



Resort Buyout







Exotic, Luxurious and Affordable Panama City

oyfriends, husbands, kids, jobs and dogs were all left behind so that the bridal party could converge in Panama City for a hotly anticipated bachelorette party weekend. We parted ways with routine and responsibilities and met up for a long weekend of fun and sun, culture and cuisine. Panama - exotic enough to require passports and high-value SPF, but familiar because English is widely spoken and American dollars are accepted everywhere — is a destination that matched our wish list. Plus, far-flung friends could get there on a nonstop flight from our hometowns across the U.S. Here's my bach weekend recap.

First, We Eat

We gathered on a tiled terrace overlooking the Pacific, cupping chilled coconut beverages spiked with rum and swaying to Latin jazz and salsa music. Conversation buzzed about our friend's upcoming wedding and move to a new city. Our home base for the weekend was the Sofitel Legend in the heart of Casco Viejo. Rebuilt from the ruins of the storied Club Unión of Panama, this resort was where Daniel Craig filmed a scene from Quantum of Solace. The intoxicating scent of roasted pork beckoned us to our table at Caleta, where we feasted on garlic jumbo prawns, fresh kampachi ceviche and cochinillo asado while toasting our togetherness with a handcrafted Pink & Roses cocktail, a mixture of tequila and lychee liquor.



Historic Charm

To me, Casco Viejo feels like a mashup of New Orleans and Miami with its captivating blend of French and Spanish influences evidenced in its wrought-iron balconies and cobblestone streets. An early morning tour of the UNESCO World Heritage Site took us into timeworn churches built by Dominican friars, shaded plazas surrounded by stately colonial architecture and the crumbling stone archway at Arco Chato. According to legend, Iglesia San Jose's breathtaking golden altar was painted black by a quick-witted priest to save it from a band of pirates. Along the sidewalks, shops display handicrafts from practiced artisans. Typical souvenirs such as tote bags, table coverings and blankets showcase indigenous needlework and traditional patterns. In an attempt to blend in with locals, we picked up Panama hats and Guayabera shirtdresses from an Alberto Pons boutique.



Wellness & Bonding

Nothing like your besties to set you straight on any issues you've been wrestling with. We hashed out work problems, in-law entanglements and other ethical dilemmas over tapas plates at the rooftop restaurant and around the infinity pool over afternoon cocktails. The pool bar kept us nourished with everything from yogurt-based fruit bowls and green smoothies to double cheeseburgers and ice-cold Atlas beer — to each her own. Each of us booked time in the spa for a luxurious massage or facial. My therapist took me into a profound state of relaxation with her Deep Recovery massage treatment.



Brunch on the terrace, shaded by a canopy of pink and purple bougainvillea, was a fusion of French and Panamanian flavors. With a peppy "Bonjour" from a server, a basket of warm French pastries was dropped off and quickly plundered. The accompanying latte was rich and flavorful thanks to the hotel's custom coffee blend made by family-owned producer, Santos Café. My final culinary indulgence in Central America was a plate of cilantro-laced scrambled eggs, beef carimañola, chicken tamales and tropical fruits. As we traded hugs and headed for the airport, the difficulty of saying adieu was softened by the realization that we'll be gathering again soon for the big event. *





Months Out

GET IT TOGETHER

This is it; the point where you can't procrastinate anymore. You don't have to solve it all right now, but you have to start getting organized. Start a folder to keep all your paperwork, contacts and inspiration in one place.

ESTABLISH A BUDGET

Be sure to build some flex spending into it for travel costs (especially if you're thinking of bundling the honeymoon and destination wedding into one trip).

CHOOSE A DESTINATION

CREATE A GUEST LIST

SET THE MENU

Choose between buffet or plated service and make your culinary choices, including a specialty cocktail.

SEND INVITATIONS

Be sure to include your travel advisor's contact information in case your guests need help getting from point A to point B.

PRACTICE MAKES **PERFECT**

Plan a rehearsal dinner or welcome cocktail reception to serve as the dry run for the big day.

CONFIRM **APPOINTMENTS**

Double-check times for all your hair and makeup appointments to ensure there's no confusion.

