

One Race— Deuteronomy 10:17

Our Heavenly Father—our Creator—has a Personal Name. In Aramaic Square Script Hebrew it is: יהוה. In Paleo Hebrew Script it is 𐤅𐤆𐤅𐤁. One transliterated version into English to help with sound pronunciation is “Yahuah,” additionally “Yah” for short—יה or 𐤅. Other English transliterations do exist.

Our Messiah—our Savior—has a Personal Name as well. Similarly in Aramaic it is written יהושע or ܝܫܘܥ in Paleo—transliterated to English by some as Yahusha. Other English transliterations do exist.

(Cepher) For **Yahuah Elohaykem** *is* **Elohai** ha’elohiym, and **Adonai** ha’adoniym, the great **El**, the mighty, and the terrible, which regards not persons, nor takes reward:

(TS2009) “For יהוה your Elohim is Elohim of mighty ones and Master of masters, the great Ėl, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality nor takes a bribe.

(YS) “For 𐤅𐤆𐤅𐤁 your Elohim is Elohim of mighty ones and Adon of masters, the great Ėl, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality nor takes a bribe.

(Brenton) For the Lord your God, he is God of gods, and the Lord of lords, the great, and strong, and terrible God, who does not accept persons, nor will he by any means accept a bribe:
