

One Race—Genesis 1:27

Our Heavenly Father—our Creator—has a Personal Name. In Aramaic Square Script Hebrew it is: יְהֹוָה. In Paleo Hebrew Script it is יְהֹוָה. One transliterated version into English to help with sound pronunciation is “Yahuah,” additionally “Yah” for short—יה or יה. Other English transliterations do exist.

Our Messiah—our Savior—has a Personal Name as well. Similarly in Aramaic it is written יהושע or OWYEH in Paleo—transliterated to English by some as Yahusha. Other English transliterations do exist.
