

Central Illinois Pole Vault, LLC – Rental Agreement

- The Rental fee will be paid in full before the pole(s) are picked up.
- The Renter will inspect the Pole(s) and report any physical damage (scratches, worn label, etc.) to the pole when picking up the pole. Pole(s) will also be inspected for any physical damage when returned.
- Pole vault poles can be easily damaged if not properly taken care of. Damaged poles can lead to pole failure and injury to the vaulter.
- Pole(s) will not be laid on the ground or in an area where they can be damaged. Place pole(s) on a pole tree or in the protective case/bag when not in use. Track spikes and contact with hard surfaces (pole vault standards) are the most common cause of damage to a pole. Ensure pole(s) are not contacting hard surfaces; recommend that pole vault standards have protective padding around them.
- Pole(s) will always be transported within the provided pole sock and inside of a hard protective case or a pole bag with a hard inner lining.
- Pole(s) will not be shared or loaned to anyone. The rental is for the individual vaulter listed on the rental agreement.
- Any lost, stolen, or damaged pole that renders the pole unsafe to vault on requires the Renter to pay the full replacement cost of the pole, plus any shipping costs incurred.
- All poles come pre-taped. If the tape is removed, damaged or altered, the Renter will need to pay a \$15 cleaning and re-taping fee.
- The Renter is responsible for pole pick-up & return in the Bloomington/Normal area. Additional fees will apply if returned late; \$5/day.
