

Ham & Ne'elatama'uk

Our Heavenly Father—our Creator—has a Personal Name. In Aramaic Square Script Hebrew it is: יהוה. In Paleo Hebrew Script it is: 𐤅𐤆𐤅𐤇. One transliterated version into English to help with sound pronunciation is “Yahuah,” additionally “Yah” for short—יה or 𐤅𐤆. Other English transliterations do exist.

Our Messiah—our Savior—has a Personal Name as well. Similarly in Aramaic it is written יהושע or 𐤅𐤆𐤕𐤍 in Paleo—transliterated to English by some as Yahusha. Other English transliterations do exist.

There is one race, and one race only—the human race. Reference **Genesis 1:27, Deuteronomy 10:17, Acts 17:26, Galatians 3:28, Colossians 3:11.**

Following the Flood, eight people survived—**Noah** and his wife **Emzârâ** (referenced in The Book of Jubilees 4:33), and their three sons (**Japheth, Shem, and Ham**) and their wives (referenced in the Book of Jubilees Chapter 7).

The Genealogy of Ham is found in **Genesis 10:6-20** and in **1 Chronicles 1:8-16**. **Psalms 78:51, 105:23, 27, and 106:21-22** refer to Egypt as “the land of Ham,” highlighting the significance of Mizraim (Egypt) as a descendant of Ham. It is also referenced in **Genesis 9:20-27** with Noah putting a curse on Canaan.

Noah

→ **Ham & Ne'elatama'uk**—populated Africa, specifically Egypt and Asia, and parts of India.

→ (1) **Cush**—India.

→ **Seba** (son)—**Genesis 10:7, 1Chronicles 1:9.**

(Seba is also a nation—**Psalms 72:10** and **Isaiah 43:3**; the people of the nation are called Sabeans via **Isaiah 45:14.**

→ **Havilah**—Arabia and Africa.

→ **Sabtah**—Africa—particularly the Kingdom of Cush, and Sudan.

→ **Raamah**—**Genesis 10:7, 1 Chronicles 1:9, and Ezekiel 27:22.** Persian Gulf (Awal Island).

→ **Sheba**—Persian Gulf and Saudi Arabia.

→ **Dedan**—Persian Gulf.

→ **Sabtecha**— Ethiopia and possibly near the Persian Gulf.

→ **Nimrod**—the land of Shinar, which included cities such as Babel, Erech, Accad, and Calneh. He is also associated with the region of Assyria, where he built cities like Nineveh, Rehoboth-Ir, and Calah.

→ (2) **Mizraim**—Egypt. (**Genesis 10:6, 13-14, 1Chronicles 1:8, 11-12**)

Ludim (**Genesis 10:13**)—North Africa, and perhaps Libya..

Anamim (**Genesis 10:13**)—North Africa, perhaps Egypt.

Lehabim (**Genesis 10:13**)—Egypt.

Naphtuhim (**Genesis 10:13**)—Egypt.

Pathrusim (**Genesis 10:14**)—Upper Egypt.

Casluhim (**Genesis 10:14**)—The Philistines.

Caphtorim (**Genesis 10:14**)—possibly linked to Crete, Gaza, and Cyprus.

→ (3) **Phut**— (**Genesis 10:6, and Ezekiel 27:10**)—North Africa, particularly Ancient Libya.

Noah

→ Ham & Ne'elatama'uk

→ (4) **Canaan**—"for whatever the reason" was cursed by Noah and Canaan is the ancestor of the Canaanites who lived throughout the land of Canaan (aka Promised Land—which was not in Africa, it was an ancient region in the Near East, primarily corresponding to modern-day countries Israel, Palestine, Lebanon, and parts of Syria and Jordan). **Canaanites** (**Deuteronomy 7:1** and **Acts 13:19—1 of 7** that the Israelites were to destroy.)

→ **Sidon** (aka Zidon **1 Chronicles 1:13**) (Sidonians—Phoenician city—modern day Lebanon). **Genesis 10:15, Judges 3:3, 10:12, 1 Kings 5:6, 11:1.**

→ **Heth (Hittites)** **Genesis 15:20** (**Deuteronomy 7:1** and **Acts 13:19—2 of 7** that the Israelites were to destroy.)

→ **Jebusite** **Genesis 10:16** (**Deuteronomy 7:1** and **Acts 13:19—3 of 7** that the Israelites were to destroy.)

→ **Amorites** **Genesis 10:16** (**Deuteronomy 7:1** and **Acts 13:19—4 of 7** that the Israelites were to destroy.)

→ **Girgasites** **Genesis 10:16** (**Deuteronomy 7:1** and **Acts 13:19—5 of 7** that the Israelites were to destroy.)

→ **Hivite** **Genesis 10:17** (**Deuteronomy 7:1** and **Acts 13:19—6 of 7** that the Israelites were to destroy.)

→ **Arkite** **Genesis 10:17**

→ **Sinite** **Genesis 10:17**

→ **Arvadite** **Genesis 10:18**

→ **Zemarite** **Genesis 10:18**

→ **Hamathite** **Genesis 10:18**

***Perizzites** (were not Canaanites, but were most probably descendants of Ham) **Genesis 13:7** (**Deuteronomy 7:1** and **Acts 13:19—7 of 7** that the Israelites were to destroy.)