FINALIZE CEREMONY **DETAILS**

Time to solidify the main event. Write your vows, select the music, choose readings or plan any personal rituals you'd like to include.

FINISHING TOUCHES

Little details like a signature drink, custom event signage or welcome bags add a lot of personality.

GET THE MARRIAGE LICENSE

Some destinations do not provide legal licenses, so the ceremony will only be for show. Destinations differ, so consult with your advisor on the local requirements to make sure everything is in order! *

Insider Perspectives from Wedding Pros

e asked a handful of seasoned experts to answer our questions in their areas of expertise: entertainment, cuisine and florals. With decades of experience and dozens of satisfied clients, observations from these professionals may inspire your approach. Find out what they're doing for weddings right now.

ENTERTAINMENT

Greg Ellis is an award-winning DJ and owner of Neckwerk Entertainment, a full-service wedding entertainment company in St. Paul, MN.

What are your most-requested first dance songs?

GE: "Perfect" by Ed Sheeran is a classic. In Minnesota, country love songs are popular. I play a lot of Luke Combs songs like "Beautiful Crazy" and "I Got Away with You" along with George Strait's "I Cross My Heart" and Morgan Wallen's "You Make it Easy."

0: Do you act as the MC in addition to playing music?

I do MC the event and keep up the pace. I think it's important to let guests know where they should be and what's about to happen. For example, as the bride makes her appearance, I build excitement, advise guests to take their seats, introduce the bridal party and get everybody standing and clapping. That way, energy is high when the first dance starts and everyone feels involved.

Do you work with the wedding coordinator?

GE: We work closely to set the mood and make sure we have the timing and music right. A wedding is like a play, there's the first act, second act and finale. I work with coordinators to confirm the order of events and ensure we're ready at each step from ceremony to cocktail hour to dinner to dancing.

CUISINE

Lorenzo Di Gravio is the Michelin-starred executive chef at Sofitel Legend Casco Viejo in Panama City, Panama.

Do you recommend a sit-down dinner or buffet for 0: wedding receptions?


LD: A sit-down dinner is the epitome of elegance and always allows us to create beautiful and intricate menu options that are both delightful and beautiful bites; however, buffet stations allow for a wider variety of cuisines and presentations.

What is the most popular passed appetizer?

LD: Tuna tartare will always be the queen of passed hors d'oeuvres, either in small plates or in clever presentations such as with fried plantains or crispy rice. During the cocktail hour, we serve a variety of hors d'oeuvres that represent the happy couple and their favorite cuisines.

What are some suggestions for showcasing Q: food beautifully?

We love vertical gardens with big monster leaves and orchids. They create a rainforest-like experience and work in perfect harmony with our food and beverage displays. An interactive station like a chocolate fountain is always fun! We like to pair chocolate with passion fruit in our tropical climate.













Based in Austin, Texas, Madeleine Landry specializes in large-scale floral installations for clients like jeweler Kendra Scott.

How do you create a romantic vibe?

ML: For a romantic ambiance, I'll fill a tent with soft lighting, abundant florals and smilax vines draped from the ceiling. I'll blend lots of texture, volume and dimension into the arrangements using loose, organic designs in colors that reflect the season: citrus and corals for spring and summer, and in the fall, burnt oranges, copper, gold and burgundy. Winter weddings tend toward white and cream stems with greenery in hues of emerald, moss, jade and chartreuse.

What floral trends are you seeing?

ML: Social media has changed how florals are deployed in weddings. "More is more," and clients like big volume at their events. We're seeing more flower walls and photo backdrops intended for social feeds. Style trends include Boho romantic and an English garden look that combines large blooms like peonies, ranunculus, tulips and garden roses.

What's the secret to a striking bouquet?

ML: Have a few large, focal-point flowers rather than a bunch of smaller blooms that compete for attention. Go for a natural shape that shows off the flowers and has room to breathe rather than something tight. For a beach wedding, tropical flowers like orchids and birds of paradise can withstand the heat.







Q: How did you decide on a destination wedding versus a local wedding?




February + Mexico
