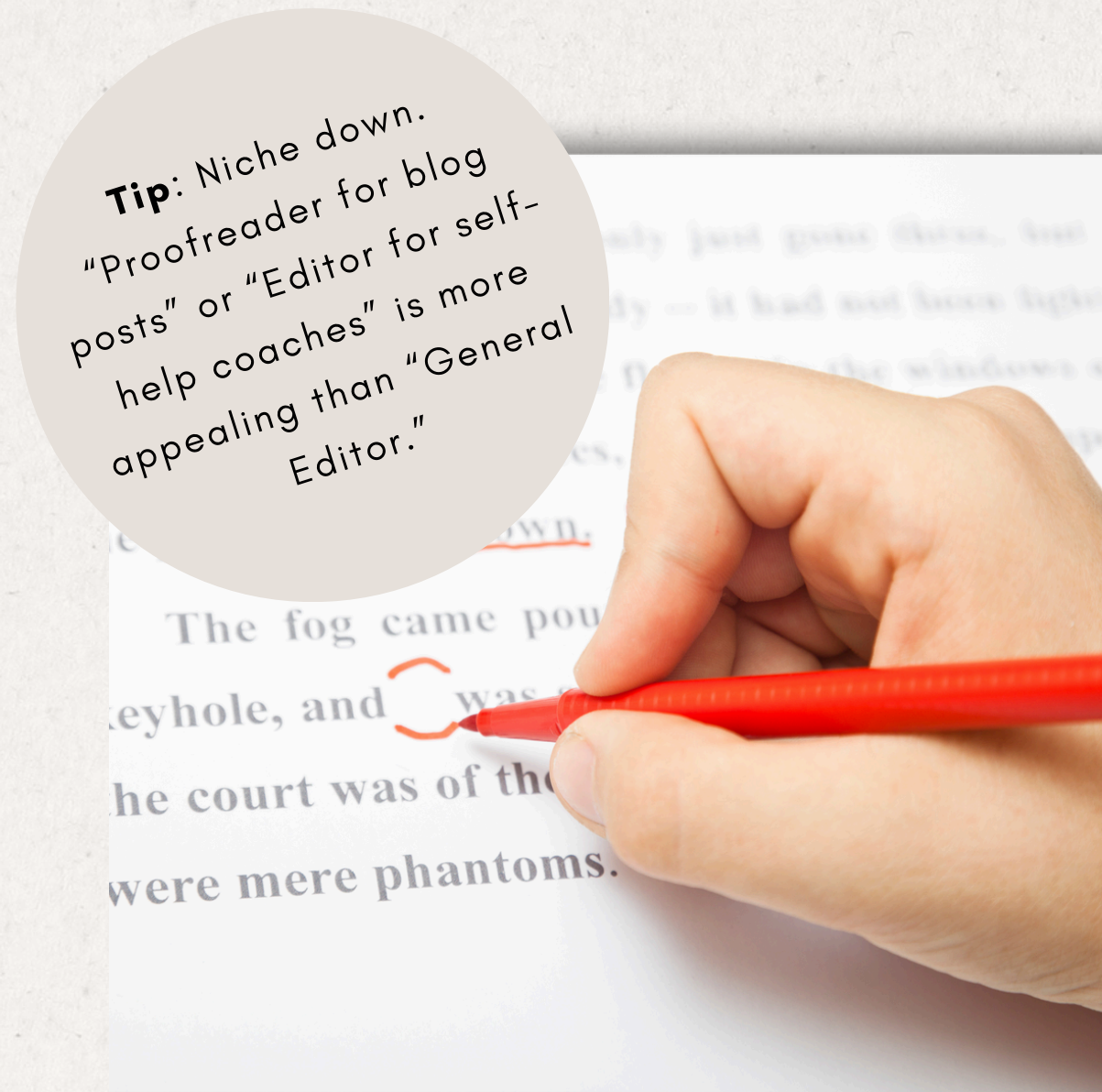
Side hustles aren't get rich quick schemes. No matter which one(s) you choose to focus on, you'll need to work hard and consistently. Are you ready to do that? Then let's GOOOO!

What It Is:

- You get paid to review documents for grammar, spelling, punctuation, and clarity. Clients include bloggers, students, authors, coaches, and small business owners.

Why It's Beginner-Friendly:

- No special certifications needed (though they help)
- You can work from anywhere
- Platforms like [Fiverr](#), [Upwork](#), [FlexJobs](#), and [Scribendi](#) have consistent listings

Typical Pay:

- \$10-\$30/hour depending on skill level and niche
- \$15-\$50 per project for shorter documents
- Can easily hit \$100 within a week or two of landing your first clients

How to Start:

- Sign up on [Fiverr](#) and/or [Upwork](#) – create a profile offering proofreading, editing, or formatting help
- Offer a few low-priced gigs to build reviews quickly
- Use [Grammarly](#) or [Hemingway App](#) to boost your editing accuracy
- Search job boards like [ProofreadingServices.com](#) or [Freelancer.com](#) for small jobs

FREELANCE WRITING / VIRTUAL ASSISTANT WORK

What It Is:

- You provide writing services (like blog posts, emails, product descriptions) or general admin support (calendar management, research, customer service) to online business owners.

Why It's Beginner-Friendly:

- Everyone needs content and admin help
- You can start with skills you already use (email, writing, organizing)
- Entry-level gigs are often available on Upwork, Fiverr, PeoplePerHour, and Facebook groups

How to Start:

- Pick a service: Blog writing, email newsletters, simple admin, social media scheduling, etc.
- Create a basic offer + portfolio samples ([Canva](#) templates or past work)
- Apply for 3-5 jobs per week on freelance platforms
- Pitch yourself in entrepreneur Facebook groups and forums

Typical Pay:

- \$20-\$100 per article (freelance writing)
- \$10-\$25/hour (virtual assistant work)
- \$100 can come quickly from just 1-2 small gigs

Tip: Offer "starter packages" (e.g., 3 blog posts for \$90) to attract first-time clients who want simple wins.



ONLINE COURSE OR MINI-WORKSHOP

Tip: Don't wait to grow an audience. Start by selling to people already in your circle who need what you know.

What It Is:

- Create a simple training on a skill you already know (or are learning!) and sell it to your existing network, email list, or social media audience. Could be a live Zoom workshop or pre-recorded.

Why It's Beginner-Friendly:

- You only need to be one step ahead of your audience
- People love step-by-step help (e.g., "How I created my first digital product")
- Free tools like Loom, Zoom, and Canva make this easy to produce

Typical Pay:

- \$27-\$97 per workshop or mini-course
- Bundle with a workbook or template for extra value
- One well-promoted workshop can earn \$100+ in a weekend

How to Start:

- Pick a topic you can teach (ex: Canva basics, organizing your week, simple social media)
- Outline 3-5 short lessons or one 60-minute workshop
- Record it (or go live and record it!) and upload to Gumroad, Teachable, or Thinkific
- Offer it to your small email list, friends, or Facebook groups — even a few buyers at \$27 gets you to \$100 fast



USER TESTING / WEBSITE TESTING



What It Is:

You get paid to test websites, apps, or digital tools and give honest feedback on user experience.

Why It's Beginner-Friendly:

- No experience needed
- Zero marketing, zero selling
- Fast to start and simple to do

Top Sites to Try:

- [Respondent.io](https://www.respondent.io)
(for higher-paying research)

How to Start:

1. Sign up for multiple platforms to get more testing opportunities
2. Complete your tester profile and do sample tests
3. Watch your email — tests often go quickly, so act fast

Typical Pay:

- \$10 per 15-20 min test
- \$30-\$75 for longer interviews on Respondent
- \$100 possible within your first few days if tests are available

Using Canva, create a one-page digital product (ex: habit tracker, journal page, quote design, to-do list).

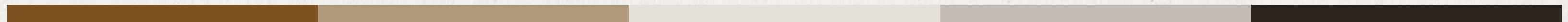
Don't overthink it – just start.

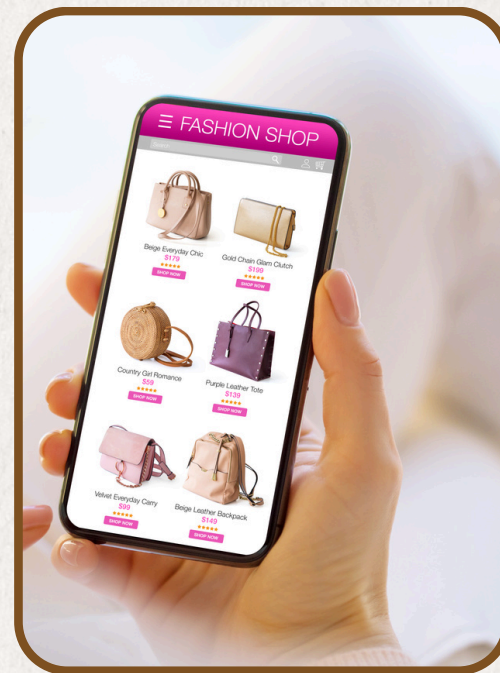
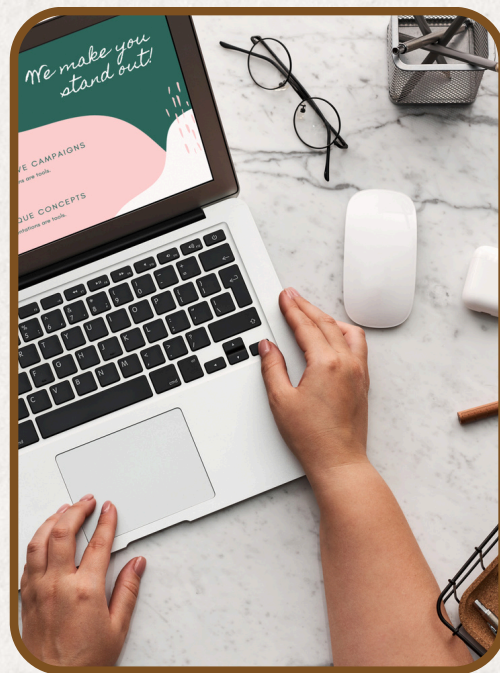


Hey - You just took a step most people never take!!

Remember: Perfectionism is procrastination in disguise. You can modify / improve your product later.

You have a product live. That's more than 99% of beginners ever do.

BONUS: 7-DAY JUMPSTART CHALLENGE



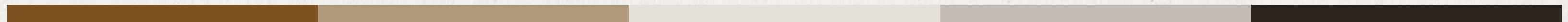
Use Canva to design a social post or Pinterest pin promoting your product.

Include a headline + mockup or screenshot.



Remember: Marketing isn't selling — it's sharing what you've created to help others..

You now have a marketing asset you can use again and again.

Message or email 3 friends or family members and tell them what you made.

Ask if they'll check it out and/or share it.



Remember: Confidence builds through action. Every “tiny win” trains your brain to believe in your potential.

You’ve officially launched. That’s huge. That’s massive. That’s hugely massive.



BONUS: 7-DAY JUMPSTART CHALLENGE



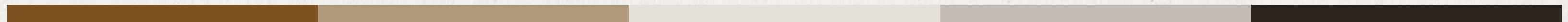
Write down:
