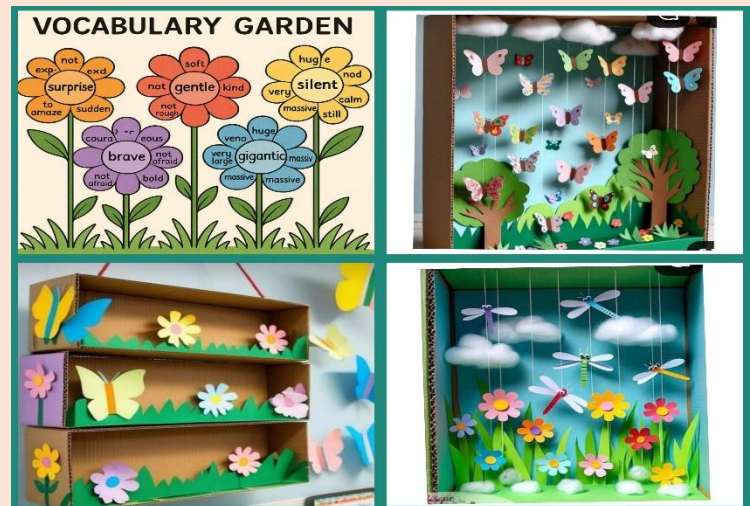

4. INNOVATION IN MAKING (MODEL)

A. Vocabulary Garden

Choose 5–10 new English words that you have learned recently. For each word, create a flower. Write the word on the petals (one letter per petal or the whole word around the petals). In the centre, write the meaning of the word. You can add simple drawing of the word or write a sentence using the word. Attach each flower to a stem and place them on your garden base. Decorate your garden with a title like “My Vocabulary Garden”. You can use cardboard, popsicle sticks, straws, sticks, original leaves, grass, etc. to decorate it.

B. Wheel of Parts of speech

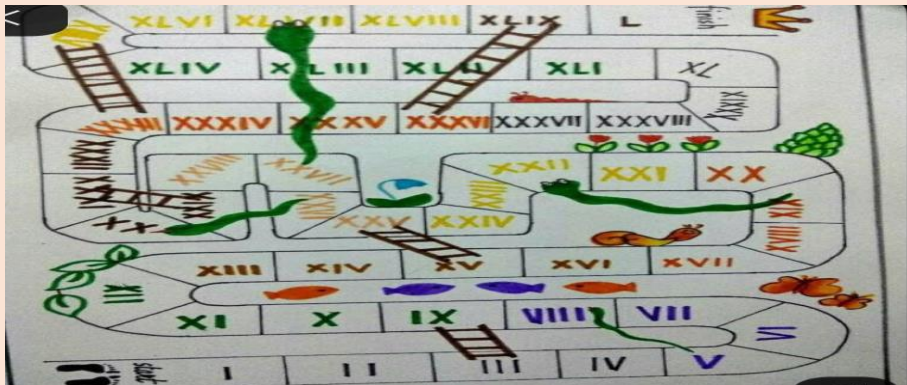

Concept: Show interaction of living and non-living components in a specific ecosystem.



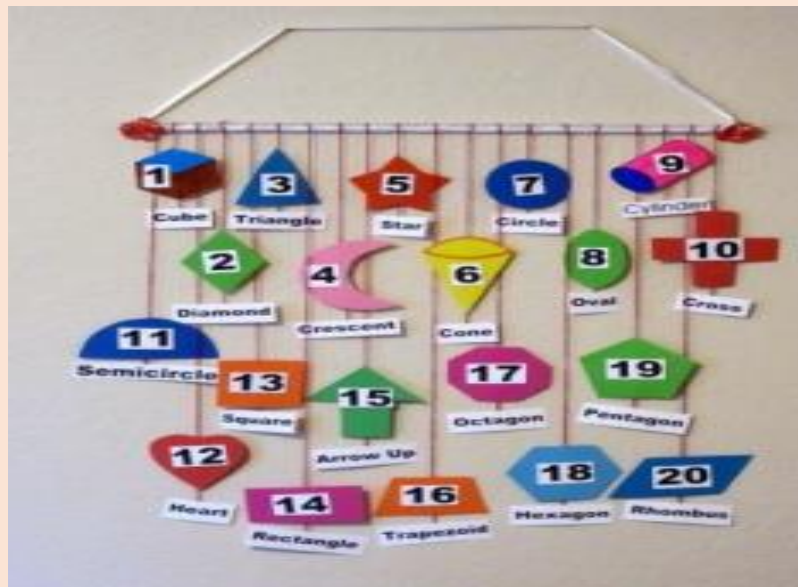
