

One Race— Deuteronomy 10:17

Our Heavenly Father—our Creator—has a Personal Name. In Aramaic Square Script Hebrew it is: יהוה. In Paleo Hebrew Script it is יהָוָה. One transliterated version into English to help with sound pronunciation is “Yahuah,” additionally “Yah” for short—יה or יה. Other English transliterations do exist.

Our Messiah—our Savior—has a Personal Name as well. Similarly in Aramaic it is written יהושע or OWYAH in Paleo—transliterated to English by some as Yahusha. Other English transliterations do exist.

(KJV) For the LORD your God *is* God of gods, and Lord of lords, a great God, a mighty, and a terrible, which regardeth not persons, nor taketh reward:

(Cepher) For **Yahuah Elohaykem** *is* **Elohai** ha’elohiyim, and **Adonai** ha’adoniyim, the great El, the mighty, and the terrible, which regards not persons, nor takes reward:

(TS2009) “For ‘יהוה’ your Elohim is Elohim of mighty ones and Master of masters, the great El, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality nor takes a bribe.

(YS) “For יהָוָה your Elohim is Elohim of mighty ones and Adon of masters, the great El, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality nor takes a bribe.

(Brenton) For the Lord your God, he is God of gods, and the Lord of lords, the great, and strong, and terrible God, who does not accept persons, nor will he by any means accept a bribe:
