

Our Heavenly Father—our Creator—has a Personal Name. In Aramaic Square Script Hebrew it is: יהוה. In Paleo Hebrew Script it is יהוה. One transliterated version into English to help with sound pronunciation is “Yahuah,” additionally “Yah” for short—יה or יה. Other English transliterations do exist.

Our Messiah—our Savior—has a Personal Name as well. Similarly in Aramaic it is written יהושע or OWYAH in Paleo—transliterated to English by some as Yahusha. Other English transliterations do exist.

## Isaiah 43:11

**(KJV)** I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me *there is* no saviour.

**(KJV+)** I, <sup>H595</sup> even I, <sup>H595</sup> am the LORD; <sup>H3068</sup> and beside <sup>H4480 H1107</sup> me *there is* no <sup>H369</sup> saviour. <sup>H3467</sup>
