I am aware that my concerns will not be addressed otherwise. You must submit this form along with all other required material.



Our goal is to provide a safe, Islamic environment for each child to experience a high quality education. Here your child will build age-appropriate skills that will prepare them for future life-skills. As we practice the Quran and Sunnah, your child will learn Islamic values and implement them in their daily choices. By the Will of Allah each day will be filled with knowledge and each child will leave confident in knowing they are successful. Your questions, comments, and suggestions are always appreciated.



Under no circumstance will we allow your child to stay under our care if they are running a fever above 100 °F, or have a cough and/or runny nose not related to allergies, or if they have vomited, or are experiencing diarrhea. If your child is sick, please keep them home for at least 24 hours after you have begun giving them medicine. This will stop the illness from spreading. Likewise, you will be notified if any child in our care has been sick. We take this seriously and hope you will too. Parents will be notified if their child is sick so they can pick them up immediately. We do not administer medication at this time. You MUST report any communicable disease your child has been exposed to as well as any underlying health issues your child faces. Our goal is to maintain a healthy and safe environment for all children. We require all individuals that enter our facility to wash their hands before/after eating, and toileting. Health screening will be conducted upon child's entry.

Admissions



All required paperwork and fees, must be completed and submitted before the child's first attendance day. One month <u>advance</u> tuition is also due. We require a one-month notice if your child will no longer attend our school. Please note that we do not serve any foods at this time. You

are required to send lunch and snacks from home. To promote a healthy lifestyle, we only allow fruits or vegetables for snacks.



Attendance

Out of respect, please <u>call, text, or e-mail</u> if your child will be absent on any given day or if you will be early/late for drop-off/pick-up. Regular late pick-up will lead to late fees. Guardians must sign the child in/out upon drop-off/pick-up.

Accidents

Any injury or accident that happens under our care shall be documented and signed by the parent(s). We are not liable for any injuries/accidents that happen under our care. We will attend to the child and give them necessary treatment. Parents will be notified according to the severity of the incident. If required, they will be transported to the nearest hospital.



It is our goal to instill Islamic values and behavior within our children. Through communication of positive statements and role-modeling, we hope to encourage every child to develop self-control. Parents will be notified and given an incident report in cases where undesired behavior becomes constant and/or a safety concern. If the child's behavior does not improve or worsens, we will recommend expulsion. Collaboration and consistency is the key to succeeding in raising our children.



In case of an emergency you will be notified by phone. If we experience a situation where we need to remain in the building and lock it, no one will be allowed in or out of the building until circumstances are

clear. If we need to evacuate, we will have the children outdoors in the parking, if needed, children will be relocated in front of the Town Hall of Dumfries (17955 Main Street). In case of inclement weather, we require parents to make prior arrangements to pick up their child(ren) in a timely manner. Remain calm and know that we are doing our best to keep your child safe.
