

One Race—Genesis 1:27

Our Heavenly Father—our Creator—has a Personal Name. In Aramaic Square Script Hebrew it is: יהוה. In Paleo Hebrew Script it is אַיָּה. One transliterated version into English to help with sound pronunciation is “Yahuah,” additionally “Yah” for short—יה or אַ. Other English transliterations do exist.

Our Messiah—our Savior—has a Personal Name as well. Similarly in Aramaic it is written יהושע or אַיָּהוֹשֻׁעַ in Paleo—transliterated to English by some as Yahusha. Other English transliterations do exist.

(Cepher) So Elohiym created man in his *own* image, in the image of Elohiym created he him; male and female created he them.

(TS2009) And Elohim created the man in His image, in the image of Elohim He created him – male and female He created them.

(YS) And Elohim created the man in His image, in the image of Elohim He created him - male and female He created them.

(Brenton) And God made man, according to the image of God he made him, male and female he made them.
